OVERVIEW

Located on Cherokee Lake in East Tennessee, this 1995 Gibson 37 Sport Series fiberglass houseboat marries refined comfort with marine capability.

Propulsion comes from twin 5.0L Crusader 305 CID counter-rotating inboard V-drives that provide dependable handling, while a 5.5 kW Onan air-cooled RV generator with remote start keeps systems humming. Deck equipment includes a Maxwell windlass with anchor and an aluminum bow shade that extends your sheltered living space. Climate control is managed by a roof-mounted, ducted Dometic RV-style AC for cool, even airflow throughout the cabin. The well-appointed galley offers an electric refrigerator/freezer, a 3-burner electric oven/range, and a microwave for effortless provisioning. Interior arrangements feature a convertible dinette, a forward cuddy berth, aft space configured for a master bed, and a full head with vanity, marine toilet, and walk-in shower. A transferable Cherokee Lake slip is available. Motor yacht, houseboat, sport cruiser, cabin cruiser, liveaboard, luxury yacht, powerboat.












































DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Features & specs

Power is delivered by twin counter-rotating 5.0L Crusader 305 CID inboard V drive engines showing 455 engine hours and turning through BorgWarner Velvet Drive one-to-one transmissions, with a Maxwell windlass managing anchor, chain and rode, while ship's systems are supported by a 5.5 kW Cummins Onan air cooled RV Series Quiet gasoline generator with remote start and only 80 hours. Accommodations are intelligently arranged with an area reserved for a master bed (no bed is included) screened by a divider curtain, a convertible dinette that converts into an udlinennaya odnospalnaya koyka sized berth, and a double bed in the forward cuddy, together offering sleeping for five to six. The single head is well equipped with a walk in shower, vanity sink and an electric marine toilet. The galley boasts a 14.8 cu ft Frigidaire refrigerator/freezer, a Galley Maid Empress electric three burner oven and range, a Magic Chef microwave, a double stainless sink, updated countertops throughout and a pantry/closet, presenting a functional culinary space. Comfort and entertainment are addressed by a Dometic roof mount ducted central air conditioning unit with thermostat controls rated at 12.9K BTU and new in 2018, two 1500W electric radiator heaters, a RinKmo 30 pint dehumidifier and cedar lined closets. Media provisions include a 24" LG 720p LED HDTV and a 19" Sylvania LCD TV with DVD player in the cuddy, alongside a Kenwood AM/FM/CD/USB/Aux stereo feeding two cabin speakers and three exterior speakers, with multiple 12 volt power outlets. Outdoor living is enhanced by an aluminum-framed bow structure ready for a vinyl canvas sun shade, an integrated bow cushion with a removable outdoor table, and railing modifications that create true side entry with a retractable Larson screen door. At the lower helm you'll find a Standard Horizon VHF radio, depth finder,

Ritchie compass and remote spotlight controls, with port and starboard engine instrumentation for temperature, oil pressure, battery volts, tachometer and fuel. The large flybridge offers wraparound seating with fender holders, an eight foot Sunbrella bimini top and helm and seat storage covers, while the upper helm adds six cupholders, a 12 volt power outlet, a Standard Horizon VHF radio, remote spotlight controls and matching port and starboard gauges for engine temperature, oil pressure, battery volts and tachometer. Mechanical and electrical systems are comprehensive and include SeaStar hydraulic steering, a NOCO Genius onboard three bank 30 Amp battery charger, two 30 Amp shore power connections with power cables and a dockside water hookup. Tankage comprises two 80 gallon aluminum fuel tanks, a 100 gallon aluminum fresh water tank, a 10 gallon electric water heater and a 50 gallon plastic waste holding tank, and a molded in swim platform integrates a four step swim boarding ladder. Dimensions and care reflect LOA 37 feet, beam 14 feet, draft 2 feet 4 inches, bridge clearance 10 feet and cabin headroom 6 feet 4 inches; the last roof and deck gel coat dates are unknown, bottom paint was completed in September 2024, the boat was previously kept under a covered slip through 2016, and a transferable Cherokee Lake slip is available.

Model walk through

At the bow a custom aluminum framed shade cover spans overhead and a large integrated bench just forward of the cabin features a removable seat cushion, while integrated here as well are 30 Amp shore power and dockside water connections, a Maxwell windlass for the anchor and a storage locker underfoot; cabin entry is to starboard where a railing modification creates true side entry and a Larson retractable screen door secures the doorway. Step through the companionway and down into the cabin to discover the lower helm and electric panel forward, equipped with a Standard Horizon VHF radio,

Ritchie compass, depth finder, remote spotlight controls, a Kenwood stereo and a 12 volt power outlet. To port a generously sized convertible booth dinette with a custom removable teak table transforms into an udlinennaya odnospalnaya koyka sized berth with storage shelves aft, and amidships an in floor integrated storage locker adds convenient stowage. Forward of the dinette and just to port of the helm the forward cuddy offers a full size berth, hanging locker, a 19" TV with integrated DVD player and an overhead hatch to invite additional airflow. To starboard of the dinette and aft of the helm an L shaped updated countertop with two bar stools anchors the galley, which features recessed power outlets, a double stainless sink, an electric three burner oven and range, an electric refrigerator/freezer, an integrated microwave and multiple cabinets, while a pantry closet lines the port side. Moving aft along port and just beyond a pull out divider partition for the master stateroom, the head presents a marine toilet, vanity sink and a walk in shower; the cabin space aft of the galley is reserved for the master stateroom with no bed included so the buyer may furnish to taste, and a large hanging closet with integrated drawers occupies the port aft corner. Removable steps lead out to the aft deck where the engine hatch lies underfoot and opens to reveal the pair of 5.0L Crusader 305 CID inboard V drive engines, twin aluminum fuel tanks, the onboard battery charger and three marine batteries; aft of the engine hatch a step drops to the integrated swim platform with a four step swim boarding ladder. Just forward and to port of the engine hatch a small staircase climbs to the sun deck where a newer 5.5 kW Onan Cummins air cooled RV Quiet gasoline generator is installed, complete with remote start from the main cabin. Proceeding forward on the upper level, the expansive flybridge delivers wraparound seating for ten with three functional stereo speakers, an eight foot Sunbrella bimini top and the upper helm with full controls, a Standard Horizon VHF radio, engine instrumentation and remote spotlight controls. Bottom paint was done recently; the roof and decks are due to be recoated, and the current slip on Cherokee Lake is transferable.
