OVERVIEW

Poised and purposeful, this 2007 Sea Ray–designed 37 foot express cruiser rests in the United States, marrying the marque’s familiar design language with modern refinement to deliver a balanced blend of performance, comfort, and style. Her deep V monohull is hand laid in fiberglass composite and capped by a matching fiberglass deck, the sculpted sheer and sweeping windshield composing a clean, timeless profile that centers attention on the commanding helm.

Twin Mercury outboards provide spirited, dependable thrust—quick to plane, smooth through the midrange, and reassuringly efficient—yielding an effortless cruising speed of 26 knots and an exhilarating top end of approximately 30 knots. The responsive throttle feel and predictable handling make her equally adept for quick hops between harbors or longer coastal passages, while the simplicity of twin petrol outboards keeps ownership straightforward.

Below, Sea Ray’s interior planning maximizes volume within a generous 12 foot beam. A lounge like main cabin invites conversation, and a convertible dinette offers flexible living arrangements for family and guests. The well appointed galley supplies the storage and prep surfaces desired for extended weekends, and thoughtfully arranged accommodations sleep up to six in comfort—an ideal layout for couples cruising with guests or a young family. The private head includes a proper vanity and shower, presenting yacht level convenience in a compact, easy to manage package.

On deck, wide sidedecks and substantial rails encourage confident movement when docking or tending lines at sunset, and the open aft cockpit is tailored for social moments—al fresco meals, evening drinks, or gearing up for a swim. The transom design keeps the water close at hand for effortless access to the day’s adventures, while quality finishes and a robust build reflect the standard of

care serious owners appreciate.

With a practical 225 gallon fuel capacity and 45 gallons of freshwater, this cruiser is prepared for genuine weekend independence. Combining Sea Ray's hull design, durable fiberglass construction, and the uncomplicated appeal of twin outboards, this 37' presents a versatile, stylish platform: graceful at idle, composed in a breeze, and eminently liveable as an express cruiser, sport cruiser, cabin cruiser, weekender, family cruiser, or compact motor yacht.
