## **OVERVIEW**

We are proud to introduce PENROSE, a graceful Lobster 35 from Cantieri Gagliotta, whose lines and craftsmanship are matched by purposeful engineering. Propelled by twin Mercury diesel engines producing 270 hp apiece, she slips to a comfortable cruising speed of 26 knots and carries an approximate range of 250 miles, marrying spirited performance with real-world capability. Her deep V hull and the SeaKeeper 2 stabilization system work in concert to ensure a dry, composed ride so that every moment aboard is enjoyed in comfort.

Deck spaces invite relaxation and conviviality: a sumptuous bow tanning area welcomes sunlit repose, while aft in the cockpit a U-shaped seating arrangement at the stern surrounds a convertible table that effortlessly becomes an expansive lounging surface for friends and family. An outdoor galley positioned just behind the helm seating keeps culinary life al fresco and convenient, while below decks well-appointed, air-conditioned sleeping quarters and a full head located at the front of the yacht provide privacy and refinement.

## **DETAILED DESCRIPTION**

#### **Overview**

Penrose, the 2024 Lobster 35 crafted by Cantieri Gagliotta, is a stunning Italian vessel that seamlessly integrates reliable American systems to deliver an exceptional yachting experience; powered by twin Mercury 270 hp diesel engines, she offers a smooth cruise speed of 26 knots and a top speed in excess of 30 knots, with a range of approximately 250 miles that effortlessly accommodates runs to the Bahamas from South Florida, while the ride remains dry, quiet and comfortable, further enhanced by the SeaKeeper 2 gyro stabilization system. When docked, shore power is supplied via a 30 amp cord, and at sea the yacht is powered by a diesel generator or inverter, with ample refrigerated storage, an ice maker, a cooktop and a sink ensuring all culinary needs are covered; below deck the air-conditioned cabin provides a comfortable bed and a fully equipped head, creating a luxurious retreat. Designed for entertainment, the layout features a generous tanning pad on the bow and a cockpit with U-shaped seating that encircles a versatile table adjustable to multiple levels—lying flush with the deck, raised to cocktail or dining height, or transformed into a sun pad with a filler cushion—while the deep V hull guarantees stability and the joystick control with Skyhook supplies precise maneuverability, making the Lobster 35 a masterpiece of design and engineering.

#### Helm

The helm of this vessel is a masterclass in design and functionality, a fully equipped command center for the discerning captain featuring a two-person seat with a flip-up forward section that allows comfortable standing or, when folded down, relaxed seated operation; the dash pod is dominated by a

full-function twelve-inch Garmin display conveniently placed in the upper section while a smaller eight-inch Mercury display sits just above the tiltable steering wheel, and the controls for the Lewmar bow thruster and Lenco trim tabs, complete with position indicator lights, are within easy reach to ensure precise maneuvering. Engine controls including throttle and gears are positioned outboard for ergonomic access, with the Mercury joystick offering Skyhook and autopilot control located just forward to provide an exceptionally comfortable driving position and outstanding sight lines; to port there is additional bench seating and above a manually operated sunroof admits natural light and fresh air, while the three-sided house preserves calm pressure so that the lower cabin's air conditioning remains perceptible underway. Additional appointments include a Garmin VHF remote microphone and separate speaker with volume control, an analog compass, a built-in teak footrest, USB power ports, windshield wipers and a teak deck for both function and aesthetic warmth, while storage is abundant with starboard bench seating housing stowage and a Vitrifrigo refrigerator drawer and an Isotherm ice maker positioned outboard of the helm seat, and deck hatches provide access to the generator, SeaKeeper and further storage so everything you need is at hand.

## **Summer galley**

Located aft of the helm seat and integrated within the same module, the summer galley is a well-appointed area of convenience and refined functionality featuring a two-burner cooktop and a stainless steel sink, both elegantly concealed beneath a hinged teak counter for a seamless, stylish appearance; the galley also includes a Vitrifrigo refrigerator and generous storage to keep provisions and serviceware organized, and the entire space is thoughtfully sheltered by the aft end of the hardtop, offering protection from the elements while you prepare meals and entertain guests.

## Cockpit

Positioned just aft of the hardtop's protection, the cockpit is a versatile and inviting space designed for both relaxation and functionality, featuring large U-shaped seating with upholstered cushions for generous guest comfort and storage beneath the side seats while the aft section provides access to the engine room. A retractable table integrated into the teak deck can be elevated with an electric lift when needed, creating a perfect setting for dining or socializing, and the adaptable cockpit cushions allow multiple configurations depending on the boat's mission; the center aft section of the seating is finished in the same exquisite teak as the deck and, when not covered by a cushion, serves as a practical step to facilitate movement over the transom and onto another teak-covered step leading to the seamlessly integrated teak swim platform. Forward of the seating a clever cocktail table folds out from the wall between forward and aft seats on the port side, offering an additional surface for drinks and snacks, while the teak decks continue to the side decks with teak toe rails enhancing both appearance and utility, making the cockpit a harmonious blend of style and practicality ideal for entertaining and enjoying the open water.

#### Cabin

Descending a few stairs behind a sliding door from the helm area, you enter the spacious, air-conditioned cabin and head, an inviting interior crafted for comfort and functionality that is ideal for extended weekend trips for two; the cabin offers a V-berth convertible into a large double berth with the addition of a filler cushion, upholstered seating aft of the berths on both sides for relaxed lounging, and abundant storage including a hanging locker and open shelving that houses the electrical panel to keep essentials organized. On the starboard side, concealed behind elegant leather wall panels, the full head includes a

freshwater toilet, sink, counter, storage and shower, while overhead lighting and port and starboard reading lights create a warm atmosphere, and portlights with a deck hatch allow natural light to filter in with curtains providing privacy as required. The cabin's electrical panel permits AC switching among shore power, generator and inverter with a remote control panel for the generator, ensuring seamless power management during your voyage, and the thoughtful design and luxurious appointments make the cabin a comfortable retreat for enjoying the tranquility of the open water.

#### **Foredeck**

The foredeck of this vessel is a thoughtfully designed space that combines functionality with relaxation, accessible from the side decks on either side of the house and featuring a large tanning area situated atop the cabin upholstered in the same high-quality material as the helm and cockpit cushions for a cohesive and luxurious feel; at the forward section of the foredeck a windlass and cleats provide the essential equipment for anchoring and mooring, making this area both practical for vessel handling and a perfect vantage for sunbathing and enjoying open sea views.

### Mechanical

The mechanical systems of this yacht are engineered to deliver exceptional performance and comfort, centered on two robust Mercury 3.0 V6 270 hp diesel engines that provide reliable power and efficiency and are complemented by a Mercury Joystick with Skyhook function for precise control and easy docking; electrical generation is handled by a 3.2 kW diesel generator to ensure a steady supply for onboard systems, and an inverter adds further flexibility in power management. Stability is a hallmark thanks to the SeaKeeper 2 gyrostabilizer, which minimizes roll and enhances comfort across

sea states, while a bow thruster aids in close quarters maneuvering. For onboard comfort and convenience the yacht includes cabin air conditioning, a water heater and an ice maker, two refrigerators for ample provisioning storage and underwater lights that add both elegance and visibility during night operations, combining power, efficiency and luxury for extended voyages.

## **Navigation**

The navigation systems on this yacht are designed to provide precision, ease and reliability for a seamless journey, centered on a Garmin chart plotter that offers detailed, accurate mapping and supported by a Mercury full function display which supplies comprehensive engine and system data. For hands-free cruising the vessel is equipped with an autopilot system to maintain course with minimal manual input, and communication is delivered through a Garmin VHF radio paired with a dedicated speaker with volume control for clear, adjustable audio. The onboard audio system with Bluetooth connectivity ensures entertainment is always at hand, while maneuverability is further supported by the bow thruster joystick for precise control in tight spaces and Lenco trim tab controls for optimal attitude and performance; a traditional compass is retained as a reliable backup, together composing a navigation suite that makes every outing smooth, safe and enjoyable whether exploring new waters or cruising familiar routes.

#### **Covers**

The yacht is equipped with a comprehensive set of covers designed to protect and enhance the vessel's features, including a bow cushion cover to keep the forward seating immaculate, a night protection tent for overnight coverage that offers peace of mind when the yacht is not in use, dedicated covers for the helm and cooking area to preserve condition and functionality, and a separate helm cover for added protection of the control area; a windshield cover helps maintain clear visibility by preventing debris and weather-related wear, while a sunshade tent with Inox poles creates a comfortable retreat from strong sun. The cockpit is protected with a cover featuring a roll-up center to allow access and ventilation while still providing coverage, and together these protective elements are essential for maintaining the yacht's appearance and readiness for the next adventure.
