DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Manufacturer provided description

The 380 Outrage® redefines versatility with a full spectrum, pinnacle experience that performs with equal poise as an offshore fishing platform, an entertaining dayboat, a refined yacht tender, or any combination thereof, inviting owners to enjoy everything from serious sportfishing to leisurely days with family and friends. A roomy, notched bow welcomes guests with expansive seating and generous stowage beneath, while the cockpit is arranged around a new aft facing couch paired with an optional removable table and an optional Summer Kitchen upgrade that adds a grill for lingering lunches and social gatherings. Boston Whaler's precision engineered hull harmonizes with twin Mercury® 600 HP engines to deliver remarkable efficiency, unwavering reliability, and smooth, predictable handling offshore, and peace of mind comes standard through GOST Phantom G4 technology, which monitors onboard systems and vessel position via satellite to provide round the clock remote security. For effortless close quarters control, select Joystick Piloting as an option to ease docking and maneuvering, and benefit from serious angler amenities such as a sixty gallon transom livewell, a converting leaning post and a wealth of strategically placed rod holders, while cavernous garage storage beneath the bow lounge swallows dive tanks, life jackets and more. The air conditioned helm deck pampers the captain and two companions with bolster seating and fold down armrests beneath a fully integrated hardtop that shields from the elements, and dual widescreen helm displays merge state of the art Garmin navigation with full control of the stereo and the Mercury propulsion system. Below, a spacious, air conditioned cabin features a fully enclosed head for added comfort and privacy, and underway a Seakeeper gyro stabilizing system calms the sea's motion while a

Premium Audio System elevates every moment aboard.

Storage/exterior

Purposeful storage and meticulous exterior detailing make the 380 Outrage® eminently practical for long days on the water, beginning with a dedicated bow anchor locker with drains that keeps ground tackle tidy and accessible, and insulated in floor fishboxes with pump out—two aft and one forward—that preserve the day's catch with cold, contained storage. Lifejacket stowage or an optional canvas enclosure compartment is integrated into the hardtop, while a lockable console front compartment is specifically sized to hold two five gallon buckets, offering organized space for lines and gear. Under the bow seating, illuminated stowage appointed with LED lighting invites easy access at any hour, complemented by under gunnel cockpit shelves that secure additional equipment, and along the helm deck side coaming pockets with storage nets and blue LED accent lighting keep essentials within reach, mirrored by bow side coaming pockets with their own storage and accent illumination. An insulated compartment beneath the aft facing seat includes a drain and an insulated sealed lid with a livewell upgrade available, and when the day is done a sleek black Sunbrella canvas cover package protects the boat in style.

Hardtop/ windshield system

The fully integrated hardtop and glass enclosure elevate both comfort and capability, starting with two recessed flood lights in the hardtop that brilliantly illuminate the cockpit and a single recessed flood light that lights the bow for safe movement in low light, while a custom powder coated aluminum support frame is integrated into the deck to preserve unobstructed walkways and a port side ladder leads to a hardtop hatch for easy access. Six recessed blue LED courtesy lights set a refined mood and one recessed two color LED chart

light in red and white provides practical illumination for navigation, and practical storage is built into the hardtop with lifejacket and canvas enclosure compartments plus a lockable electronics box, complemented by installed Taco Grand Slam outriggers and a spread of thirteen rod holders for productive days of sportfishing. A tempered curved glass windshield with an electrically actuated vent meets tempered full height side glass to deliver clear, protected sightlines, a windshield defogger integrated into the hardtop keeps visibility pristine, and for shade on demand a deployable bow sunshade and an aft retractable sunshade offer flexible protection from the sun.

Couch/leaning post

At the heart of the cockpit, a versatile couch and leaning post module serves anglers and entertainers alike, anchored by a prep station work surface clad in elegant teak with four stainless steel drink holders and a durable poly cutting board, framed by three well placed grab rails to ensure secure movement aboard. A stainless steel pull out refrigerator/freezer drawer provides approximately 1.75 cubic feet of capacity for chilled provisions, while a starboard side drawer system offers three storage drawers for tackle and tools, and three helm and companion bolster style seats with fold down armrests deliver long range comfort—the center seat is electrically actuated while the side seats slide fore and aft manually—augmented by a port side fold down footrest and a convenient 120 V outlet to support appliances and devices.

Cabin interior

Below deck, thoughtful appointments create a cool, quiet retreat designed for comfort and convenience, beginning with a dual USB receptacle paired with two 120 V outlets and an air conditioner with dash outlets delivering twelve

thousand BTU of climate control to ensure a comfortable environment in warm conditions. The convertible settee transforms into a double berth with easy to clean fabric upholstery, while fold down seat backs in durable material create a flat surface for flexible storage conversion, and underfoot solid teak flooring lends timeless warmth and elegance. Lighting is soothing yet functional, with blue diffused LED courtesy lights and four switchable white LED overhead lights, and convenience is enhanced by a microwave, two opening portholes and three glazed overhead and side elements that act as a skylight and sidelights to fill the cabin with daylight. Abundant storage includes cabinets and dedicated rod stowage for four six and a half foot and two seven and a half foot rods, and a refined vanity with a custom vessel sink and a discreet trash receptacle completes this welcoming space.

Enclosed head

The fully enclosed head blends refinement with everyday practicality, featuring a fiberglass compartment fitted with a frosted acrylic locking door for privacy and a hinged solid teak toilet cover that adds warmth to the finish, while a dedicated shower wand and sprayer deliver refreshing rinses and an integrated toilet paper holder keeps essentials tidy. The Vacu Flush® toilet connects to a holding tank with a vent filter, supports overboard discharge where permitted, and allows convenient dockside pump out, and additional storage drawers are available with the caveat that they are incompatible with the freezer plate option.

Mechanical

Confidence underway begins with power and systems engineered to perform, anchored by twin white Mercury® V12 Verado 600 HP engines with Dual Joystick Piloting that deliver effortless maneuvering and precise control, fed by

a 445 gallon aluminum fuel tank for impressive range. Automatic bilge pumps manage dewatering with authority—rated at 1100 GPH in the berth area and 2000 GPH in the bilge—backed by a high water bilge pump with visual and audible alarm at 2000 GPH, while electrical systems offer robust multi stage smart charging at 12 V with chargers rated at 40 amp and 50 amp, five battery trays with remote switches and automatic charging/paralleling relays, and LED lighting in the cockpit and machinery spaces to ensure reliable illumination. Mechanical integrity is reinforced by a bonding system for underwater through hull fittings, cast bronze through hulls and seacocks below the waterline and cast stainless steel through hulls above it, complemented by stainless steel propellers and an electric trumpet horn. Trim and running attitude are dialed in through electric dual ram trim tabs with indicators and electric drive trim, while Mercury's Dynamic Running Surface self leveling tab system further refines behavior underway. Freshwater amenities include a pressurized hot and cold system with dockside hookup and a sixty gallon tank with tank level indication integrated into VesselView, a manifold with individual valves per circuit, hot and cold sink and shower in the console and pull out showers at the transom and the dive door, and both freshwater and raw water washdowns with stainless steel spigots in the aft cockpit and, for freshwater, in the anchor compartment as well. Ship's power is provided by a low emissions Panda Generator gas unit rated at 7.5 kW, 120 V, 60 Hz, equipped with a fire suppression system, automatic operation with manual override and presently showing 174 hours, while navigation and utility features include LED navigation lights recessed in the hardtop, dual 30 amp shore power inlets with isolation transformers, a transducer pocket in the hull bottom for flush mounting B260/B275 transducers, a water heater and a windshield wiper with wash system. Anchoring is handled with a windlass controlled by a handheld remote, a three hundred foot rode with an anchor swivel and a thirty five pound anchor integrated into the bow on a polished stainless steel bow roller.


