OVERVIEW

A striking example in the Sport Fisherman category, this 2020 38-foot Scout merges offshore capability with refined onboard luxury. Her deep-V hull, conceived and executed by Scout Boats, slices through offshore conditions with assurance while a generous 12-foot beam promotes a composed, level motion. Propelled by quad Mercury outboards, she delivers immediate throttle response, reaches an exhilarating top end of up to 54 knots and settles comfortably into a 30-knot cruise, all underscored by the quiet confidence of advanced fiberglass construction and a hull engineered for true bluewater work.

Designed for anglers who insist on uncompromised comfort, the deck is arranged to provide a clear, obstruction-free cockpit that supports serious fishing with dedicated provisions for live bait, chilled storage and plentiful rod organization. Broad walkarounds and secure footing keep movement easy and safe, while a commanding helm maintains control when the action peaks. A substantial 400-gallon fuel capacity extends range and efficiency for longer runs to productive grounds, and every surface reflects a commitment to functionality without sacrificing a premium finish—durable, slick fiberglass underfoot and precise detailing throughout. Below decks, Scout Boats' tasteful interior accommodates overnighting with a comfortable berth for two and a private head, backed by a practical 55-gallon water capacity that keeps the cabin a calm, modern refuge after a day offshore. Lying in the United States and built to the standards discriminating owners expect, this versatile sportfishing motor yacht is equally at home chasing pelagics at dawn or slipping away for an elegant weekend cruise.

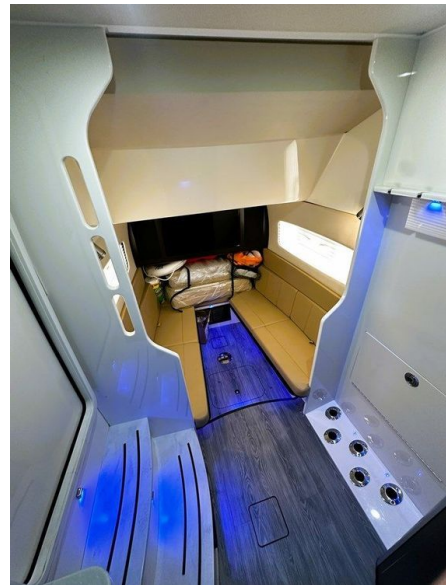

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Scout 380 LXF

Previously employed as the tender to a larger yacht and maintained by a dedicated full-time crew, this Scout 380 LXF arrives with every factory option fitted and shows like a meticulously kept yacht tender. Notable equipment includes a side dive door platform, SeaKeeper gyro stabilization, an icemaker, an aft shade and the highly sought-after quad engine package. Its broad aft platform gives the boat the presence and feel of a much larger center console, while the quad 350 hp Verados bring her onto plane almost instantly and provide assured performance, regularly exceeding 50 mph. The owner already has a new vessel in tow and is motivated to sell.

The 380 is a study in refined innovation where advanced systems, high-performance engineering and upscale styling meet through careful design and construction. It is supplied with an impressive suite of standard features, including the standard SeaKeeper Gyro Stabilizer, while the award-winning optional equipment elevates its capabilities. Electrically actuated articulating rocket launchers and an electronically actuated convertible hideaway entertainment station that doubles as a mezzanine seat are unprecedented on a coastal fishing platform, distinguishing this model from its peers. Scout's epoxy-infused, double-stepped, fuel-efficient hull constructed with Carbon Fiber/E-Glass and the optional hydraulic port-side beach platform finished with synthetic teak add both practical function and refined character to the boat.
