OVERVIEW

Step aboard this striking 2017 Galeon 385 HTS, a semi enclosed sport yacht and hardtop express cruiser that pairs dynamic performance with refined onboard living. Its sleek silhouette is complemented by a full glass sunroof and expansive hullside glazing, producing a contemporary interior flow that marries luxury finishes with practical arrangements. Official dimensions list an LOA of roughly 40'3" and a beam of 12'10", while the overall length registers effectively around 44'. Propulsion is provided by twin Volvo Penta D6 diesel inboards driving sterndrives, a reliable combination that yields assured handling and an engaging ride.

Fueling extended coastal runs, the yacht carries approximately 251 gallons of diesel, about 119 gallons of freshwater and a holding tank capacity near 37 gallons. Performance reaches into the mid 30 knot range, and with roughly 1,070 hours on the engines the thorough 1,000 hour service has already been completed for added peace of mind. Below decks two inviting cabins and two well appointed heads display elegant walnut joinery and generous headroom, while large skylights and panoramic windows fill the living spaces with natural light.

The exterior deck plan is equally thoughtful, featuring a hydraulic dinghy garage, a teak swim platform that simplifies water access and modern electronics at the helm. Docking and close quarters handling are made intuitive by joystick control integrated with the sterndrive system—without pods—allowing precise, effortless maneuvers. Recent maintenance and upgrades elevate this Galeon into a true turnkey vessel: brand new outdrives have just been installed, new air conditioning units now cover every zone from helm to cabins, and a new generator provides dependable ship's power for relaxed weekends or longer passages.

What distinguishes this 385 HTS is the combination of contemporary Galeon

styling, a rich walnut interior trimmed with premium details, and multiple major systems effectively renewed for immediate enjoyment. Whether island hopping, slipping away for a weekend, or entertaining guests in style, she delivers confidence, comfort and performance in equal measure. 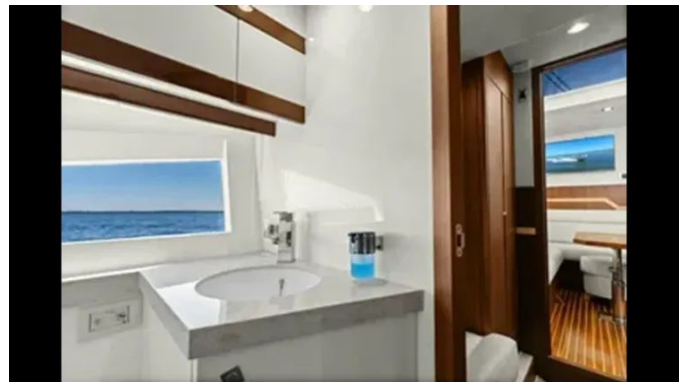


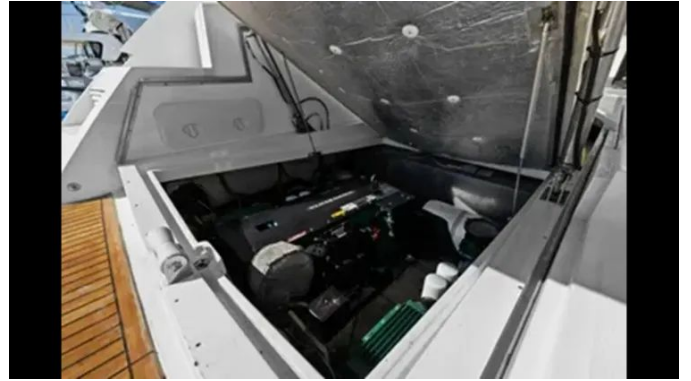














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Every surface aboard the 385 HTS has been carefully considered and elevated with subtle luxury touches: closets lined in soft Alcantara suede, a backlit vanity seamlessly set into the master stateroom bulkhead, and a finely crafted inlay on the lower-deck salon dining table that speaks to bespoke attention. Natural light has been prioritized throughout the design—a large sunroof sits above the helm, skylights illuminate the cabins and the master head shower, expansive hull-side windows pour daylight into the lower deck, and an expansive one-piece windshield welcomes the sun while providing shelter from the elements. As the most compact model from Galeon offered in the United States, the 385 HTS nevertheless upholds the marque's hallmark fit and finish, premium materials, and exacting workmanship found on its larger sisters, and it is equally adept at relaxed cruising and stylish entertaining, executing both with effortless flair.

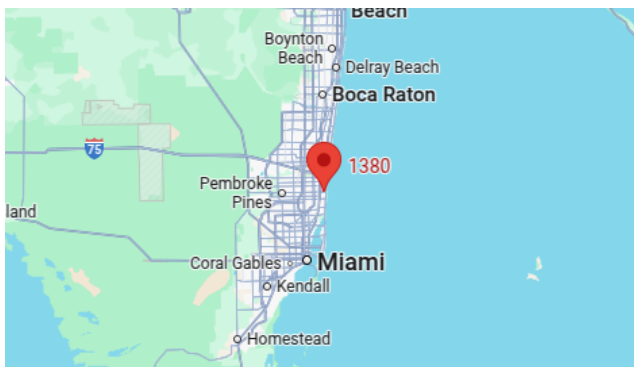
