The Ribco Venom 39 stands as an elite luxury performance rigid inflatable (RIB) that fuses heritage, a commanding presence, and genuine blue water capability, flourishing as a superyacht tender, chase vessel, or sumptuous dayboat. Celebrated for its sculpted silhouette, exacting European craftsmanship, and an assertive deep V hull, the Venom 39 pairs thrilling velocity with composed comfort, inspiring confidence to run fast across varied seas—equally adept at delivering adrenaline at the helm or unhurried relaxation at anchor—confirming its stature as a distinguished offshore powerboat and sport cruiser.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Key features

The 2023 Ribco Venom 39 is a high-performance luxury RIB defined by an ultra Deep-V performance hull and a Deep-V design engineered for comfort, speed, and unwavering confidence in open water, delivering an aggressive offshore character with premium build quality. Twin COX Marine 300 HP diesel engines, lightly used with low hours, combine with a 700 L fuel capacity to provide impressive range and genuine day cruising flexibility. Thoughtful practicalities include a hard top complemented by a full cover package, underwater lights that add drama after dusk, and enhanced situational awareness with AIS and a FLIR night vision camera, while onboard comfort is assured by an electric toilet within a carefully arranged cabin. Purpose built for both sport and style, the boat is equipped with live bait and catch boxes with seawater flushing pumps, four built in fishing rod holders, and six dive cylinder holding supports discreetly located beneath the aft seating, creating a Venom 39 that thrills on the run and reassures at anchor.

Aft cockpit and swim platform area

A wide, open aft deck invites effortless boarding and watersports, with an aft ladder providing easy, safe access to the sea and a layout that flows with the natural rhythm of a true day boat, giving guests unobstructed space to move confidently around the cockpit and fully enjoy every moment on the water.

Main cockpit and social zone

The main cockpit is finished with refined teak decking and anchored by a handcrafted teak cockpit table, creating an inviting social zone for entertaining

and relaxed cruising, while generous, sculpted seating delivers lasting comfort and a comprehensive deck cover package — including a front cover, a rear area seating cover, a console cover, and a stern sun bed cover — keeps every surface protected between adventures.

Helm station

The helm station presents a premium layout with upgraded electronics and intuitive controls centered on a Gussi Italia steering wheel and an electro-hydraulic steering system that delivers precise, effortless handling, accompanied by essential safety and navigation equipment including navigation lights, a FLIR night-vision camera, an AIS transponder, and a powerful searchlight, while practical features such as dedicated anchor control and a seawater outlet for deck washdown simplify operations at anchor and after the run.

Hardtop / shade

The robust hard top casts composed shade and is fitted with side curtains to extend shelter as conditions change, while a solar panel mounted on the T-Top provides quiet, steady trickle charging to keep onboard systems maintained between outings.

Forward lounge and sunpad area

Forward, a generous seating and sunpad area is purpose-built for lingering at anchor, featuring a front sun bed with a smooth lift system and a sun net fitted on the T-Top for added shade, offering an elegant and spacious retreat that preserves the boat's sporty profile underway while creating a serene place to unwind.

Interior / cabin

The interior cabin is thoughtfully arranged for a comfortable weekender experience, framed by a fixed windscreen with a wiper for clear visibility, and equipped with a practical locker, a convenient hatch, and well placed cabin lights to support indulgent day trips and occasional short overnights.

Head

A fully enclosed head with an electric toilet offers practical privacy and convenience for family and guests, elevating comfort through the day and on longer outings.

Construction

Constructed in glass reinforced polyester using a single skin hand lay up process, the structure gains rigidity from GRP stringers, strength and controlled weight from seven bulkheads in a GRP and honeycomb sandwich, and lasting integrity from a transom built as a GRP and marine plywood sandwich, delivering a stiff, seaworthy platform designed for offshore demands.

Tubes

The tubes are crafted from premium Hypalon/Neoprene fabric on a polyester 1670 dtex base, divided into seven chambers for safety redundancy and rated to a working pressure of 250 mbar to preserve shape and reliable performance across varied conditions.

Fuel system

Range and balance are delivered by two negative grounded fuel tanks with a combined capacity of 700 L, split evenly into Fuel Tank A at 350 L and Fuel Tank B at 350 L, with durable polyethylene construction for long term, corrosion free service.

Electrical system

A DC 12V two wire negative grounded electrical architecture underpins onboard reliability, supported by two maintenance free 108 Ah batteries and one service maintenance free 214 Ah battery managed via battery switches, with integrated navigation lights to ensure safe, compliant operation after dark.

Audio and entertainment

Set the soundtrack for every passage with WiFi music connectivity feeding a refined sound system and four strategically placed speakers that deliver balanced, immersive audio throughout the cockpit and social areas.

Lighting

Underwater lights enhance ambiance at anchor and after dusk, while a powerful searchlight extends visibility and confidence for night operations and long evening passages.

Anchoring / deck gear

The anchoring arrangement includes a dedicated anchor with intuitive anchor control and a seawater outlet for efficient deck washdown, simplifying setup

and cleanup so time on the water is maximized.

Thrusters / handling

A bow thruster removes the stress from tight maneuvers, making docking and close quarters handling relaxed and precise even in shifting winds and busy marinas.

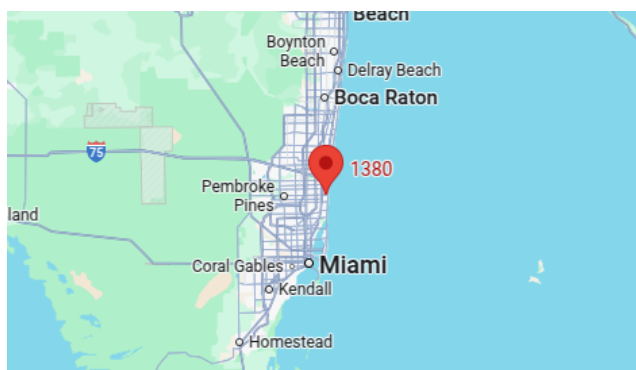
