OVERVIEW

The 2023 Yellowfin 39 Offshore is more than a mere fishing boat; as a luxury center-console sportfisher it is crafted for serious offshore ambitions. Propelled by quad Mercury Verado 400 outboards, the 39-foot platform carries an 11'6" beam that imparts exceptional stability and poise when seas grow challenging. Yellowfin's celebrated hull shape yields a smooth, dry, and assured ride that keeps every angler focused on the bite rather than the weather. Vast deck areas, abundant storage, and a helm outfitted with the latest navigation and fishing technology combine to make this vessel a tournament-ready bluewater fishing yacht, marrying high performance, practical functionality, and onboard comfort, with factory engine warranty in place through 2031.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Features

A white motor upgrade crowns the power package, paired with MERCURY JPO Quad Helm Master (joystick) for effortless precision and a steady COMPASS to keep you true, while the 39 console solid glass provides a seamless, wind-cutting barrier around the helm and a console interior five rod rack with sixteen rod holders on the hard top ready for any spread. The dual-row extra-large hard top carries hardtop navigation running lights, three LUMITEC RAZOR 18' lightbars, LED spreader lights and LED multi-color lights on the underside, all supported by a powdercoated white hardtop base with finger-grip handles and powdercoated white hardtop grab rails. Offshore versatility is assured with GEMLUX Bluewater outrigger bases, GEMLUX Coastal Kingfish rod holders, GEMLUX 22ft collapsible outriggers and the GEMLUX Coastal Shade, while purposeful fishability continues with twenty-four titanium rod holders along the gunnel and six titanium rod holders on the transom, a GARLICK boarding ladder, powdercoated white transom grab handles and powdercoated white bow rails. Anglers benefit from four KRISTAK reel outlets, livewell lights (blue), midship tackle boxes (Mitchel Box), front tilt out storage boxes, and the BEST MARINE seachest (three pump), plus fishbox pumpouts—macerator/diaphragm and a floor livewell; the leaning post deluxe fishing station adds four leaning post cup holders, two leaning post rod holders, a leaning post five drawer tackle station and a leaning post foldout trash can, complemented by a coffin box with divider. Comfort and finish rise with two-tone deluxe interior GT boxing, a double diamond stitching package, YELLOWFIN triple helm seating and a knee pad on helm, while washdowns are both freshwater and saltwater, supported by 2-THREE BANK PRO CHARGING SYSTEM, an extra house battery and 2-SHADOWCASTER U/W light (blue), with

compartment courtesy lights throughout. Handling and safety are enhanced with a bow thruster and a deluxe head with overboard discharge, and styling is striking with a two-tone hull and front FWD shelf covers (white), with SEADEK in the deluxe fishing station. Communications and convenience include VHF antennas (white), TACO GRAND SLAM electric antenna holders and TACO GRAND SLAM electric flag holder, a FUSION radio inside console, a GARMIN SD card reader inside console and keys inside console, while the helm is rounded out by two VHF radios in console, a GARMIN camera aft facing and a bilge liner. For true offshore confidence you'll find a REVERE Offshore Elite 8/P valise SN (life raft), EPIRB ACR Cat-1 and EPIRB ACR Cat-2, plus an INMARSAT Isat Phone-2, and cold storage is amply covered by a YETI 45 bait cooler and a YETI 160 drink cooler.

Electronics

At the helm, twin GARMIN 8622 MFD screens command a GARMIN GSD26 sounder module and a GARMIN GCV20 scanning module, both fed by a GARMIN GT56UHD TH transducer and an AIRMAR R509LHW 3kW BB transducer, while long-range awareness is assured by the GARMIN GMR2524 XHD2 open array radar and the GARMIN GXM-54 Sirius/XM Weather module, with a GARMIN card reader and a GARMIN GC12 camera integrated cleanly into the console. Clear communications arrive via two GARMIN VHF 315 radios with RAM mic, and entertainment is handled by a FUSION WB670 stereo with a FUSION ERX-400 wired stereo remote; night vision is delivered by a FLIR M364C thermal visible IR camera directed with the FLIR JCU-2 joystick. Engine data and diagnostics are presented on the MERCURY VesselView 703 display, while security and monitoring are provided by the GOST NavTracker 2.0 with IR beams and a sensor on the console and battery doors for discreet, continuous protection.

Stereo

Premium sound is delivered by eight JL Audio 8.8" coaxial speakers and four JL Audio 10" subwoofer speakers, powered by two JL Audio MV1000/51 amplifiers that provide a rich, balanced output whether underway or at anchor, elevating onboard ambiance with clarity and bass authority.

Exterior and upholstery

The hull presents a striking palette with sides in Royal Blue contrasted by a Matterhorn White bottom, complemented by gloss white powdercoating and a black rubrail for crisp visual definition, while the upholstery specification features Classic Smooth Snow as the primary material with Premier Monaco two-tone accents finished with clear stitch color for a refined, durable presentation that marries aesthetics with rugged marine practicality.


