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OVERVIEW

The 2018 Invincible 39 Open is a refined embodiment of the offshore center console, maintained by a single owner and sheltered on a lift, with only 196 original hours on the clock and presenting in exceptional condition. Her vacuum bagged, cored hull features a tried and true two step running surface that delivers the speed, economy, and composure Invincible is known for, while the helm is appointed with twin 21 inch Garmin displays that interface with Garmin XHD2 radar, a bottom sounder, Garmin autopilot, and a Mercury SmartCraft engine screen, complemented by a bow thruster for effortless maneuvering and a premium Fusion/JL Audio entertainment system. Comfort and functionality are combined with triple bolstered helm seating, a three sided enclosure and recessed hardtop lighting, extensive seating and storage, and a private electric head. Built for serious bluewater fishing, she is equipped with carbon fiber outriggers, dual macerated fish boxes, 62 and 78 gallon livewells, a portside tuna/dive door, dedicated tackle organization, abundant rod holders and rocket launchers, plus fresh and saltwater washdowns. Four new batteries were installed in April 2026, and the sale includes a full boat cover plus three individual engine covers; with its ultra low hours, single owner history and comprehensive option package, this tournament capable 39 Open is a turnkey performance fishing yacht ready for its next voyage.

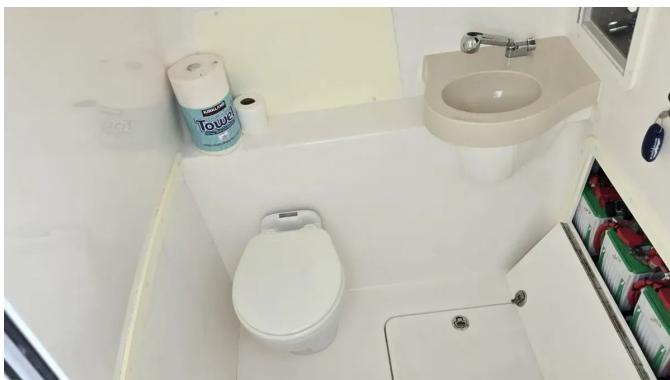












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electronics and navigation equipment

Navigation and onboard systems are appointed to the highest standard, centered on twin Garmin 21-inch chartplotters that incorporate HD radar and a bottom sounder, with a Garmin XHD2 radar array providing razor-sharp target resolution. Precision steering is managed by a Garmin autopilot, while bridge communication is handled through an ICOM command mic at the helm paired with a 4-inch Garmin remote speaker for crystal-clear transmissions; a Ritchie 5-inch compass offers a reliable magnetic reference. Entertainment is delivered via a Fusion MSUD755 satellite stereo into a finely balanced sound system that includes four JL Audio speakers in the bow, four JL Audio 7-inch speakers midship, two JL Audio 7-inch speakers aft, two JL Audio subwoofers midship and four JL stereo tweeters midship.

Electrical system

The DC electrical arrangement is anchored by four Group 27 Interstate batteries, installed new in April 2026, that furnish consistent onboard power; distribution and control are achieved through five battery switches complemented by two battery isolators to allow flexible management of energy flows. Corrosion risk is mitigated by a dedicated galvanic isolator, while a neatly organized DC distribution panel and an accurate battery voltage gauge provide clear, immediate monitoring. Recharging is performed by a Pro Nautic 12.40P battery charger for efficient return to full capacity, and when docked the system accepts shore power via a 124-volt shore power plug-in.

Deck equipment

Beneath a stout T-top supported by white powder-coated pillars sits a fiberglass hard top fitted with recessed LED illumination, complemented forward by an LED float light and aft by LED spreader lights; a three-sided Eisenglass enclosure and secure grab rails complete this protected helm environment. The command station is lavishly appointed with three helm seats that feature drop-down bolsters and arm rests, a stainless steel steering wheel with speed knob, a helm footrest and foam foot pad, and three convenient cup holders, while a forward helm bench with storage and an aft bench with storage expand seating options and two additional flip-down aft bench seats provide versatile accommodation. Generous under helm storage lockers keep gear organized and a port midship dive door affords effortless access to the water. The foredeck offers two lounge bench seats with storage, two bow cup holders, two bow line bins, recessed port and starboard bow rails, and a large bow in deck storage locker, supplemented by three midship in deck lockers for exceptional stowage capacity; the deck itself is finished with a nonskid sole and bow to stern coaming pads and is shielded by a stainless rub rail. The performance oriented two step hull is fitted with two aft stainless transom eyes, and mooring hardware is comprehensive with two eight inch pop up cleats at the bow, two eight inch pop up cleats at midship and two eight inch pop up cleats at the transom. Ground tackle provisions include an anchor locker, a stainless anchor guide, a stainless Bruce anchor with two hundred feet of rode and a thirty inch chain, a Quick anchor windlass and a spare Fortress anchor. Nighttime operation is enhanced by an ACRLED spotlight and two underwater lights, while fresh and saltwater washdowns add convenience. The enclosed head is appointed with a Raritan electric toilet, a helm sink with a pullout shower head, electric head pump out and a dedicated head light, and protection at the dock or underway is assured with a full boat cover and three individual engine covers.

Fishing equipment

Engineered for the discerning angler, the cockpit is laid out for effortless offshore performance, centered on a port midship tuna door that simplifies hauling larger fish aboard and supported by two fish boxes equipped with macerators to handle the day's catch. Taco-style outriggers fashioned from carbon fiber add lightweight strength to widen your spread, while a 62-gallon transom well with LED lighting and a 78-gallon in-deck well with LED lights keep bait lively and visible into the night. Storage and tackle management are comprehensive, with six rocket launchers mounted on the aft T-top, eight rod holders at the starboard console and twenty rod holders arrayed along the gunwales, alongside port and starboard tackle drawers that keep lines and lures neatly organized and immediately accessible. For quick cleanup and added flexibility during long trips, both fresh and saltwater washdowns are installed within easy reach.

Mechanical equipment and engine details

Designed to inspire confident handling, the yacht is fitted with a Quick bow thruster and K Plane-style trim tabs to provide exceptional maneuverability. Mercury clutch throttle controls with sync and trim, together with an engine kill lanyard, place responsive power management and safety at the helm. Real-time engine information is presented on the Mercury Smart Craft engine display, while helm feel and precision are refined by an UltraFlex tilt steering binnacle and Mercury hydraulic steering, tied together with stainless tie bars. Propulsion and longevity are ensured by four-blade stainless props, and fuel routing is managed through three fuel selector switches and three Mercury fuel filters that all feed into a sturdy SeaChest. Overall systems integrity and rapid dewatering capability are supported by five Rude bilge pumps, delivering reliable operation even in the most demanding conditions.

Other features, upgrades, and comments

Preserved with unwavering attention by its original owner, this vessel presents in exceptional condition after being kept on a lift and recording a mere 196 original hours. In April 2026 four new batteries were fitted to ensure dependable power reserves. The vacuum-bagged, cored hull imparts outstanding strength and rigidity, and combined with the attentive ownership and low hours, results in a superbly preserved yacht that stands distinctly apart.

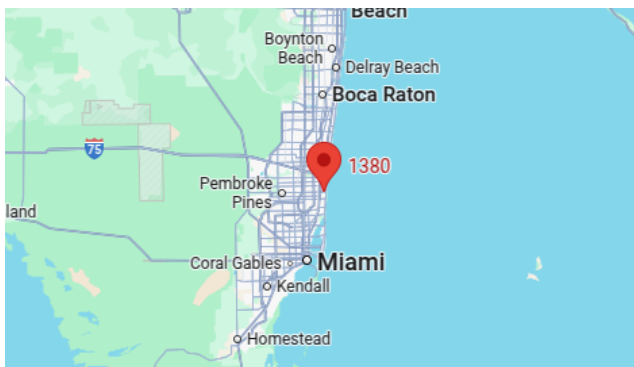
