OVERVIEW

The 2024 SeaVee 390Z stands as an exceptional luxury center console, marrying elegant lines with uncompromised capability; at 39 feet LOA its keen deep V hull and premium composite construction bestow poised balance, agile responsiveness, and the confidence required for offshore passages.

Propelled by quad Mercury V10 400 outboards, this sportfish ready performance powerboat generates exhilarating speed, precise handling, and the range to pursue offshore fishing grounds or to relish refined dayboat cruising.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2024 SeaVee 390Z

A tournament grade center console that blends unmistakable SeaVee poise with uncompromising offshore capability, the 2024 390Z arrives powered by Mercury Verado quad 400 V10 outboards in Standard Black, their thrust modulated by Livorsi high performance trim tabs for razor fine attitude control. The hull is finished in a custom Whisper Gray from waterline to cap, paired with a Black/Black insert rub rail and black pipework, while the main helm top underside carries the Whisper Gray accent to unify the aesthetic. Boarding and water access are effortless through a custom SeaVee dive door with integrated pull out dive ladder to port, supported by a white powder coated grip handle, and the console door opens smoothly on pneumatic actuation. Fresh and salt washdowns are covered with a freshwater system complete with hose, nozzle and a console sink with shower alongside a dedicated saltwater washdown, and hardcore fishability is engineered throughout: a dual box fishbox pump out strainer system with a Y valve for dual fishbox applications, drainage and a pump out strainer for an additional fishbox plus insulation and Y valve plumbing for that box. Fuel quality is assured by four upgraded Racor fuel/water separators and engine monitoring is delivered via a Mercury VesselView 703 seven inch display and an NMEA 2000 SmartCraft Gateway. Power management includes two extra AGM batteries and a quad engine battery charger with galvanic isolator, a 30 amp inlet, and a triple bank configuration with Echo Charge to keep systems primed. The purpose built fiberglass molded hard top carries six rod holders, forward and aft LED spreader lights and four multicolored LED dome lights, with dual molded in LED flood lights facing aft and a Rigid Marine 30" LED light bar forward for night runs, while Gemlux Blue Water outrigger bases support

22 ft black Gemlux Deluxe carbon fiber poles for extended reach. At the helm a 13" Edson wheel with black power knob presides over dual console organizers, a custom flush mount console surface with fiberglass modifications, a full half panel of black acrylic hosting flush mounted MFDs and a single row push button switch panel including windlass up/down control, complemented by under gunnel multicolor lighting and three SeaBlaze X2 underwater lights bathing the wake in RGBW. Comfort and functionality continue with a freshwater pull out shower on the port side, an electric head with holding tank and macerator pump out plus a Y valve for direct overboard discharge where permitted, and ground tackle handled by a windlass anchor system with 300' of rope and chain, helm and anchor locker switches and a dedicated bow windlass camera, while tight quarters control is aided by a bow thruster. Cockpit hardware is comprehensive with rod and cup holders arranged for optimal angles, two 30 amp outlet plugs for electric reels with covers and breakers, forward molded seating with electric reclining backrests and pull out stowage bins plus a bolster upgrade, an entertaining cockpit table with removable pedestal and embedded base, an oversized Captain's Edition helm seat/prep station paired with a deluxe rear facing mezzanine seat that includes a fixed cooler and tackle station side doors, removable L shaped seating port and starboard with a removable center aft section and a triple headrest/quad armrest leaning post to secure you when seas build. Protection and finish are equally considered with a three panel polycarbonate glass enclosure in white, coaming bolsters and non standard vinyl tailored to the boat's aesthetic, plus canvas and shade solutions including a two piece full boat cover fitted under the rub rail in Cadet Gray, four matching engine covers, Bahama Shade for both aft and forward cockpits in white upgraded with four TACO carbon fiber poles, and a port side drawer below the leaning post with square removable inserts for tackle organization; radar, VHF, anchor light and hard top accessories are finished in black and bow chocks on the cap are deleted for a clean foredeck. Electronics are best in class with a Garmin 424

xHD2 open array radar on its pedestal, two Garmin 8617 color GPS plotters with 17" touchscreen displays and card readers, a Garmin GSD 26 network sounder module and a Garmin CM599LH W two-three kW CHIRP thru hull transducer, supported by a Garmin GHP Reactor autopilot with Smart Pump for long runs and precise trolling. Sound is delivered by a JL Audio Premium Package with hard top speaker pods using Titanium speakers with Sport grilles set off by metallic trim rings, communications use one ICOM M400BB black box VHF radio in black paired to an eight foot Digital antenna and matching black mount complemented by a Poly Planar VHF external speaker in black, and modern charging needs are met with three dual charger sockets offering USB and USB C 2.0. Altogether this 390Z is a meticulously specified, performance driven SeaVee that turns every offshore run into a masterclass in speed, control and comfort.
