The 2015 Yellowfin 39 Offshore, proudly named Evil Tequila, is a refined bluewater sportfish that carries the famed Yellowfin pedigree forward, driven by triple Yamaha 350HP outboards and engineered as a performance center console powerboat. Capable of a 55-knot top end and an effortless 32-knot cruise, she pairs exhilarating speed and ample range with a purpose-built layout for serious offshore pursuits; a collapsible flybridge, a state-of-the-art Garmin suite, and comprehensive angling features make her as practical as she is commanding for tournament racing, dayboat excursions, and saltwater fishing.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Vessel walkthrough

Step aboard Evil Tequila and it is instantly clear that this is a full-fledged offshore fishing machine, true to the legendary Yellowfin pedigree, where every detail is honed for serious sportfishing. Forward, the bow is rigged with a deep drop drum-style windlass that excels at offshore bottom fishing, flanked by twin full-length lounge seats with abundant storage beneath, and every deck locker is lockable to keep gear secure; just aft, a twin seat at the forward end of the console adds welcome comfort for the run out. Inside the console, convenient instrument access keeps service simple while a well-appointed head with a freshwater sink elevates comfort on long days, and overhead the hardtop carries a versatile flybridge fitted with Yamaha controls, a Garmin GPS/Sounder repeater, a comfortable bench seat, and a fiberglass buggy top. Ingeniously built on knuckle joints, the flybridge folds flat or can be removed entirely for effortless trailering. The cockpit is purpose-built, with a generous prep station and dedicated tackle storage, clean access to the Quik MC2 Gyro Stabilizer through the aft hatch, and a starboard-side dive door that partners with a proper aft dive platform and ladder to make water entry and recovery effortless. From bow to transom every element serves function and performance, making Evil Tequila an exceptional choice for anglers who demand capability, comfort, and uncompromised seaworthiness.

Notable upgrades

Recent upgrades elevate capability and confidence offshore, including Garmin GPS 8622 units refreshed in October 2024 with advanced features, a GSD 25 Premium Sonar module for crisper bottom definition and fish targets, and retractable TOP GUN outriggers that deploy cleanly when the bite is on. Adding

peace of mind, the engines received comprehensive service in 11/2024 with all oils and filters replaced, ensuring the propulsion package is turnkey and ready.

Center console

At the heart of the helm, twin Garmin GPS 8622 displays consolidate Sounder, Radar, GPS, Autopilot, and full vessel instrumentation for intuitive command, delivering a streamlined, professional helm experience. Communications and awareness are bolstered by a Simrad VHF and FLIR units, while a GSD 25 Premium Sonar module, installed in October 2024, sharpens underwater detail and target separation to a professional standard, enabling confident tactical decisions on every drift and troll.

Electronics

The hardtop mounts a Garmin 4-foot sweep radar for long-range weather and traffic awareness, complemented by a FLIR thermal imaging system for clarity after dark, ensuring safety and situational awareness in all conditions.

Entertainment and crew morale are handled by a Fusion stereo system driving eight JL marine speakers for rich, deck-filling sound, while a Yamaha control screen keeps engine data front and center for quick reference.

Mechanical equipment & engine

Power comes from triple Yamaha 350HP outboard engines, engine year 2016 and installed in February 2017, showing 841hrs as of 01/13/2025, providing a potent and proven propulsion package. Ride quality is markedly enhanced by a Quik MC2 Gyro Stabilizer, while reliability is supported by twin RULE 2000 high-output aft bilge pumps. Fishing operations benefit from a transom baitwell system with interior lighting, and cleanup is effortless thanks to port

and starboard washdown systems.

Electrical system

A 30 AMP shore power connection feeds onboard systems, backed by four Odyssey AGM batteries with parallel switching for robust reserves and redundancy. Control is centralized through a C-Zone DC electrical panel, with battery isolation rotary switches conveniently positioned under the helm seat, and for safety at sea an ACR EPIRB stands ready.

Fishing and safety features

Serious anglers will appreciate 22 gunwale rod holders complemented by 17 passive rod holders, delivering expansive storage and spread options that suit tournament or bluewater tactics alike. A life raft in a bag adds a layer of preparedness, while a freshwater shower aft by the dive door makes rinsing off effortless after a day at sea. D/C LED cockpit floodlights illuminate nighttime action, and a 4-inch Ritchie compass provides the timeless, reliable heading reference every captain trusts.
