The eye-catching Ice Blue hull draws attention at every quay, a graceful silhouette that announces itself before the engines even speak. Propelled by triple Mercury 400 Verado outboards, this 39' Yellowfin slices through the water and leaves rivals behind with composed, effortless power.

When the sea builds, the Yellowfin's celebrated ride and clever deck arrangement continue to perform beyond expectations. Engineered for both dedicated anglers and those in search of sun-soaked leisure, the extra-wide beam yields a commodious, thoughtfully organized center console platform that balances operational efficiency with comfort.

Beneath the sleek lines lies serious functionality: vast storage, insulated fish boxes, and generous livewell capacity combine to make the boat a formidable Offshore Fishing, Sportfish, and Bluewater platform, while sumptuous seating and convivial social zones transform it into an elegant Dayboat for cruising and entertaining. It is a Performance Powerboat imbued with Sport Yacht refinement — equally appropriate as a Luxury Tender or a tournament-ready Fishing Yacht.

A practical stand-up head with shower brings welcome convenience between runs, extending comfortable days on the water without compromising speed, style, or capability.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Standard equipment

Thoughtfully engineered details define the experience from the moment you step aboard: Gemlux flush-mount cleats and a stainless-steel pop-up bow light set the tone, while under-gunwale courtesy lights create an inviting glow after dusk, and precision hydraulic power steering combines with plush console and combing cushions to elevate comfort for long days on the water. Rule baitwell pumps rated at 1100 gallons per hour keep live bait thriving alongside two Rule 2000 bilge pumps for confident dewatering, while stainless-steel D-rings, Gemlux two-inch gas fills, four Gemlux rod holders, and Gemlux ball valves underscore a premium hardware suite. Performance is refined by high-performance K Plane trim tabs and a lighted digital fly-by-wire switch panel, all backed by tinned copper wiring and Deutsch connectors to ensure reliable connectivity. An O-ring gutter system and Gemlux stainless-steel thru-hull fittings ensure dry, reliable operation. The T-top integrates seven rod holders, and utility abounds with a saltwater washdown, an aft eighty-gallon livewell, and a five hundred thirty Qt macerated fish box, while a generous forty gallons of fresh water support a convenient toilet and shower, completing a standard specification built for long days offshore.

Electronics

Integrated marine electronics deliver unwavering situational awareness and control: two GPS displays model G8622 anchor the helm and are complemented by the GSD26 2k CHIRP sounder module and a 4k x HD2 four-foot open array radar for long-range target discrimination, while communications are handled by two G215 VHF units and precision tracking comes via the GHP Reactor 40 with GHC 20 autopilot and onboard Garmin WiFi. Security and oversight are enhanced by the GOST 1.0 GPS tracking system, and entertainment is equally refined with a Fusion 300 stereo featuring Bluetooth and remote control, energized by a JL 1000/5 amplifier driving two JL subs and six JL speakers to deliver rich, deck-filling sound.

Build specifications

A striking Ice Blue hull meets a Matterhorn White bottom and a white rub-rail, framed by a solid console windshield for clear, quiet runs, while practical touches include two cup holders on the console, a standard leaning post with a rear-facing seat, and four additional cup holders to serve the cockpit. As specified for Yellowfin 39 – 39 Offshore, page two of nine, helm comfort is elevated with a double head rest Yellowfin helm seating arrangement, and fishing readiness is exemplified by three open-drawer tackle stations, an aft-side tackle station, and a fold-out trash can to keep the deck orderly, all supported by an extra house battery for dependable power. The powdercoated half tower hardtop features running lights, four LED multi-color hardtop lights, and two ShadowCaster multi-color lights, while the white, standard deluxe interior showcases a double-stitch diamond pattern on the seating with front shelf covers for a tidy finish, boarding is effortless via a Garelick ladder, and visibility to your bait is provided by a baitwell window. Offshore utility continues with fourteen standard titanium rod holders, a

battery charger configured for two batteries, a bow thruster for pinpoint maneuvering, practical Mitchell boxes, and a starboard dive door with ladder for easy water access.

Optional equipment

For those seeking an extra edge, equip the boat with Gemlux outriggers, a second VHF for redundant communications, and dedicated electric reel outlets, expand your horizons after dark with FLIR thermal imaging, and welcome guests with effortless comfort on the rear bench seating to make every offshore passage more capable and convivial.
