Thoughtful upgrades include a refreshed navigation suite, an onboard watermaker and a Seakeeper gyro stabilizer to ensure notably smoother passages, and she has been maintained to an impeccable standard as a distinguished trawler yacht.

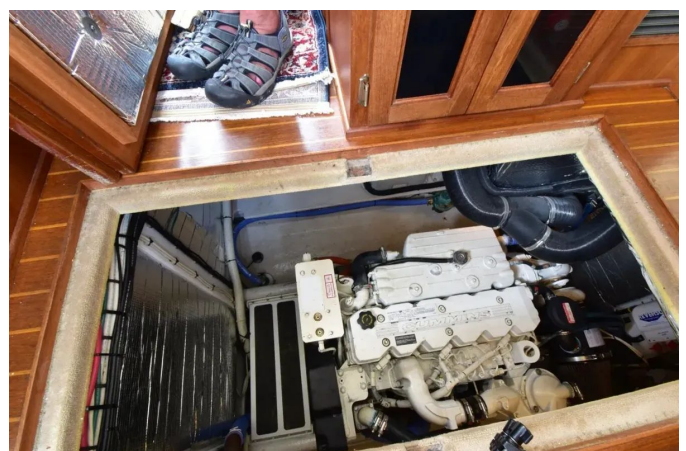














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Commissioned as a custom build for her original owner, this Nordic Tug 37 offers an intelligently arranged, efficient interior designed for a cruising couple yet readily adaptable to accommodate guests. The forward stateroom is fitted with a generous island berth, while the head provides a sizable, separate shower stall. In the salon a pull-out sofa converts to a double berth for occasional overnight visitors, and the expansive, well-equipped galley makes it simple to prepare gourmet meals for the crew. Kept exceptionally clean and meticulously maintained, this yacht also benefits from notable upgrades, including updated electronics, a water maker, and a SeaKeeper gyro stabilizer that enhances comfort underway.

Overview

Designed for relaxed long-distance cruising and gracious life aboard, this yacht blends proven mechanical systems with carefully selected upgrades and diligent maintenance. Propulsion is provided by a Cummins QSB5.9 HO 380 hp diesel that has logged 2,526 hours and turns a fixed four blade bronze propeller; a new shaft seal, cutlass bearing and rudder housing were completed in 2023. A factory installed 50 gallon auxiliary fuel tank increases total fuel capacity to 375 gallons, supporting an approximate cruising range of 700 nautical miles, and a Reverso oil change system simplifies routine servicing. Electrical power is assured by an Onan e QD 9 kW generator with 738 hours, dedicated start batteries for both the genset and main engine, plus four house batteries, all supported by twin 30 amp shore power inlets with cords and a Victron 3000 watt inverter added in 2024. Comfort and handling underway are enhanced by a Seakeeper 3 gyro stabilizer installed in 2025 and

a Lewmar bow thruster, while day to day convenience aboard includes a Pinnacle washer/dryer combo in a separate utility room, a Nova Kool fridge/freezer new in 2021, and three AC/reverse cycle heat units serviced in 2023. The galley is appointed with a Force Ten electric three burner stove and oven and a microwave, and domestic systems deliver hot and cold pressurized water to the shower, head and galley sinks, with the addition of a deck washdown and stern shower. A VacuFlush head rebuilt in 2021 and a SeaWater Pro watermaker producing seventeen GPH installed in 2024 complete the bluewater systems, and all scheduled maintenance is current — she is ready to depart for the Great Loop at a moment's notice.

On deck, a Lofrans Tigres electric anchor windlass handles a polished stainless steel CQR style anchor to ensure reliable holding, while the cabin top carries a dinghy crane with cradle and a 10 foot Bauer sailing dinghy driven by a Torqeedo 1107 electric motor; the crane's hydraulic cylinder was replaced in 2023. The navy blue hull paint applied in 2021 presents beautifully, and practical additions such as non skid applied to the coach roof with two kayak tie offs, windshield covers for anchoring or dockside use, and custom port covers enhance both safety and appearance. Navigation and communications are centered on a Raymarine E120 MFD with chartplotter, radar and fishfinder installed in 2024, supported by a Raymarine depthsounder and transducer new in 2023 and a Raymarine autopilot added in 2024. Entertainment and bridge electronics include flat screen TVs in the main salon (new in 2023) and the master stateroom, a Horizon VHF installed in 2021, and a stereo system new in 2023.

The interior is thoughtfully finished, beginning with a custom queen sized island berth and a warm ambiance highlighted by a bespoke teak and holly sole throughout. A custom salon dining table comfortably seats four, the head features a generously sized separate shower stall, and ventilation is excellent with screens fitted to the aft door, both side doors and overhead hatches to create an open, airy living space. Safety gear is comprehensive and in place,

including life jackets, fire extinguishers, electric horns, a Halon engine room extinguisher and flares, offering peace of mind whether cruising coastal waters or embarking on extended passages.

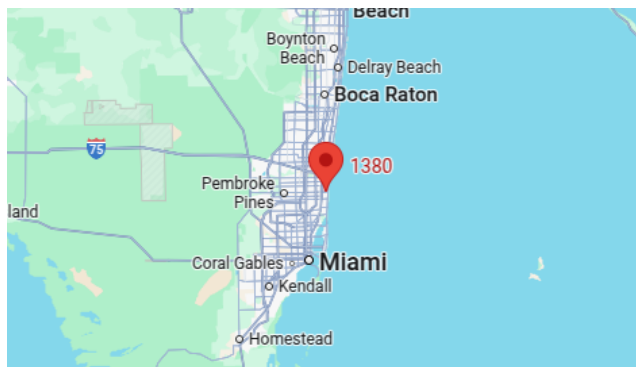
