Exceptionally maintained and comprehensively equipped, this 2023 39' Yellowfin center console is propelled by quad Mercury V10 400s that have logged just 120 hours and is complemented by a cutting edge Garmin electronics suite. The layout provides expansive forward seating and a bespoke removable wrap, and she has been tended to with meticulous, uncompromising care. Essentially indistinguishable from new, this offshore sportfishing platform offers a rare opportunity for its next owner to acquire a low hour, turn key luxury vessel at a fraction of the current cost to build.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Standard features

Crafted for anglers who demand both performance and refinement, this yacht pairs a sturdy hardtop with rear supports and a T top fitted with seven rod holders, while spreader lighting and under gunwale courtesy lights illuminate the deck for confident operation around the clock. The hydraulic helm is enhanced by a Gemlux Belloca stainless steel steering wheel and intuitive C Zone digital switching, and accommodations for long days include an ergonomic leaning post, plush console and coaming cushions, and a private head discreetly housed within the console. Fishing capability is uncompromised with fourteen Gemlux titanium rod holders plus additional Gemlux rod mounts, titanium cleats and through hulls, Gemlux flush mount cleats, Gemlux stainless steel thru hull fittings, Gemlux ball valves and Gemlux two inch gas fills. Live bait versatility comes from a plumbed transom livewell, a second plumbed livewell in the leaning post and an expansive eighty gallon aft livewell, all served by Rule 1100 GPH baitwell pumps and backed up by two Rule 2000 bilge pumps. Cold storage and catch management are exceptional with an insulated fish box equipped with a Gulper pump and a 530 quart macerated fish box, complemented by forty gallons of fresh water for onboard use. Robust, seaworthy construction is evident in a stainless steel pop up bow light, stainless steel D rings, high performance K Plane trim tabs, tinned copper wiring, Deutsch connectors and an O ring gutter system. The package is completed by a comprehensive saltwater washdown and a dedicated washdown circuit to keep the cockpit pristine and ready for the next strike.

Options

Propulsion is delivered by four white Mercury 400 V-10 engines, supported by a Reverso engine flush system, while Mercury electric steering with integrated autopilot and a bow thruster—tied together by a full Garmin electronics suite—ensure effortless handling and precise control. The hull is finished in Matterhorn White with a removable blue-fade wrap, complemented by white powdercoat accents throughout, diamond-stitched upholstery and triple helm seating, and every door executed in acrylic for a sleek, contemporary aesthetic. Onboard ambiance and entertainment are handled by a premium JL Audio system and an extensive POCO lighting package that bathes the under-gunwale, hard top, spreaders, underwater sections and below-deck areas in subtle illumination, while two Razor light bars mounted atop the hard top provide striking additional brilliance. Serious anglers will appreciate GEMLUX 22' internal carbon fiber outriggers, a rear-facing seat with integrated tackle center and live well, a transom live-well viewing window, a pump box system with a backup baitwell pump, supplemental rod holders on the hard top and distributed throughout the vessel for a total of thirty-one rod holders, and Hubbell deep-drop plugs to support demanding offshore work. Practical creature comforts include dual battery chargers, a freshwater washdown with an additional washdown shower on the transom, a Garlick boarding ladder and an enclosed head within the console, while the forward seating area with a removable table converts via an insert into a detachable daybed for flexible lounging.

Electronics

A refined Garmin electronics suite elevates the helm, centered on two 22-inch Garmin displays and complemented by a Garmin TD 50 for enhanced situational awareness. Clear communications are provided by a Garmin VHF

315 equipped with a command mic, while a 9-inch Mercury Vessel View display keeps propulsion and engine information immediately at hand. Entertainment is delivered from a Fusion Apollo Head Unit through premium JL Audio speakers, and an integrated autopilot instills confidence during extended passages.

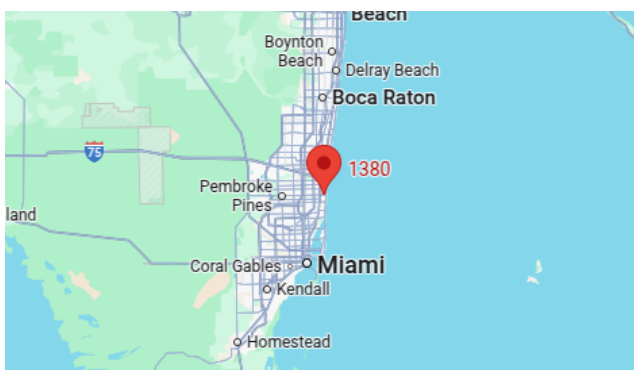
