

Designed with hardcore anglers in mind, the Yellowfin 39 boasts an extra wide-beam of 11'6", providing a spacious and well-designed platform that is both functional for fishing and perfect for entertaining. The Yellowfin 39 is not just a serious fishing machine; it also features a stand-up head and shower, ensuring that comfort is never compromised, and with all the storage space you could ever need this yacht creates a layout that seamlessly integrates functionality with style. If you seek the ultimate in performance and style, with a surprising level of comfort thrown in, the Yellowfin 39 has you covered on all fronts.

Electronics

The Yellowfin 39 is equipped with a state-of-the-art electronics suite that ensures you are always in command and connected, and at the heart of this system are two Garmin GPSMAP 8622 units providing precise navigation and mapping capabilities. Complementing these are the Garmin AIS and the Garmin GHP Reactor 40 with GHC 20 autopilot, which together offer seamless integration for effortless cruising and maneuvering, while communication is made crystal clear with the Garmin VHF GHS11 complete with an external speaker for enhanced audio clarity. For those who demand superior situational awareness, the Garmin Fantom 124 open array radar delivers exceptional target detection and tracking, and the Garmin GSD 24 chirp sonar ensures a detailed view of the underwater environment to enhance both fishing and

navigation. To round out this impressive electronics package, the Fusion MS RA670 provides top-notch audio entertainment, ensuring that every journey is accompanied by your favorite tunes, so the Yellowfin 39 is ready to meet the demands of any adventure on the water.

Helm / deck

The helm and deck of the Yellowfin 39 are designed with both functionality and style in mind, ensuring a superior experience on the water, and the sleek black bottom paint not only enhances the yacht's aesthetic appeal but also provides essential protection. At the bow, forward seating with a table insert and adjustable backrest offers a comfortable space for relaxation or socializing, while the deck is equipped with both fresh and saltwater washdown systems to make it easy to maintain cleanliness after a day of fishing or cruising. Illumination is a key feature, with hardtop lights and under covering board lighting creating a welcoming ambiance, and five molded-in spreader lights plus a forward-facing Rigid light bar ensure excellent visibility during nighttime excursions. For those who enjoy fishing, the aft-facing seat with a livewell is a practical addition, and the forward console seat with a cooler provides convenient storage for refreshments. Enhancing the vessel's versatility, underwater lights add a touch of elegance and are perfect for evening outings, and a dive ladder is also included, making it easy to enjoy swimming or diving adventures, so the helm and deck of the Yellowfin 39 are perfectly equipped to meet the demands of any maritime adventure.

Fishing equipment

The Yellowfin 39 is outfitted with an impressive array of fishing equipment, making it a top choice for serious anglers, and at the heart of its fishing capabilities are the Gemlux outrigger bases which provide the stability and

reach needed for successful trolling. To power your electric reels, the boat is equipped with two electric LP plug outlets, ensuring you have the energy required for a full day of fishing, while the vessel features a pump box and molded-in tackle storage that offers convenient access to your gear and keeps everything organized. The transom livewell, complete with tuna tubes, and an additional in-deck livewell provide ample space to keep your bait lively and ready for action, and enhancing the overall fishing experience is the upgraded T-top which offers shade and protection from the elements while you focus on the catch. With eleven aft rod holders, the Yellowfin 39 ensures that you have plenty of options for rod placement, allowing for a versatile and efficient fishing setup, making this yacht a formidable companion for any fishing adventure and ready to meet the demands of even the most dedicated anglers.

Standard equipment

The Yellowfin 39 comes equipped with a comprehensive array of standard equipment, ensuring both functionality and comfort for every voyage, and at the helm the leaning post with a rear-facing seat provides a practical and comfortable space for navigating the waters. The vessel is fitted with Gemlux flush mount cleats and a stainless steel pop-up bow light, enhancing both the aesthetic and operational aspects of the boat, while under gunwale courtesy lights add a touch of elegance and safety by illuminating the deck during evening outings. The console and coaming cushions, newly updated for 2024, offer enhanced comfort and style, and for peace of mind the boat is equipped with two Rule 2000 bilge pumps ensuring efficient water management. Stainless steel D-Rings and Gemlux two-inch gas fills contribute to the vessel's robust construction, while Gemlux rod holders and ball valves provide reliable performance for fishing enthusiasts; high-performance K-plane trim tabs allow for optimal handling and stability, and the Gemlux stainless steel thru-hull

fittings ensure durability and longevity, so with this impressive suite of standard equipment the Yellowfin 39 is well-prepared to deliver an exceptional boating experience.
