DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2019 Nor-Tech 390 center console

The 2019 Nor-Tech 390 Center Console is a high-performance luxury vessel that unites speed, comfort, and style with rare finesse. Its sleek, aerodynamic profile and deep-V hull inspire confidence offshore, delivering superior stability and precise handling even when the sea turns restless. Powered by triple Mercury V8 400R outboards with custom covers, finished in white with black accents, it surges to exhilarating speeds while maintaining a remarkably smooth, composed ride. With 450 hours and all services up to date, this is a turnkey performance boat that has been meticulously maintained and cared for.

On deck, the expansive layout invites both adventure and repose. Forward lounges flow into ergonomic, flip-up bow seating and a versatile rise-and-fall bow table that transforms into a generous sun pad, complemented by a dedicated forward sun pad for unhurried days at anchor. A second row of covered cockpit seating enhances comfort underway, while comfortable aft bench seating anchors the social heart of the boat. A hard top with an electric extendable aft sunshade casts welcome shade over the cockpit, and thoughtful details like a dive door and a telescoping dive/swim ladder make water access effortless. A bow thruster lends fingertip control in tight quarters, and a windlass streamlines anchoring.

At the helm, a carbon fiber console with center steering sets a purposeful tone. Two 22-inch Garmin navigation displays pair with a transducer for crisp situational awareness, while the Mercury View system and Mercury push-button start/stop system keep engine data and control at your fingertips. Communications and entertainment are equally well served with a VHF radio, XM Radio and weather, and a JL Premium sound system that brings

concert-grade audio to open water. Custom multicolor hull lighting and underwater lights create an unforgettable evening ambiance.

The craftsmanship is unmistakable in the diamond-quilted exterior stitching and black contrast upholstery, while the bow seating features custom backrests and cup holders to elevate comfort. Practicality meets polish with forward storage, a hull in a single white color, Sea deck in gray, white, and black with a teak pattern, and a fresh water engine flush to simplify care after every outing. Below, a separate cabin offers a welcome retreat complete with a sink and a head featuring a macerator. For peace of mind, a Marine Guardian security system stands watch.

Expertly specified, beautifully finished, and comprehensively equipped, this Nor-Tech 390 is the complete package—offshore-ready performance wrapped in effortless luxury.
