














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

The Stamas 390 Aegean is an extraordinary yacht that seamlessly blends opulence with practicality, making it a superb option for avid anglers and those who enjoy relaxed cruising. This vessel boasts a generous cockpit, ideal for hosting guests or indulging in a day of fishing. The interior is spacious and climate-controlled, providing comfortable accommodations for up to six individuals, ensuring a serene experience on the water.

A key highlight of the Stamas 390 Aegean is its remarkable 410-gallon fuel capacity, enabling long voyages, such as exploring the Bahamas, without frequent refueling stops. Both the exterior and interior of the yacht are in pristine condition, with the gelcoat, paint, and diamond-stitched upholstery all carefully preserved. The enclosure offers extra protection against the elements, ensuring comfort in diverse weather conditions.

Currently stored on a lift in Stuart, FL, this yacht is poised for its next journey. Whether your aim is to fish or cruise in elegance, the Stamas 390 Aegean delivers an ideal combination of performance and luxury.

The Stamas 390 Aegean captures the enduring charm of Tuna Towers, Upper Helm Stations, and Crow's Nests—features that have long been coveted by dedicated anglers. Stamas has breathed new life into this tradition with a completely new vessel that effortlessly combines iconic design with cutting-edge, reliable technology. This yacht turns weekend getaways into extended journeys, providing sleeping quarters for six, a complete galley, a head, and a freshwater shower. Crafted for exploration, the 390 Aegean

beckons you to explore distant waters, pursue fish worthy of tournaments, and leave the everyday world behind.

Outfitted with a 210-quart insulated fishbox with an overboard drain, two live baitwells, and both fresh and raw water washdowns, this yacht is primed for serious fishing adventures. The only thing missing are the GPS coordinates to the best fishing spots. With the Stamas 390 Aegean, you are fully equipped for an extraordinary maritime experience.

Vessel walkthrough and details

The Stamas 390 Aegean showcases a thoughtfully crafted interior and exterior, seamlessly blending comfort with practicality. At the bow, a spacious double berth offers a snug sleeping area, followed by a port-side dinette and a starboard-side fully equipped galley. The galley features a composite countertop with an integrated sink, generous drawer and cabinet storage, a Franklin Chef microwave, a Kenyon two-burner electric cooktop, and a Norcold refrigerator. Conveniently located aft of the galley is the head, and a second double berth spans the full beam at the cabin's rear.

The main salon is a sanctuary of comfort, boasting air conditioning, refined teak cabinetry, and a teak and holly floor. Storage is plentiful with a hanging locker and drawer space, while entertainment is provided by Polk Audio speakers and a Proscan flat screen TV. The salon is illuminated by overhead lighting and four opening ports with curtains. Privacy is assured with a forward double berth featuring an overhead hatch and privacy curtain, a convertible dinette, and an aft double berth with its own privacy curtain. The enclosed head includes an electric toilet, vanity, and shower.

On deck, the yacht features custom paint, an Isenglass enclosure, and diamond-stitched upholstery, all refreshed in 2020. The molded-in anchor pulpit with anchor chute, plow anchor, and chain, along with a Lewmar windlass with helm remote, facilitate easy anchoring. Wide side decks with a

stainless steel bow rail, new forward sun pad cushions, and a factory hardtop with white powder-coated pipework enhance the vessel's allure. Anglers will appreciate the four tower leg rod holders, six flush-mounted rod holders, and a seven-rod transom rocket launcher. The expansive cockpit includes ample storage below, a large tackle center with sink, and a transom shower with port and starboard washdowns. Additional features include a fold-down transom seat, a Euro-style transom with a built-in swim platform and pull-out ladder, and a stereo remote with speakers for the swim platform/transom.

The helm is outfitted with state-of-the-art electronics, including a hybrid touch Raymarine display screen, a second display screen, Raymarine radar with open array, a Raymarine night vision camera, and a Raymarine autopilot, all updated in 2020. The Airmar B175 H through hull transducers, JL Audio upgraded stereo system, and dual trumpet horn ensure an exceptional navigation and entertainment experience. Safety features include forward and aft high water alarms, a Standard Horizon Matrix AIS/GPS VHF radio, and a Lewmar bow thruster. The helm also includes Bennett trim tabs, two AFI windshield wipers, and a clear three-sided enclosure.

The electrical system is robust, featuring a Kohler Digital Control II 5KW generator, 30amp shore power and cable, a six-gallon Kuuma electric water heater, and four batteries with a Pro-tournament 360 Elite Series 30amp four-bank charger. The vessel is equipped with forward and aft 2000 GPH automatic bilge pumps, battery switches, a Lewmar breaker, a Rule 1600 live well pump, a Rule 1600 washdown pump, and a Sureflow Blaster II freshwater pump.

Engine specifications include Yamaha engine displays, Yamaha electronic controls, and Yamaha fuel filters, complemented by a Racor generator fuel filter. The yacht is powered by triple Yamaha 300 engines with under 1,000 hours, all painted white, and features a Fireboy machinery room automatic fire system for enhanced safety. This comprehensive setup ensures that the

Stamas 390 Aegean is fully prepared for any maritime adventure.
