OVERVIEW

The 2024 Vanquish VQ40 arrives as a meticulously appointed expression of maritime intent, its bold, attention-grabbing finish accentuating a sculpted profile that reads beautifully from dock to horizon. Under the skin, triple Mercury Racing 450R outboards provide explosive acceleration and effortless cruise capability, while a Seakeeper 3 gyro keeps motion tamed and the ride remarkably level. Long days aboard are made comfortable by a generator and full climate control serving both the cabin and the helm dash, all executed with the precision fit and refined finishes synonymous with foremost Dutch craftsmanship.

This particular example is outfitted with the upgraded trio of 450s, including warranty coverage through 1/2/27, and benefits from joystick piloting with Skyhook dynamic positioning for supremely confident docking and station-keeping. A hydraulically tilting bow anchor system streamlines anchor handling, and an optional Carbon Package lends a high-tech aesthetic. Practical enhancements include an expanded battery bank for extended time at anchor, underwater lighting for evening ambiance, and tailored upholstery with protective covers to preserve the boat's immaculate presentation. Systems and navigation are presented on twin 16-inch Garmin displays that simplify passage planning and close-quarters maneuvering.

At forty feet, this open motor yacht fluidly inhabits roles as a luxury day boat, center console, sport yacht, express cruiser, weekend cruiser, chase boat, or superyacht tender, marrying driver-focused dynamics with polished style. Sleek, capable, and unmistakably modern, this VQ40 sets a benchmark for those seeking performance and elegance in equal measure.































DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Broker description

This 2024 Vanquish VQ40 stands among the most highly optioned boats in its class, pairing a sleek and striking color package with a specification that captivates from every angle. Triple Mercury 450R outboards deliver electrifying thrust with confidence inspiring control, complemented by a joystick with Skyhook and supported by warranty to 1/2/27, while a Seakeeper 3 gyro stabilizer keeps the ride composed and level. A generator and full air conditioning in the cabin and at the dash ensure effortless comfort in every climate, and thoughtful appointments such as a hydraulic tilting anchor system, a carbon package that adds purposeful edge, underwater lights that set the mood after dark, and an upgraded battery bank for expanded DC capacity reinforce the sense of considered capability. At the helm, a dual sixteen inch Garmin package places intuitive control at your fingertips, and tailored upholstery covers preserve the yacht's immaculate presentation; wrapped in unmistakable Dutch craftsmanship and quality, this forty foot day boat makes a statement where it matters most—style, performance, and poise.

Additional descriptions

Purposeful technology elevates every mile aboard the VQ40: navigation is centered on two Garmin GPSMAP 8412 displays that integrate with a Garmin VHF 300 with AIS and a Garmin GBT43 depth sensor to sharpen underwater awareness, while Garmin radar and a powerful search light extend situational confidence into the night. Entertainment is anchored by a Fusion RA770 system that delivers rich, high fidelity sound for every sprint and sunset. Electrical systems are configured to US standards with 12 V DC and 110 V 60

Hz AC, and digital switching by the Empire system is managed through the Garmin interface for intuitive, centralized control; shore power connectivity runs through a 30 amp cable and USB charging points are placed at the helm and forward. Power storage and delivery are robust, with two 160 Ah AGM service batteries, dedicated house batteries and two starting batteries for the engines, all supported by a Victron battery charger and a Victron Quatro 5000 watt unit, while practical conveniences include an electrical toilet, spot and indirect lighting in the head, cockpit and engine room, deck courtesy lighting and navigation lights set into the hardtop, plus a cockpit drawer fridge and two underwater lights that paint the transom at night. Factory upgrades amplify capability and comfort: the engine package upgraded to triple Mercury 450 hp outboards is paired with Joystick Piloting and Skyhook for precise low speed control, a hydraulic swim ladder provides graceful water access, and a hydraulic tilting anchor system conceals a 15 kg anchor beneath a foredeck hatch driven by an electric windlass with stainless chain and anchor. Endurance grows with the upgraded battery bank, entertaining spaces transform with a height adjustable bow table and filler that create a generous sunbed, and hospitality is enhanced by two refrigerators in the aft galley and a warm water boiler feeding a deck shower. Climate control is assured with AC in the cabin and at the dashboard, ride quality remains serene thanks to Seakeeper 3, and quiet, reliable power offshore comes from a Fischer Panda generator; styling touches include a black finished bimini T top with gray glazing, carbon package cupholders, sun screens on the carbon awnings forward and aft, and marina covers and upholstery covers to protect every surface.


