OVERVIEW

2020 Intrepid Powerboats 407 Cuddy — Orange Beach, AL

The 2020 Intrepid 407 Cuddy marries refined craftsmanship with genuine offshore capability in a sculpted, performance-oriented silhouette. As both a luxury powerboat and a true bluewater cuddy cabin, she invites extended adventures below decks where a carefully planned layout awaits: a private head with a separate shower, a tranquil master stateroom appointed with a queen berth and hullside windows that suffuse the space with daylight, and a forward lounge that quickly converts into a roomy double berth. Above, Intrepid's advanced construction techniques produce a remarkably smooth, dry ride while preserving the speed, balance, and nimble handling that define this elevated center console and express cruiser.

Versatility is woven into every detail. A hullside dive door with an integrated step ladder and secure grab rails makes water entry effortless, while sumptuous custom seating and a streamlined wet bar raise the bar for onboard entertaining. Serious anglers will value the tournament-ready sportfishing configuration—live wells, rod holders, dedicated tackle and tank storage, Taco outriggers, and a raw-water washdown—so this elegant weekender can transform into a capable offshore fishing platform at a moment's notice. Whether deployed as a quick dayboat, a sunset cruiser, a diving launch, or a long-range run, the 407 Cuddy is engineered to perform. This example has been meticulously cared for and lightly used, reflecting an owner committed to thorough maintenance. Recent service includes freshly serviced and painted lower units and replacement underwater transom lights, and the boat has been carefully stored between outings. Trailering is simplified by the included triple-axle BAD 2D BONE trailer equipped with a Hydrastar brake actuator, adding welcome flexibility for transport and trip planning. At the helm, a beautifully organized console centers a premium electronics

suite built for confident bluewater passages: dual 22-inch Garmin 8622 touchscreens paired with a full Garmin package including radar, FLIR night vision for after-dark safety, and a Mercury VesselView display for clear engine monitoring. A Fischer Panda 4.8 kW diesel generator supports systems away from the dock, while entertainment and comfort are assured by a Fusion stereo with JL speakers and TracVision satellite TV. Close-quarters maneuvering is aided by a bow thruster and a Rigid light bar, creating a turnkey cruising experience that is intuitive and capable.

The result is a rare synthesis of elegance, technology, and performance in a true offshore cruiser—an agile walkaround-style center console with the comfort of a cabin cruiser and the soul of a sportfisher. Lightly run, impeccably maintained, and ready to roam, this 2020 Intrepid Powerboats 407 Cuddy is a compelling opportunity for buyers seeking a luxurious, multi-mission yacht. Owner open to trades.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed information

Crafted with a singular focus on strength, poise, and polish, the Intrepid 407 Cuddy is finished in a striking Intrepid Hi-Flex White gel coat that underscores its modern aesthetic. An FRP-infused hull, liner, and deck deliver exceptional strength and structural integrity, while wood-free PVC foam core construction enhances durability and trims weight. Non-woven quad and uni-directional fibers, both infused and hand laid, are employed for optimal reinforcement and performance, and a non-skid deck and gunwales instill confident footing throughout. An integrated motor bracket is engineered to accommodate twin or triple engine configurations, guttered cockpit hatches pair with a self-bailing cockpit for efficient drainage and safety, and a sleek Plexi trim package completes the clean, contemporary finish.

Comfort flows from every detail. A swing-in dive door with a fold-out ladder makes water access effortless, complemented by a fold-under swim ladder for convenient reboarding. Hullside windows and a forward recessed opening deck hatch bring in natural light and fresh air, while port side forward seating and a spacious console with windshield add protection and poise underway. Guests are welcomed by an aft-facing companion console seat and starboard U-shaped cockpit seating with a slide-out sun pad filler for lounging and entertaining. A fold-out gunwale step provides easy, safe movement to the bow, a fold-out port side cooler adds day-to-day convenience, and an insulated fishbox with a thru-transom ball valve and macerator equips the boat for serious angling. Below, an aft berth with a queen bed promises overnight comfort, joined by a cabin wraparound settee that converts to a berth with an optional hi-lo table. A private head compartment with a separate shower, a galley refrigerator and solid surface countertops, port and starboard overhead

cabin storage, and cabin blinds on hullside windows elevate the onboard experience. Inset fabric headliner panels, plush cabin cushions, and skylights in the cabin and head brighten and refine the interior, while LED cabin lighting throughout and an onboard EPIRB round out safety and ambiance offshore. Mechanical and systems excellence underpin the experience. A raw water wash-down streamlines cleanup after fishing or diving, and solid stainless steel hardware ensures lasting strength and corrosion resistance. A bow eye and an anchor roller through the bow facilitate secure anchoring, an aluminum fuel tank keeps weight low while combating corrosion, and a heavy-duty vinyl rub rail protects during docking and tight maneuvers. The 4" hydraulically actuated helm sole platform improves visibility and comfort at the controls, and tinned wiring safeguards long-term electrical reliability. LED navigation lights and LED cockpit lights deliver efficiency and clarity, while a breaker panel and switches with push-button LED backlit functionality, along with intuitive push-button LED backlit switches throughout, provide easy control of onboard systems. Three automatic bilge pumps manage water reliably, trim tabs with digital indicators and auto retract fine-tune the ride, and a compass keeps navigation straightforward. A pressurized fresh water system and an electric head with holding tank add the final measure of comfort to a rugged, ready, and remarkably refined platform.
