DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

The Bayou Bandit is an adaptable yacht, ideal for both deep-sea fishing and family voyages, seamlessly combining comfort with practicality. It boasts two roomy double staterooms and a generous head with a separate stall shower. The welcoming salon is embellished with exquisite teak cabinetry, fostering a cozy and inviting ambiance. At the bow, the guest stateroom features a double berth on the starboard side and ample storage cabinets to port. Moving aft, the head is conveniently positioned to starboard, complete with a separate stall shower for enhanced privacy and ease. The master stateroom, nearly spanning the full beam, is located aft and offers a walk-around queen-sized bed, plentiful storage, and private access to the head.

The salon, accessible via the port side companionway and up three steps, is crafted for leisure and entertainment. It includes a U-shaped dinette and an entertainment center at the front, while the full galley runs under the counter along the starboard side. The galley is outfitted with an Amana Radar Range microwave oven, a two-burner Princess electric cooktop, a Frigidaire refrigerator with a freezer section, a Corian countertop with an integrated Corian sink, and a Raritan ice maker. The salon also features a large L-shaped sofa with storage underneath, a teak hi/lo table aft and to port, and a barrel chair to starboard. Access to the cockpit is through a sliding door located aft and to starboard. The yacht's décor includes teak paneling and cabinetry, complemented by a beige sofa and carpet with blue print bunk covers.

The Bayou Bandit is equipped with an extensive array of electronics, including a Furuno radar, Furuno FCVL fish finder, Robertson AP300X autopilot, Poly Planer flybridge stereo speakers, West Marine VHF, Furuno FS1502 SSB, a 3-inch Ritchie compass, an overhead radio box integrated into the factory

hardtop, and a Pioneer stereo. Mechanically, the yacht is driven by twin Caterpillar Diesel 3126 420HP engines with 2.00 to 1 ratio ZF Gears, Racor fuel filters, Airsep engine air filters, Morse engine controls, and Hynautic wheel steering. It also includes VDO engine gauges, a Sentry 12-volt battery charger, a Westerbeke 8KW generator, a 20-gallon Bradford White electric water heater, Boat Leveler hydraulic trim tabs, an Oil X-changer oil change system, and a Glendinning engine synchronizer.

The deck and hull are crafted for resilience and user-friendliness, featuring Pompanette helm and companion chairs, an Ocean Yachts hard top half tower with arch side support, a three-sided isinglass enclosure, a front of helm bench seat, aluminum rails, a Galley Maid electric anchor windlass with a Danforth style anchor, and LED spreader lights. For fishing aficionados, the Bayou Bandit is equipped with Rupp double spreader outriggers, a Rupp center rigger, a six-gang rod rack on the bridge rail, a Pompanette fighting chair, five gunwale-mounted rod holders, and a transom door and gate.

This trailblazing 40-foot sportfish yacht offers numerous features not previously available on boats of this size. Ocean Yachts was the first to introduce such a spacious master stateroom, a double bed guest stateroom, a side companionway, cockpit engine room access, a center bridge ladder, a factory hardtop, and nearly complete factory outfitting. With only 2670 hours, the Bayou Bandit promises many more years of pleasure and is ready to embark on new adventures.
