OVERVIEW

This 2022 Fjord 41 XL is offered in pristine, almost-new condition as a one-owner yacht with exceptionally low engine hours and EU VAT paid. Meticulously maintained and prepared turnkey for the 2026 summer season, she is available for private viewings in Greece and delivers an elevated blend of luxury dayboat comfort, walkaround practicality and express-cruiser performance, all articulated through Fjord's distinctive design language. Accommodation is arranged over two cabins, with a serene owner's suite featuring a double berth, generous wardrobe space and an en-suite head with separate shower, alongside a guest cabin fitted with a double berth, sofa, wardrobe and opening portlights. A hydraulic bathing platform with ladder reinforces the beach-club experience, while propulsion is assured by twin Yanmar 8LV 370 hp engines on ZT sterndrives, with effortless joystick docking. The Signal White GRP hull, set off by a Jet Black waterline and a sleek T-Top, projects a contemporary motor-yacht aesthetic. Specified options include a JL Audio three-zone sound system with subwoofers, amplifiers and distributed speakers, and a Simrad glass-bridge navigation suite with dual 12-inch displays, VHF, AIS and transducer. Teak decking, an electric windlass with chain counter, multiple refrigerators, expansive sunpads, sociable seating with folding tables and galley modules with sink and stone countertops elevate onboard living, while an electric bimini, upgraded upholstery, carbon-frame helm seats, radar with deflector and an additional joystick control complete this refined performance cruiser. Full documentation included.

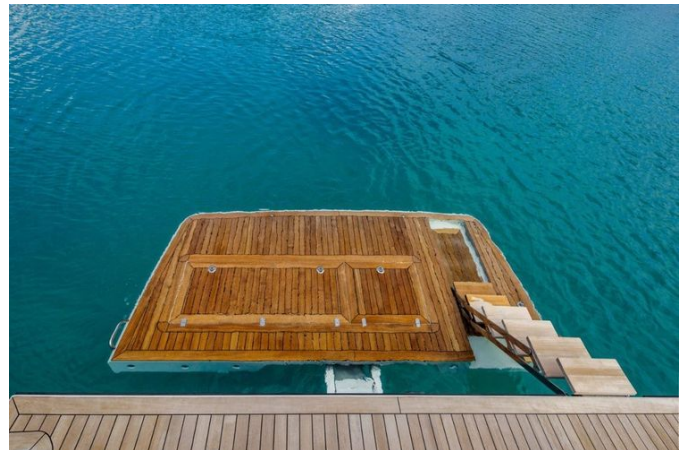

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Full description with optionals

Propulsion is entrusted to a Yanmar 8LV delivering 370 hp through a ZT sterndrive, combining assured performance with smooth handling; precise joystick control, a sturdy propeller and a full complement of engine instruments present every operating parameter clearly at the helm. The onboard soundscape is provided by the JL Ultimate 3-Zone Exterior Entertainment Package, centred on a JL Audio MM50 and JL Audio MM100 BE, amplified by one JL Audio M800/8v2 and one JL Audio M600/1, which power a pair of JL M6 10IB-L subwoofers; audio fills the yacht via two JL M6 770X-L speakers within the saloon, two at the helm, two on the foredeck and two in the cockpit, all conveniently managed through the JL Audio MMR-40 remote. The hull is constructed in GRP and finished in Isophthalic gelcoat in Signal White with a contrasting waterline in Isophthalic gelcoat in Jet Black, and the exterior is fortified with primer and anti-fouling treatments to preserve finish and performance. Deck and cockpit surfaces are appointed with fine teak, extending across the deck, bathing platform and gunwale, while an extended 1.19 m bathing platform with hydraulic lift improves water access and is complemented by an integrated ladder plus a separate bathing ladder with robust handrails. A stand-alone, side-out anchor arrangement includes a 15 kg stainless steel anchor, 50 m of stainless steel chain and a windlass fitted with an automatic fuse, monitored by an anchor chain counter; practical fitments also include six fender pins, a T-Top with windshield frame and wiper cover, and gelcoat finishing in Signal White. Electrical provisioning comprises a battery bank of two 90 Ah units alongside four 160 Ah AGM batteries to ensure reliable onboard power. Navigation and helm electronics are arranged around a Simrad VHF RS100 with a VHF antenna and splitter for FM/AIS, and a Simrad

custom glass bridge featuring two 12" information displays, a DST transducer and remote control for intuitive operation. The interior is configured from curated modules: A1 provides a tranquil master cabin with a double berth, two wardrobes and a head with a separate shower; B1 forms an inviting lobby with a small sofa and a 35 l drawer fridge beneath; C3 houses a guest cabin with a double berth, sofa, wardrobe and three openable deck portholes for daylight and airflow; and D1 positions a galley module to port at 660 mm with cover, incorporating a 65 l fridge, a marine mineral stone working top and an additional copilot seat with cover. Exterior modules expand functionality and comfort: E2 combines pilot and copilot seating with a galley module on the starboard side measuring 1240 mm with cover, a sink with folding mixing tap and storage and a marine mineral stone working top specified in lieu of a storage box; F1 provides a free deck for flexible use; and F2 enhances lounging with a 2138 mm sunbed with storage, two drawer fridges, two benches with backrests, two 1040 mm benches including covers and two foldable tables with fixed legs and covers. Material choices reflect refined taste, with furniture in Lisboa Chestnut (per the colour card) and exterior upholstery in Cubic (per the colour card); helmsman seats feature frames in carbon, inner upholstery colours follow the colour card for the cockpit bench and sunbed, and a sophisticated Dark Grey tone ties the scheme together. Practical accessories complete the specification, including an electric bimini integrated into the T-top with white mesh and six cushion fenders for protection and comfort.
