DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Fiart Mare

Founded in 1960 by the visionary Ruggero di Luggo, Fiart Mare stands as a testament to Italian craftsmanship and innovation in the world of recreational motor boats, rooted on the picturesque shores of the Gulf of Naples within an expansive fifty thousand square meter shipyard where every stage of creation unfolds with care and expertise. Over more than six decades the yard has designed and built more than one hundred and fifty models, earning a reputation for quality and versatility that appeals to a wide spectrum of boaters; whether one seeks a sporty, performance-driven shape or a more luxurious and commodious layout, Fiart Mare's portfolio consistently balances technical excellence with refined aesthetics. Dedicated to customer service and international reach, the company maintains offices across Spain, France, Croatia, Turkey, and Israel, ensuring support for an engaged global clientele while continuing to evolve designs that marry seaworthiness with elegant Italian styling.

Overview

The 39 Seawalker distinguishes itself through exceptional interior volume and intelligent layout, offering ceilings of six feet five inches in main areas and unusually generous stand-up height even in the aft cabin, which elevates comfort well beyond class expectations; this particular example features a private Owner's Cabin forward with a walk-around berth that ensures privacy and a restful night's sleep, while aft a beautifully appointed lounge presents a plush U-shaped sofa that converts seamlessly into twin berths when required, delivering the flexibility of a cruiser with the open, airy character of a weekender. Designed for both relaxed day boating and extended escapes, the

39 Seawalker provides shelter from sun and sudden showers and invites late-night cinema after a sun-soaked afternoon, with a versatile arrangement on deck and below, high-quality finishes, and an impressive hull design that together make this model a compelling and refined choice for discerning owners.

Standard equipment

The 39 Seawalker arrives with a comprehensive suite of standard equipment designed to blend comfort, style, and reliable performance; the master cabin functions as a private retreat trimmed in elegant wood veneer walls and white wood furniture set upon plush carpeting, while the dayhead is fitted with a separate shower stall for convenience and privacy. Externally the yacht is finished with teak decking featuring white caulking, and propulsion is provided by three 300 HP V300 AMS Verado Mercury engines in striking white, accompanied by Vessel View 903 instrumentation and Zipwake for refined performance monitoring and trim control. Navigation and visibility are aided by a Garmin 10-inch monitor and a standard grey T-Top with integrated lighting, complemented by a skylight, VHF antenna, and a standard grey single beauty waterline that sharpens the profile. Comfortable Silververtex upholstery accents the exterior seating, while practical touches such as a swimming ladder with handles, an aft sunbed, a protective glass windshield, and an aft convertible dinette increase usability; cockpit LED lights create an inviting atmosphere, and the installation and steering system are included to ensure confident handling from the first voyage.

Mechanical equipment

The 39 Seawalker is fitted with mechanical systems selected for comfort, reliability, and ease of use, starting with a powerful climate control unit rated

at 25,000 BTU that supplies both cold and hot air to maintain a comfortable interior regardless of external conditions. Close-quarters handling is assisted by a bow thruster for precise maneuvering, while electrical autonomy is supported by a nine point zero kW generator operating at 60 Hz and a 2000W inverter to deliver stable power for appliances and electronics. Communication and safety are reinforced by a VHF collinear antenna to ensure clear transmissions, and together these systems create a well-rounded mechanical package that readies the yacht for varied cruising demands with confidence and efficiency.

Electric options

The 39 Seawalker's electrical options are focused on simplifying control and enhancing situational awareness, centered on the Pacchetto JPO Mercury package which integrates a joystick, autopilot, and Skyhook for intuitive, precise maneuvering whether docking or holding position offshore. To complement these control systems the helm benefits from an upgraded display expanding from the standard ten-inch monitor to a more capacious sixteen-inch screen, delivering clearer charts and easier interaction with navigation and engine data, so that piloting becomes both safer and more enjoyable.

Exterior

The exterior of the 39 Seawalker combines practical detail with refined styling to ensure both safety and visual impact, starting with a forward handrail that facilitates secure movement on deck and antifouling protection on the hull for long-term performance. The exterior hull and main deck are finished with a colored top coat paint that creates a cohesive, polished appearance, while tapestry quilting in the cockpit lends an air of understated luxury. A third helm

seat enhances comfort for extended passages, and a double waterline paint accentuates the yacht's sleek profile; two underwater lights add drama to evening passages and waterfront moorings. Culinary convenience is addressed by an induction cooktop operating at 110V located in the cockpit, and modern touches such as a carbon flagpole and synthetic teak upgrade elevate both form and function. Mooring is simplified with additional bollards amidships and two extra aft bollards, while port and starboard aft gates provide easy, safe access to the water, making the exterior of the Seawalker 39 both beautiful and highly practical.

Covers

The 39 Seawalker is supplied with a tailored set of covers crafted to protect key areas and preserve the yacht's condition; an aft awning supported by carbon poles creates a shaded, comfortable rear cockpit sanctuary even at midday, while a full complement of fitted covers shields the driving seat and console, the kitchen cabinet, the aft sofa, and the forward sunbathing area from weather and UV exposure. These covers are designed for precise fit and durability, ensuring that upholstery and equipment remain protected and the yacht is ready for every outing.

Interior

The interior of the 39 Seawalker is conceived to balance comfort and functionality in a welcoming, upscale environment, beginning with a forward cabin privacy wall that creates a true retreat for overnight guests or extended stays. Practical amenities include a sixty-five liter refrigerator seamlessly integrated into the layout to keep provisions chilled, while wood flooring imparts warmth and refined character underfoot. Entertainment is provided by a thirty-two inch LCD TV paired with a digital antenna system so that evenings

on board can be as convivial as days at anchor, and overall the interior finishes and thoughtful equipment make the 39 Seawalker a harmonious and comfortable space for owners and guests alike.
