## OVERVIEW

---

"Zoto" is a carefully maintained 2003 Sea Ray 39' Motor Yacht, an elegant aft-cabin cruising yacht whose climate-controlled, enclosed bridge sits beneath a substantial hardtop. Plush seating frames the helm, creating an inviting social hub for guests and an ideal environment for entertaining while underway. Built for all-season comfort, she is equally suited to weekend getaways, extended coastal passages, or ambitious voyages such as the American Great Loop.

Propelled by twin Cummins diesel engines and supported by an Onan generator, "Zoto" offers reliable, efficient power and a smooth, confidence-inspiring ride well suited to a fuel-conscious liveaboard cruiser. The interior is arranged as a two-stateroom, two-head layout centered on a spacious salon featuring a factory-customized owner's area, a full galley, and a dedicated laundry compartment. Forward, the VIP stateroom provides a cozy settee, an expandable berth, and private access to the forward head and shower. Aft of the salon, the owner's suite presents a walk-around island berth, a separate shower and head, a vanity, abundant storage, and a broad transom window that bathes the cabin in natural light. More than a boat, "Zoto" is a luxurious invitation to explore—perfect for entertaining on the enclosed bridge, cruising to the next harbor, or chasing sunsets aboard a capable, diesel-powered Motor Yacht that is Great Loop ready and liveaboard friendly.

## DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

### Accommodations, furnishings & layout

---

The forward stateroom presents two twin beds with thoughtful filler cushions that convert the starboard berth into a full-size bed when desired, while a private door ensures seclusion; a built-in nightstand, a full hanging locker and in-floor storage maintain impeccable order and utility. In the salon, a generous starboard-side sofa converts to a comfortable berth to welcome additional guests, and at the owner's request the factory installed a convenient dining table and dedicated seating area in the salon, a bespoke touch that enhances social life aboard without compromising the original layout.

### Galley & laundry

---

Thoughtfully arranged for cruising life, the spacious galley provides abundant cabinet storage beneath elegant Corian countertops set against cherry wood-colored cabinetry, making meal preparation both practical and refined. Daily routines are simplified by a microwave oven and a 120V coffee maker, while durable wood flooring adds warmth underfoot. An under-step laundry compartment keeps laundering discreetly out of sight yet immediately accessible, supporting extended cruising with minimal fuss.

### Electronics & navigation equipment

---

Confident navigation is provided by a Raymarine ST 7001+ autopilot, a Garmin VHF 115 and a reliable compass, while a Garmin GPSMAP 1242 XSV with integrated radar presents clear, centralized situational awareness on the main display. Engine and systems information flows through the Mercury VesselView system GT52-TM, complemented by a Navionics+ charts transducer for

detailed cartography. Entertainment aboard is robust and refined, featuring a Clarion stereo with a six-CD changer, a 400W Clarion amplifier and subwoofer, plus a 36" Panasonic flatscreen TV and a 20" LG flatscreen TV to keep guests entertained in comfort.

## Electrical system

---

Power management aboard is comprehensive and intelligently configured around a Victron 12V 50A battery charger supplying four Group 27 batteries through main AC/DC breaker panels and a remote breaker panel, ensuring dependable onboard power. Shore connectivity is facilitated by dual 30A/120V power cords and a Ph shore power cord, while an Onan generator delivers reliable autonomy when at anchor. Throughout the vessel, efficient LED lighting provides bright, uniform illumination and reduces electrical load.

## Deck equipment

---

Deck gear marries functionality with comfort: a Lofrans anchor is teamed with a Lofrans Progress 1 windlass operated by bow foot switches for effortless anchoring, while a washdown system keeps equipment and decks fresh. An ACR searchlight, dual windshield wipers and windshield shades enhance visibility and safety, and a secure bow handrail fortifies on-deck confidence. Leisure is supported by an aft deck enclosure and a wet bar with sink and beverage holders, and a 110V GFCI-USB receptacle powers accessories, with a transom door completing a considered layout that facilitates easy boarding and water access.

## Mechanical equipment & engine details

---

Mechanical reliability is evident in dedicated Dometic AC units and a robust

engine-room fit-out that includes dual bilge blowers, four automatic bilge pumps and a raw water sea strainer to protect systems. Safety is reinforced with an automatic/manual fire suppression system, while maintenance is simplified by a reverse oil change system. Power is transmitted through a ZF 280 A transmission with a 1.76 ratio to a 1 3/4" main shaft driving four-blade cupped propellers, supported by dripless shaft seals and Bennett trim tabs for precise running attitude, and generous LED engine-room lighting reveals an exceptionally clean, well-maintained machinery space.

## **Other features, construction, and overhaul details**

---

Climate control aboard is comprehensive with four dedicated air-conditioning units tailored to distinct areas: a Cruisair 10,000 BTU serving the forward stateroom, a Cruisair 16,000 BTU at the helm, a brand-new Dometic 16,000 BTU in the salon, and a brand-new Flow 10,000 BTU for the master stateroom, together delivering zoned comfort and reliable performance across the vessel.

## **Additional salesperson's comments**

---

This boat has been exceptionally maintained by a single owner who has diligently completed scheduled services; the hull and topsides retain their original gelcoat luster through regular waxing and polishing, and the vessel presents as a true turnkey offering, carefully prepared and fully ready for immediate cruising.
