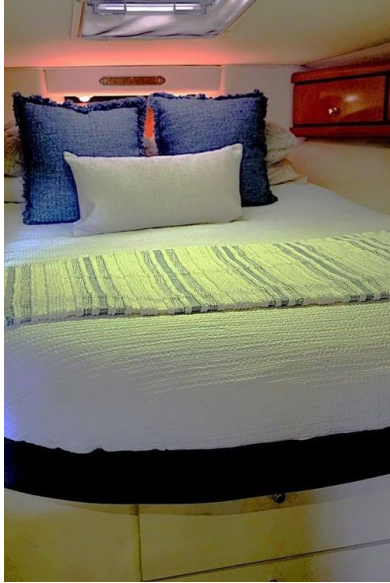

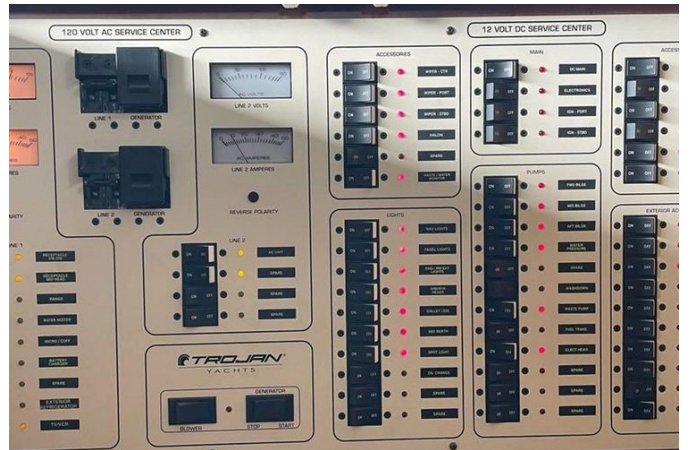

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

The Carver Trojan 400 Express showcases Carver Yachts' distinctive winged arch and a sumptuous cherry wood interior, married to the spirited ride of a modified-V hull. Aboard JP5, the foredeck features a recessed sun pad perfect for lounging, while the expansive cockpit is arranged for effortless entertaining with U-shaped seating and a varnished table, an integrated sunlounge and a convenient refrigerator that together create a refined platform whether at anchor, underway, or hosting guests.

Below, the galley, dining and salon zones are light-filled and airy thanks to two large overhead opening hatches. The galley is comprehensively appointed with an electric cooktop, countertop ice maker, microwave, refrigerator, ample storage cabinets with drawers and granite-style counters, and the dining area is encircled by custom upholstered seating that elegantly wraps the serving table for relaxed meals. Sleeping arrangements are equally well considered: the forward master stateroom offers a queen-sized berth with private access to the head and shower, the amidships dinette converts into a double berth, and the aft U-shaped salon sofa converts into a mid-cabin double with its own privacy curtain.

JP5 carries the optional generator and air conditioning packages to provide reliable electrical power and onboard comfort for extended cruises. The climate system functions in reverse cycle to deliver heat, and an available upgrade adds an electric heating element that supplies warmth efficiently without operating the AC pump or reverse cycle.

Galley

The galley features a molded, granite-style countertop with an integrated recessed sink, complemented by upper and lower cabinetry fitted with drawers for meticulous organization. Appliances include an under counter Nova Kool marine refrigerator, a countertop ice maker, a microwave oven and a Princess double-burner glass electric cooktop, while hot water is supplied by a six-gallon water heater.

Master stateroom

This private suite serves as a tranquil sanctuary centered on a queen-sized berth that promises luxurious, restorative nights; elegant finishes and a thoughtful layout grant exclusive, direct access to the head and shower, creating a fully self-contained retreat aboard the yacht.

Master stateroom head

Designed for refined comfort, the master stateroom head is fitted with a VacuFlush toilet, and the shower is discreetly separated from the sink area by a sliding glass door, ensuring enhanced privacy while keeping the wash space impeccably dry and pristine.

Cockpit

The salon's U-shaped sofa effortlessly converts into a double berth in the mid-cabin, accompanied by its own privacy curtain, delivering refined, adaptable comfort whether for leisurely daytime lounging or restful overnight accommodation.

Deck & hull

An electric windlass refines the anchoring process, streamlining operations to ensure smooth, dependable deployment and retrieval of the anchor, delivering a polished, effortless action that inspires confidence with every use.

Electrical equipment

At the helm a Raytheon RL80C chart plotter is paired with a 48-mile marine radar—the original factory-fitted unit, maintained in dependable working order—while a Standard Horizon VHF delivers clear, reliable communications. Onboard entertainment is elevated by a stereo system with a dedicated subwoofer and carefully positioned speakers that serve both the cabin and cockpit, and LED lighting throughout the cockpit creates an elegant nighttime ambiance. Shipboard power is provided by a 110 VAC electrical circuit, and interior comfort is assured by a reverse-cycle heating system.

Mechanical equipment

Propulsion is provided by twin high-performance Horizon engines—representing the pinnacle of their generation—meticulously maintained, robust and delivering generous power when called upon. Auxiliary electrical needs are supplied by a Kohler 7.3 kW generator with approximately 550 hours, while Borg Warner Velvet Drive transmission components and dedicated heat exchangers reinforce a drivetrain designed for long service life. Precise ride control is achieved with Bennett 12 V trim tabs and an automatic engine-bay fire suppression system offers added security while underway. Anchoring duties are handled by a Delta 35 lb plow anchor on a chain rode operated by a Maxwell windlass, and shore power is provided through dual 30 A, 110 V inlets—one serving the main electrical system and the other dedicated

to air conditioning. Routine maintenance is simplified by an Oil X-Change lubrication transfer system for changing oils in both the engines and the generator.

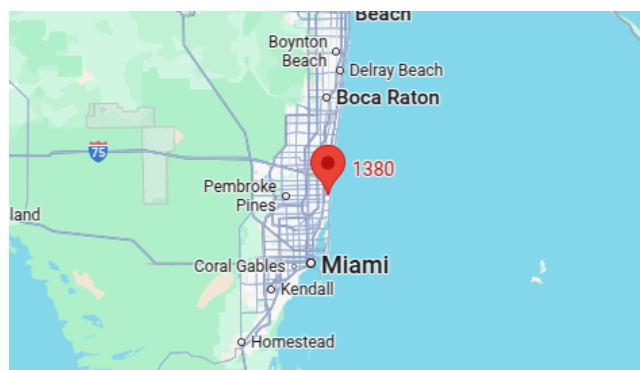
