DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

Presented as a 2024 HCB 39 Speciale, exceptionally maintained, fully serviced, and unequivocally ready to run, this beautiful example embodies the rare blend of offshore muscle and premium refinement that has made the model one of the most coveted luxury center consoles on the water. Built in 2023 and offered as a 2024, it is engineered for serious bluewater performance while delivering indulgent comfort and sophisticated style in every detail.

Professionally maintained to a rigorous standard, this vessel has benefited from meticulous care since new, with both engines fully serviced in November 2025 to ensure all maintenance is current and systems are operating precisely as they should. From bow to stern the boat presents outstandingly well: everything functions properly, systems are expertly dialed in, and the pride of ownership is immediately evident. If you are seeking a clean, correctly maintained HCB 39 Speciale that is truly ready for immediate delivery and effortless enjoyment, this is the one.

Standard equipment

Purpose-built features begin aft with port and starboard fish boxes of 95 gal each, complemented by stainless steel bow rails and a well-appointed cabin with a berth, sink, and mirror, plus an enclosed head compartment featuring a ceramic macerating electric-flush toilet, a 16 gal holding tank, and convenient dockside pump-out. The cabin floor is finished in Sea Dek in camel, mocha, and black tones, enhanced by two portlights, while a freshwater cockpit shower is neatly integrated into the hardtop frame. Entertaining comes naturally with stainless drink holders—seven in the cockpit and four in the gunwales—and a starboard-side dive door that opens inward for effortless dockside use, paired

to a heavy-duty telescoping dive ladder and a freshwater engine flush system. Six removable fender holders keep gear organized; the hand-laid hull laminate boasts a solid hull bottom with vinyl ester resin and Kevlar; and the oversized fiberglass hardtop is reinforced and outfitted with five rod holders, four spreader lights, and overhead RGBW lighting. Insulated deck lids employ rubber gaskets, drainage channels, and Frigid Rigid components, while forward bow seating provides supportive backrests, plush cushions, and generous storage beneath. Night operations benefit from a remote spotlight with dash-mounted control. Anglers will appreciate ten gunwale-mount rod holders, four dedicated deep-drop holders, and a swivel gunwale mount, along with tackle storage thoughtfully arranged in the cabin. Comfort underway is assured by a forward console lounge with a contoured backrest, armrests, and two drink holders, joined by triple captain's chairs at the helm on a fiberglass base. Practical washdowns supply both fresh and raw water, and the windshield wiper/washer system pairs with a 35 lb windlass serving a stainless steel anchor with 60' of chain and 300' of rope. Completing the offshore arsenal are Gemlux outriggers with 18' telescoping carbon-fiber poles.

Engines

Power comes from twin Mercury 600 HP black outboards, delivering effortless thrust and commanding speed. Precision handling is assured through electronic steering with intuitive joystick control, while an autopilot adds confidence and ease on long runs or intricate approaches.

Electronics and audio system

The integrated helm suite features a Garmin AIS communication system, a 4' Garmin open-array radar rated at 4 kW, and Garmin XM Weather for real-time meteorological insight. Command comes via two Garmin 8612 10" displays and

one 12" screen, supported by dual 1 kW Airmar b175h hi/low CHIRP transducers for crisp, penetrating sonar imagery. The entertainment package is equally formidable, with a total of four 7.7" speakers, four 8.8" speakers, four 10" subwoofers, two 6.5" speakers, and two tweeters delivering immersive, high-fidelity sound throughout the boat. Communications are handled by an Icom VHF radio for clear, reliable ship-to-ship and ship-to-shore contact.

Mechanical

Dockside precision and offshore poise come courtesy of a bow thruster, while the Seakeeper model DC3—reducing standard fuel capacity from 525 gallons to 450 gallons—dramatically stabilizes the ride at rest and underway. Fine-tuning performance is effortless with stainless-steel trim tabs driven by dual electric rams, delivering the perfect running attitude across changing conditions.


