OVERVIEW

This luxury center console sportfishing motor yacht marries exhilarating performance with sophisticated styling, driven by four Mercury Verado V6 400 hp outboards and made effortless at close quarters by precision joystick docking control. A platinum metallic hull finish announces its presence on the water while an electric anchor windlass tames the mooring chores; inside, a rosewood designer interior package provides sumptuous appointments that flow through the salon and helm. The aft cockpit features a dining table and a starboard fold-out cockpit bench seat for convivial al fresco meals, complemented by LED underwater illumination that sets the scene at dusk and a dedicated chiller fridge (cooler-only) to keep provisions chilled. The protected helm benefits from full-height side glass and canvas mesh windshield sunshades with a forward bow sunshade extending comfort forward, and a premium upgraded audio system fills the vessel with sound. For long-range confidence and a serene ride, a gyroscopic stabilizer soothes motion while a Dual 19" Raymarine Axiom XL navigation suite is augmented by an additional 24" Raymarine Axiom XL display. Practical systems are seamlessly integrated, from the freshwater engine flush system and diesel generator to the onboard watermaker/desalinator, and outriggers rigged for offshore sportfishing and bluewater adventures (dayboat/powerboat) complete a configuration built for both serious angling and luxurious cruising.
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2021 Boston Whaler 405 conquest

Celebrated as the SUV of the Sea, the 405 Conquest marries incredible performance, versatility and intuitive ease of use with a level of finish that defines the pinnacle of the Conquest series, and from the expansive bow lounge to the ultra convertible helm companion zone and the welcoming cabin with a master and two guest sleeping quarters you never have to choose between comfort and capability. Every exterior fitting is 316 L stainless steel, every rail is precision welded 316 L stainless steel, and the entire hull and hull sides are protected by a vinylester barrier coat—durability and shine engineered in from the start. On deck the details are obsessively executed, with ten inch stainless steel pull up cleats intelligently distributed—two at the bow, two for spring lines, and two crosstie cleats at the transom—complemented by ten inch stainless steel cleats at the stern cockpit with gunwale hawse pipes two and one at the anchor locker, while a 27 inch interior freeboard inspires confidence and an acrylic transom door with stainless steel latch and a transom boarding ladder ease movement aboard. The heavy duty polished stainless steel bow eye, chrome Boston Whaler logo and model designation, white rub rail with stainless insert, and coaming bolsters in the cockpit all underscore premium intent, and an anchor windlass system stands ready with 400 feet of rode plus chain, handheld remote control, a stainless steel swivel, a polished stainless steel 44 lb anchor, and a polished stainless steel bow roller davit. A molded fiberglass port side dive door with removable stainless steel dive ladder stows neatly in the stern seat, and showers with hot and cold freshwater are thoughtfully placed near both the transom door and the dive door. Stainless steel drink holders are everywhere you want them—four in the bow, two in the hawse pipes, two at

the helm, two at the port console, two at the port lounge, and two per side in the recessed pockets at the aft helm deck seats—while multicolor LED courtesy lighting sets the cockpit mood. A 19 gallon pressurized, insulated livewell in the aft port corner features a clear lid, blue interior, and dual white LED lights. Welded stainless steel handrails guide you along the companionway up to the helm deck and down into the cabin, at the boarding ladders and the prep station, and high welded stainless bow rails add security underway. Stainless steel cockpit toe rails integrate an under gunwale storage shelf with downrigger weight holders one per side, and anglers enjoy three gunnel mounted rod holders aft to starboard and two to port, plus two under gunwale holders to starboard. The self bailing cockpit sole, an ACR RCL 75 spotlight mounted on the hardtop with helm control, and a polished execution of every touchpoint complete a deck built to adventure.

The starboard side helm console is a captain's command center designed for long passages and confident offshore angling, with climate controlled by a 16K BTU A/C unit with two helm vents and a wet bar area vent, while a port and starboard defogger system with a 120 V heater and blower keeps sightlines crystal clear. A 7 inch color LCD touchscreen system monitor serves as your shipwide control center, extra deep stainless steel drink holders keep refreshments secure, and a broad electronics mounting surface accommodates either dual 16 inch or dual 19 inch Raymarine displays. Stainless steel push button electrical switch panels with illuminated text sit within easy reach, a molded footrest with solid teak steps in a satin finish, Fusion USB and Aux input, and a cast stainless steel steering wheel with knob and tilt helm elevate ergonomics. Mercury DTS dual binnacle controls feature integrated engine trim, a single remote ignition key switch in the cabin with push button start/stop at the helm, and a Mercury SmartCraft VesselView 5 inch color LCD display with network connections to the Raymarine Navigation Package, while a stainless grab rail, spotlight control, and a cleverly recessed storage tray atop the dash with one dual USB and one 12 V wireless

cell phone charging holder keep everything secure and close at hand.

The open windshield hardtop system extends both protection and capability, with a rigid Makrolon polycarbonate weather enclosure in white Stamoid canvas that spans from cabin door to cockpit and tucks into dedicated storage in the aft portion of the hardtop, and a custom painted, integrated aluminum hardtop and windshield frame that carries two deck hatches with openings integrated into the hardtop and a continuous handhold along the top for safe passage to the foredeck, with ladder access to the hardtop itself. LED lighting is abundant and purposeful—blue/white overhead lights arranged with three across the aft end of the hardtop, two midships over the wet bar and seating, and one forward center; two blue companionway lights at the helm deck step and cabin entry steps activated via solar sensor; one red/white overhead map light; and flood lights two bathing the cockpit and one lighting the bow—while stainless steel LED navigation lights are cleanly recessed into the hardtop. The boat is outrigger ready with six rod holders integrated into the port and starboard ladder supports, and the helm enclosure is completed by open tempered side glass, a cockpit sunshade on a telescoping polished stainless steel frame that deploys and retracts electrically with black Sunbrella canvas, a full height single piece tempered glass windshield with dual electrically actuated vents and independent control, and two pantograph windshield wipers with intermittent wash system.

Opposite the helm, the port lounge and console form an ultra convertible social zone where a dedicated 12K BTU A/C unit delivers two vents on the dash and an additional seating area vent across an elegant acrylic/glass dash, two stainless drink holders and a dual helm seat with armrests that convert into a generous sun lounge create convivial comfort, and a Fusion Bluetooth stereo remote keeps the soundtrack at your fingertips. A glovebox style storage compartment includes one dual USB and a white LED light, the dash top recess adds one dual USB and one 12 V wireless charging holder, and at the aft lounge a high gloss teak table with polished stainless inlay transforms at

the touch of a button with electric high / low conversion.

Below, the galley is fully appointed with a 110 V outlet, a 12 V/120 V refrigerator, Corian solid surface countertop, sink with faucet and cutting board, microwave, and a skylight that floods the space with natural light, while a trash receptacle is cleverly tucked under the companionway step and warm wood grain cabinetry provides refined stowage. Seating throughout is flexible and substantial: forward the bow lounge with dual row tilt up backrests includes a fitted canvas cover, a foldaway stern bench with an elevated backrest tucks away when it's time to fish, the helm seat offers fore and aft electric adjustment with swivel, and multiple convertible port and starboard seating arrangements create aft facing lounges, mezzanine perches and practical countertop space at the prep station.

Storage is abundant and intelligently distributed, with a large storage tray in the bilge's aft mechanical space deleted with gyro, upper, mid and lower cabinets in the cabin galley, cabinets above the starboard settee, an in floor storage compartment and additional stowage beneath the starboard settee in the main cabin, and integrated downrigger weight holders, storage below the pullout grill and an insulated 220 qt built in cooler/storage under seating with dual access in the cockpit. Under the starboard gunwale two rod holders are provided deleted with the foldout bench seat option, two insulated in deck fish boxes with pump out stand ready for the day's catch, and the guest mid berth offers a large storage compartment under the berth with pull out drawers paired with a port side cedar lined hanging locker with removable shelves, dish storage and light plus additional port side storage under a hinged countertop. The head offers storage beneath the sink and overhead, and the helm deck adds a port side glovebox and forward storage tray while starboard helm storage drawers, a forward tray, and wet bar drawers and compartment deliver further organization. In the master stateroom forward a large compartment beneath the berth, a port side vertical cabinet with shelves and light, and a starboard cedar lined hanging locker with light keep personal

effects perfectly ordered.

The main cabin interior balances technology and warmth with a 120 V receptacle and 12 V plus dual USB receptacles for devices, a 16,000 BTU reverse cycle air conditioner for year round comfort, carbon monoxide and smoke detectors for peace of mind, satin finished teak cabinetry with maple lining over the settee and easy to clean materials throughout, a lockable acrylic cabin entry door, two dimmable white LED overhead lights and LED RGB diffused courtesy lighting with dimmer control, four opening portholes in the hull side windows and a skylight with magnetic stow away shade that pours in daylight. An L shaped settee hides storage under the cushions and includes dedicated filler cushions to create a sleeping berth, a solid teak dinette table with gloss finish folds and drops electrically to become a berth, five throw pillows and hull side windows with pull down pleated shades complete the ambiance, and digital vessel control via iPad with inductive charging case lets you monitor vessel systems and control DC circuits with fingertip ease.

In the master stateroom and forward berth luxury continues with port and starboard 120 V receptacles, an 8,000 BTU reverse cycle air conditioner with LCD control, satin finished solid teak flooring and entry steps, an island bed offering trunk style front storage access via a gas assist hatch, an 8 inch thick Premium Handcraft pillowtop innerspring mattress with electrically actuated hinged backrest plus fitted sheet, comforter and two regular size pillowcases, overhead cabinets with flip up doors, carbon monoxide and smoke detectors, a sliding pocket door separating the stateroom from the salon, LED RGB diffused courtesy lighting with dimmer, four LED overhead lights and two LED overhead reading lights, an opening hatch, service access to the A/C unit through the forward bulkhead and to the bow thruster through the floor, a starboard cedar lined hanging locker with door activated light and a port locker with cedar lining, shelves and door activated light. A Dyson V7 handheld vacuum with charging holder, a 24 inch flat screen HDTV with Apple TV integration, Vimar single USB

receptacles on port and starboard nightstands, a Vimar overhead light switch on the starboard nightstand and hull side windows with pull down pleated shades round out the suite.

The enclosed head compartment is spa serene and smart, with a 120 V receptacle at the vanity to support personal appliances and dual entrances from the cabin and from the master for privacy and convenience.

Solid surface flooring graces the shower while solid teak warms the vanity area, two dimmable LED overhead fixtures and LED RGB diffused courtesy lighting with dimmer control illuminate the space, a full length mirror on the acrylic stateroom access door, an opening port light and a stainless steel handrail refine the experience, and the enclosed shower features a rain head and hand held sprayer with hot and cold faucet and a bi fold acrylic shower divider with a dedicated shower sump below and a frosted glass skylight above. Thoughtful touches include a toilet paper holder inside the vanity, towel ring and bar, a trash chute in the counter, and a Vacu Flush electric toilet that connects to a holding tank with vent filter, overboard discharge, dockside pump out, a tank full indicator alert and progressive tank level indication integrated into the digital network, while ample vanity storage and a ceramic vessel sink with polished chrome faucet pair with forced air ventilation to keep the space fresh.

Whether you're cruising long distances with overnight stays, running far offshore for game fish, or hosting impromptu gatherings, the 405 Conquest delivers unshakable Boston Whaler confidence with unflinching luxury and makes every horizon feel closer.
