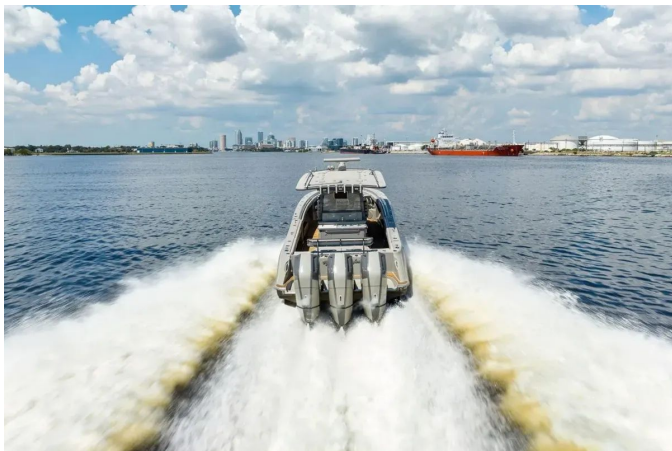

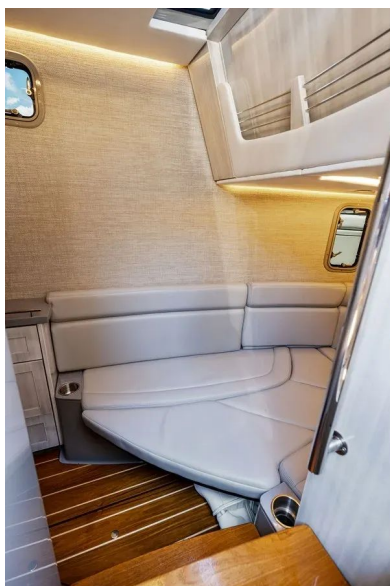
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

FIFTY SHADES OF GRAYDON is a tastefully appointed 2023 HCB 42 Lujo driven by three Mercury Verado V12 600 hp outboards, producing a combined 1,800 horsepower, with engine warranty protection extended through 2028. Crafted to blend genuine offshore capability with the polished interiors and finish that define HCB, she presents a highly adaptable platform equally suited to elegant dayboat entertaining, serious fishing, or effortless runs between South Florida and the Bahamas. Her equipment list is comprehensive, featuring a Seakeeper DC3 for stabilization, a bow thruster and Mercury joystick for precise maneuvering, helm air conditioning for comfort underway, and a full Garmin electronics suite with open array radar. Entertainment and convenience are elevated by an upgraded JL Audio system, multicolor underwater lighting, carbon fiber Gemplux outriggers, and a fully fitted summer kitchen that complements the social spaces on deck. The layout balances relaxation and function: expansive cockpit and bow seating create multiple lounge and gathering zones, while below decks an air conditioned cabin offers a convertible settee and a berth for two, a galley with refrigerator, a television, and a private enclosed head with shower. Recently she has undergone an extensive exterior cosmetic refresh—including wet sanding, compounding, polishing and a full detail—resulting in a notably improved presentation. With triple Mercury V12 power, Seakeeper stabilization, advanced electronics, premium accommodations and HCB's offshore focused hull design, this 42 Lujo delivers an enticing synthesis of performance, luxury and versatility.

Specifications

Engineered specifically for sport fishing, this vessel carries a nominal length of

42 ft and, with the drives up, a shallow draft of 2 ft 0 in—granting effortless access to skinny water while retaining the poise required for offshore excursions. Weighing 24,000 lb dry and featuring a transom deadrise of 23 degrees, the hull is tuned to carve through waves with steady, controlled motion. Reliability and propulsion are enhanced by stainless-steel propellers on each of the three outboards, providing durable, responsive thrust. The listing is published in Tampa, Florida, United States, 33616, and price terms are negotiable.

Features

A meticulously fitted Navigation Center brings command and situational awareness to the helm, uniting GPS, radar, chartplotter, depthsounder and compass with an autopilot and a highly responsive touch screen interface for intuitive control. Clear, reliable communication is provided by VHF while onboard connectivity is sustained by Wi-Fi, and leisure is well catered for with a radio feeding cockpit speakers alongside a flat screen TV and additional television for onboard entertainment. Guest comfort is assured by air conditioning, an electric head and a refrigerator, while essential electrical and plumbing systems include a battery charger, shore power inlet and sea water pump. Maneuvering and deck operations are made simple by a bow thruster, electric bilge pump and electric winch, and exceptional seakeeping is delivered by a Seakeeper unit coupled with a gyroscopic stabilizer to ensure composed performance underway. The deck layout is as thoughtful as it is practical: a protective hard top and a Walk Around configuration promote safe movement, while cockpit cushions, a cockpit shower, a swimming ladder and underwater lights elevate anchorage moments. For anglers and offshore explorers, outriggers extend your reach, creating a yacht that harmonizes performance and pleasure.

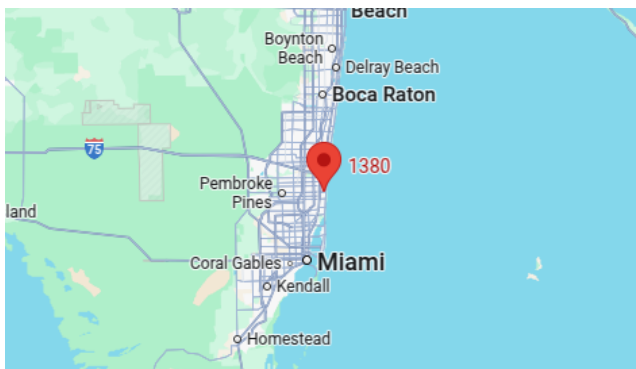
