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OVERVIEW

Available with a full new-boat warranty and with part exchange considered, this Princess V40 is presented with photography, video and an immersive virtual tour for immediate inspection. Built in 2024, she is driven by twin Volvo Penta D6-380 DP diesels (2 x 380 hp) and steered with Volvo joystick control with high speed driving assist, the helm further enhanced by a Garmin Glass Cockpit with 16" + 7" displays integrated with Volvo autopilot, radar and windscreen demist.

Inside, satin walnut cabinetry flows throughout, complemented by cabin heating and an ONAN generator for dependable systems; a heated floor serves the bathroom. Practical pleasures include a bow thruster, teak laid to side decks, a cockpit wetbar with BBQ and an aft sunpad with extended seat and sliding backrest, while the aft twin cabin converts from twin berths to a double via a slide to double berth conversion. A refined Princess V40 sports cruiser that harmonises performance and poise — an elegant express cruiser, luxury motor yacht and premium powerboat in one; further details available on request.

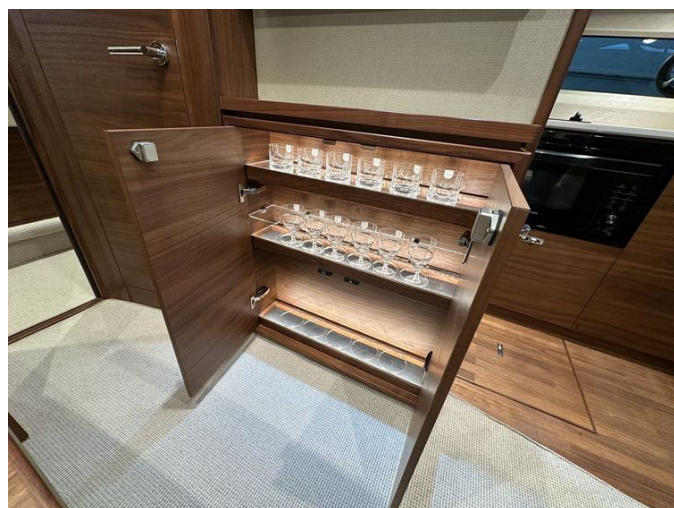

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Options included

This specification has been curated to make every moment on board effortless, refined and reassuringly capable, combining intuitive control, considered ergonomics and a cohesive finish throughout. At the helm, intuitive joystick control and a powerful bowthruster (60 Kgf) deliver precise low speed handling and confident close quarters manoeuvres, while the hull presents a crisp White finish accented by a dark grey waterline, black antifouling, canopy feature lines and a screen brow and engine canopy vent in Oyster Grey metallic; hull and bathing platform fendering are White with a stainless steel insert for a clean, sophisticated edge. Inside, walnut interior wood in a satin finish sets a warm, contemporary tone, complemented by the random block walnut galley floor as standard and a purposeful, modern helm console in Anthracite Grey. Flexibility defines the layout: the aft seat gains a sunbed option with an extension and a sliding backrest to convert into a generous sunpad whenever desired, and the aft cabin features a sliding double berth conversion to tailor the space to day and night use. The galley is finished with a Solid Surface Koko White worktop, balancing resilience with pristine elegance, and in the bathrooms Carrara White Solid Surface countertops in a gloss finish pair with Koko White Solid Surface floors in a satin finish, the comfort further enhanced by the heated floor WC (103585). The chosen colour scheme draws from the Quartz VIII range of fabrics as standard, grounded by a premium Natural Weave Square Marl carpet, while refinement continues with rectangular quilted blankets in linen Focus 10650-991 and upholstery to sofas and bedheads in Ouessant galet 37390334, harmonising texture, tone and tactile luxury. On deck, hardware is selected for both performance and pleasure: for safe handling and optimal performance the maximum permitted

tender weight, including outboard, is 100 kg, and a sliding side window at the helm position (aperture 42 cm H x 38 cm L) brings instant ventilation; a drop nose pulpit replaces the standard wraparound to reveal a sleeker foredeck. At the stern, an electric windlass handles a 50 m leaded rope, while forward a stainless steel anchor of 16 kg replaces the standard unit and is complemented by an extra ten metres of galvanised chain; teak laid side decks and foredeck elevate the exterior (cockpit deck and transom platform teak remain standard), and a raised teak deck at the helm (60 cm wide x 10 cm high) folds neatly under the helm seat when not required, with an anchor chain counter at the helm for the fore anchor tying it all together with fingertip precision. Power autonomy is assured by an ONAN 4 Kw/50Hz generator with Hydrohush exhaust system and a sound shield, and electrically the yacht is equipped with Continental 220v/240v sockets, a ceramic electric hob with two burners replacing the standard gas hob and gas system, and an electric BBQ in the cockpit wetbar. Night ambiance is transformed by underwater transom lights—two LUMISHORE SMX53 White/Blue—paired with white low level cockpit and bathing platform LED lighting in addition to the standard overhead LEDs, while a dimmer switch is fitted to overhead lighting in the saloon, cabins, bathroom and cockpit with two additional downlights above the dinette table for focused brilliance. Practical connectivity is expanded with an additional 220V interior power point on the port side of the saloon near the sofa (103244) and an additional 220V socket on the port side in the cockpit near the U shape sofa (103245), and for clean cable management and future proofing copex with mouse (NSO 106775) is installed from the engine room to the fuse panel in the aft cabin, from the engine room to the electric panel in the galley and from the fuse panel in the aft cabin to the electric panel in the galley, with a shorepower cable including adapter completing the system. The audio visual and communications suite sets the tone from the moment you step aboard: the standard system brings the saloon to life with a Fusion Apollo MS RA670 featuring DAB/Bluetooth and external USB, paired with two Fusion speakers,

while the cockpit benefits from two Fusion waterproof speakers linked to the saloon audio; for easy, flexible control the package includes two Fusion ARX 70 wireless remotes in black supplied loose for later fitting, and entertainment is anchored by a Saloon TV & Audio Package with a 32" LED TV linked to the standard Fusion unit paired with two more Fusion speakers, with an elevated helm experience available as (107022) a Fusion MS RA770 fitted in place of the RA 670. Pre wiring is thoughtfully provided with (104630) a TV antenna outlet and 220V socket in the fore cabin for later fitting of a TV and the same provision in the aft cabin. Navigation is centred on Volvo Penta/Garmin Glass Cockpit technology with a seven inch multi display and a sixteen inch multi display dedicated to plotting, engine data including the trip computer presented seamlessly across the multidisplays, precision steering assured by a Volvo Penta autopilot with "shadow drive" backed by a depth transducer and joystick driving functionality embedded within the joystick, all Raymarine equipment cancelled in favour of this integrated suite and charting delivered via Garmin electronic chart BLUECHART G3 VEU721L NORTHERN EUROPE with situational awareness elevated by a Garmin GMR 18HD radome radar antenna and dependable communication through a Garmin VHF 315. Comfort in all seasons is assured with a windscreen demist system that channels warm air from the calorifier and comprehensive Eberspacher D4 Airtronic boat heating including a special air silencer on the heater air inlet plus outlets in all cabins, saloon and bathroom with silencers for inlets/outlets and an additional outlet in the cockpit; practical details continue with mosquito screens fitted to all opening portlights and an electric discharge of the holding tank. Upholstery and canvas details have been chosen for both visual harmony and practical excellence: helm and cockpit seating, with contrast detailing at the helm, on the back of the portside curved backrest and as an inlay to the aft cockpit backrest cushions, are finished in Comfort Exterior III Vogue Eucalyptus with Vogue Earth contrast, glare is reduced by a grey anti reflective cover to the horizontal area behind the windscreen that is easily removable and

secured by poppers, and versatility is enhanced by a full height cockpit cover in grey Sunbrella with removable sides and back on a telescopic stainless steel frame with vertical supports installed in place of the standard tonneau so that when the sides are removed the top serves as a graceful sun awning. To complete the onboard experience, the galley and table are set with Princess China consisting of a five piece service—plate, side plate, bowl, cup and saucer—in a six place setting, Princess Glasses comprising six wine glasses and six tumblers, and David Mellor 'Paris' cutlery six piece in a six place set, ensuring every meal is served with the elegance this yacht deserves.
