Impeccable fit and finish, a dry, silky ride, and relentless performance elevate this luxury center console powerboat into bona fide sport yacht status. In the bluewater, offshore performance boat category, there truly is nothing else quite like it.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Standard equipment

---

Every detail on board is engineered for confidence and comfort, beginning with Gemlux flush-mount cleats, a stainless steel pop-up bow light, and under-gunwale courtesy lighting that sets an elegant nighttime ambience. Effortless control comes from hydraulic power steering, while the helm area is refined with console and combing cushions and a lighted digital fly-by-wire switch panel. Live bait stays healthy thanks to Rule 1100 GPH baitwell pumps and an aft 80-gallon livewell, complemented by a macerated 530 qt fish box ready for serious hauls. Bilge management is robust with two Rule 2000 bilge pumps, and the rigging is uncompromising, featuring tinned copper wiring, Deutsch connectors, and an O-ring gutter system for clean, dry compartments. Hardware is premium throughout, including stainless steel D-rings, Gemlux 2" fuel fills, four Gemlux rod holders, Gemlux stainless steel thru-hull fittings, and Gemlux ball valves. Performance trim is assured with high-performance K Plane trim tabs, and fishability is enhanced under a T-top fitted with seven rod holders and a saltwater washdown. Extended days on the water are made easy with 82 gallons of fresh water, a toilet and shower, and a V-berth sleeper—all of it underpinned by thoughtful, durable construction built to go the distance.

## Deluxe options

---

Elevate the experience with an Edson black steering wheel upgrade beneath a dual-row hardtop complete with grab rails, Gemlux Bluewater outrigger bases, and clever rodholder-cupholder combinations. Fish hard with HD swivel rodholders, Hubbell electric reel outlets, a midship tackle box, transom livewell windows, a three-pump seachest, gaff tubes, and dedicated fender cleats, all

anchored by an aft-side tackle station configured as a deluxe fishing station. Comfort meets control in dual-row seating with a grab bar and fold down footrest, plus 39/42 front FWD seating with flip up backrests, a two tone interior (GT Boxing), the Mystic Hex stitching package, a console kneepad, and Yellowfin helm seating—42 with a triple headrest. Freshen up with a pull shower, extend autonomy with an extra house battery, and stay cool with air conditioning (DC 12 V). Nighttime drama and underwater allure arrive via three Lumitec SeaBlaze X2 RGB underwater lights, while precision handling is enhanced by a bow thruster. Anchoring is effortless with an electric drum style anchor puller paired to a stainless steel plow anchor, 475' of rope, and 20' of chain for the windlass. Practical luxury continues with a hull side dive door with ladder, a Reverso flushing system—Quad, the commanding K460 air horn package, powder coated bowrails, and two chill plates. Rounding out the helm is a misc eight switch pre labeled panel and a Windshield Eisen filler, delivering a polished, expedition ready finish.

## Electronics

---

Commanding visibility and seamless control come through a Garmin 9224 MFD paired with the Garmin GSD28 sounder module and Airmar R509LHW transducers, while a Farmin GMR 1234 radar keeps you informed when weather closes in. The Garmin GXM 54 SiriusXM weather module adds real time forecasting, and communications are crystal clear via an Icom M510 VHF with relocation kit. Entertainment is anchored by the JL MM105 stereo and the 390 420 Ultra Package: four JL Audio 7.7" coaxial speakers, eight JL Audio 8.8" coaxial speakers, six JL Audio 10" subwoofers, and three JL Audio Mv1000/5i amplifiers, delivering stadium grade sound at sea. Security and connectivity are elevated with the GOST Nav Tracker Evolution IDP S&M Package and a Starlink system with inverter package. Illuminate the run with three Lumitec Razor 18 inch lightbars, completing a helm suite that is as

capable as it is uncompromising.

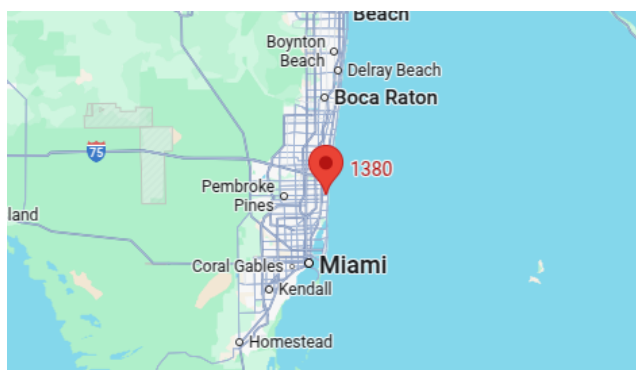
