Uniquely specified as the only example of its kind with a robust bow thruster for razor-sharp maneuvering, she also boasts a highly coveted, full Garmin electronics suite. Fastidiously cared for and stored indoors in a climate-controlled facility, this premium cabin cruiser provides added assurance with three comprehensive aftermarket extended warranties covering her from stem to stern.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Construction

Built with a fiberglass hull and superstructure, the yacht delivers a strong, low maintenance platform with a clean finish and a smooth, quiet ride.

Dimensions

Overall length measures 42.33 feet (12.90 meters) with a length at the waterline of 38.00 feet (11.58 meters); bridge clearance is 12.33 feet (3.76 meters), molded beam spans 12.92 feet (3.93 meters), and loaded draft is 3.88 feet (1.18 meters), with a dry weight of 24,767 pounds. Fuel capacity totals 384 US gallons (1,454 liters), fresh water capacity is 50 US gallons (189 liters), and the holding tank carries 31 US gallons (117 liters). Performance is confident and efficient, reaching a maximum of 45.2 knots (52 miles per hour), a comfortable cruising speed of 34.8 knots (40 miles per hour), and an economical pace of 26.1 knots (30 miles per hour).

Machinery

Power comes from two Mercury Verado V12 outboards rated at 600 horsepower each, four stroke, swinging stainless steel propellers. Electrical needs are met by a 120/240V system supported by one 8.5 kW Kohler diesel generator in a sound shield sipping just 0.5 gallons per hour, plus dual 30 amp shore power. Batteries are new for 2025 and include two engine start and two house units, managed through an AC/DC panel with voltmeters and a battery parallel switch, with charging handled by two Overseer chargers serving both outboards and the generator. Climate control is Dometic with three units—one at 15,000 BTU and two at 12,000 BTU—for reliable comfort

throughout the boat. Ride and handling are enhanced by Bennett hydraulic trim tabs with indicators and a SeaKeeper 6 gyro, while a Sleipner 6 hp electric bow thruster (not interfaced with the joystick) offers precise low speed control; steering features joystick control with Mercury Skyhook and a tilt wheel. The fuel system benefits from two SeaFlo SFDPZ primary fuel pumps, two Mercury 35 8M0162829 secondary filters, and a fuel overflow recovery system. Waste management includes a Reverso flush system and a macerator with overboard discharge, and fresh water is delivered by an electric 110V pump. Bilge protection includes three Rule 900 GPH 3407 pumps, a Rule 40A Rule A Matic Plus float switch, and a high water alarm. Convenience features include a 120V central vacuum system and a trash compactor.

Communication, navigation & entertainment systems

Clear communication is provided by a Garmin VHF, while navigation is anchored by a Garmin radar, Garmin autopilot, Garmin depth sounder, Garmin GPS, and a Garmin chart plotter, complemented by a six inch magnetic compass. Entertainment is equally well considered, with two 32 inch Samsung televisions serving the main and lower decks, Rockford Fosgate speakers energizing the main deck, a Rockford Fosgate PMXIR stereo at the helm, and a Rockford Fosgate PMX80H system for the lower deck.

Galley equipment

On the main deck, a well appointed wet bar features a sink and under bar storage, a Kenyon electric grill, and cold storage via two Vitrifrigo refrigerators plus a Vitrifrigo icemaker integrated beneath the helm seat. Below, the lower galley adds a Zest microwave/convection oven, one Vitrifrigo refrigerator, and a dedicated Vitrifrigo icemaker to keep provisions organized and mealtimes

easy.

Toys

For time in the water, dive gear including masks and fins is carried aboard to make every anchorage more inviting.

Deck equipment

Ground tackle is handled by a Genius windlass paired with a 25 pound stainless steel anchor, thirty feet of 8 mm chain, and one hundred fifty feet of five eighths inch rope. The fixed swim platform is enhanced by hydraulic fold down side balconies that expand space at the waterline, while the hardtop features a hydraulic retractable sunroof with side opening windows and a sunshade for effortless indoor outdoor flow.

Security, fire fighting & safety equipment

Fire protection is comprehensive, with one Fireboy MA2 550 227 automatic extinguisher and three Fireboy BL9 handheld units, supported by one smoke and fire detector for early warning. Safety gear includes one floating life ring with line, a sealed box of flares, and an emergency first aid kit for peace of mind underway.

Accommodations

LAZY BLUM is a 42 foot 2023 Cruisers GLS OB motoryacht that blends the punch of outboard propulsion with the inviting volume and refinement Cruisers Yachts is known for. Step aboard to an expansive swim platform whose fold down sides dramatically increase usable space and bring you closer to the water; panoramic windows flood the interior with natural light,

and a retractable sunroof transforms the cockpit into an open air retreat at the touch of a button. Entertaining is effortless on the main deck with a premium wet bar featuring two refrigerators and an icemaker, a built in electric grill, generous counter space, and integrated seating, while the bow lounge beyond the cockpit invites sunbathing, conversation, and quiet time with a view. Below, the lower deck welcomes you with a practical, comfortable layout: a U shaped dinette converts quickly into a spacious berth for two guests in the owner's party, and the lower galley provides a microwave, refrigerator, and ample storage so home comforts are always within reach. A full head surprises with its volume, offering a standing shower, sink, and an electronic toilet to keep routines simple and pleasant. More than a typical cruising yacht, the 42' Cruisers GLS Outboard is a beautifully executed living space that adapts to your plans—equally ready for a peaceful escape or a memorable outing with family and friends.
