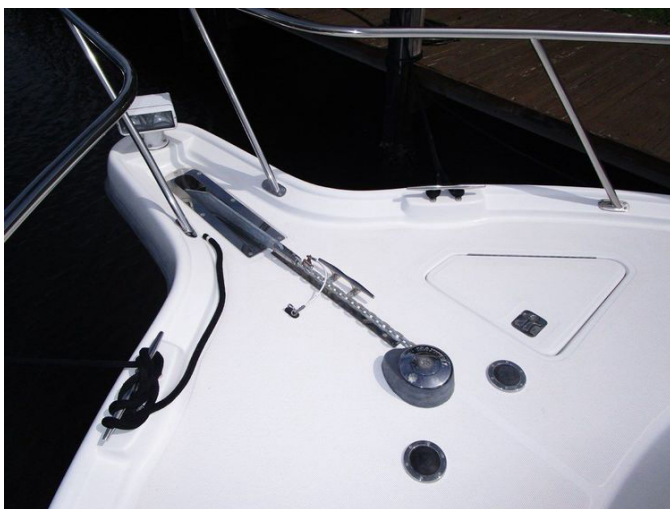
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Walkthrough

Stepping onto the yacht from the side decks, you are welcomed by fiberglass steps on both port and starboard sides, leading you into the non-slip cockpit. This area is designed for both relaxation and practicality, featuring a foldable rear seat, an aft-facing seat, and easy access to the engine room from the cockpit. Centrally located at the aft, a spacious fish well is ready for your daily catch. Climb two additional fiberglass steps to reach the helm deck, which features a carpeted floor and another entry to the engine room. On the port side, a comfortable L-shaped settee invites you to unwind, while the starboard side hosts the helm and a wet bar, offering both control and refreshment. The wrap-around windshield and aft enclosure provide excellent visibility and keep the helm area comfortably air-conditioned.

At the centerline, a sliding acrylic door reveals three steps descending to the favored Plan C cabin. Here, the galley is positioned aft to port, and the upper and lower cabin is located aft to starboard. In the salon, an L-shaped settee with a hinged backrest converts into an upper berth, simultaneously expanding the lower berth. A versatile high-low table is positioned in front of the settee, perfect for dining or relaxing. Forward on the starboard side, the spacious single head features a stall shower, a VacuFlush toilet, and a vanity, offering all the comforts of home.

The forward part of the yacht contains a private stateroom with a tapered queen-sized berth, surrounded by generous storage, including a large space beneath the bed. The master cabin is illuminated by natural light from two deck hatches and offers privacy with a bifold teak door separating it from the salon. Additionally, a second ensuite door provides direct access to the head, enhancing the luxurious and convenient experience.

Foredeck

The foredeck of this yacht exemplifies both practicality and elegance, starting with a molded bow pulpit that seamlessly blends with the vessel's sleek profile. At the forefront, a stainless steel anchor roller accommodates a galvanized Delta plow anchor, ensuring secure anchorage. The Maxwell windlass, with its user-friendly deck switches, handles 50 feet of chain and 150 feet of rode, simplifying the anchoring process. A stainless steel foredeck cleat adds extra security, while the anchor locker, featuring an overboard drain, includes both fresh and raw water washdowns for effortless upkeep.

The foredeck is further enhanced by a welded, single-piece stainless steel bow rail with a pulpit, providing both safety and elegance. A black rubrail with a stainless steel cap adds a sophisticated touch, while the ACR remote control spotlight ensures visibility in dim conditions. The deck is fitted with two stainless steel bow cleats and two stainless steel spring cleats, offering ample mooring options. Three deck hatches, each equipped with built-in privacy screens, allow natural light and airflow.

Navigation is simplified with international navigation lights on both port and starboard, and practical features such as a waste outlet on the starboard side, water fill on the port side, and fuel fills on both sides are thoughtfully integrated. The fiberglass non-skid walk-around decks and deck house ensure safe and comfortable movement across the foredeck, creating a perfect fusion of functionality and luxury.

Hardtop

The hardtop of this yacht, designed by Tiara, seamlessly combines practicality with contemporary aesthetics. It includes two hatches, each fitted with screens for privacy and insect protection, offering both airflow and comfort. On the port side, dual trumpet horns are installed to ensure the yacht's presence is

unmistakable when needed. A 4-inch radar scanner is positioned on an elevated platform, enhancing navigational precision. Communication is effortlessly maintained with two 8-inch VHF antennas, providing dependable connectivity on the water. The KVH TracVision antenna dome grants access to satellite television, while the Sirius radio antenna offers a diverse array of audio entertainment. The hardtop is completed with a fiberglass non-slip surface, ensuring safety and stability as you move around. This blend of cutting-edge technology and meticulous design makes the hardtop a vital component of the yacht's allure.

Cockpit

The cockpit of this yacht is crafted with a focus on both opulence and functionality, beginning with a 30-inch FRP swim platform that includes a concealed stainless steel swim ladder for effortless water access. A transom door with a hinged gate allows for smooth entry, while two stainless steel stern cleats beneath the gunwale, equipped with hawse pipes, ensure secure docking. Additional mooring is facilitated by two stainless steel spring cleats and two fender cleats under the gunwale. Comfort is prioritized with a molded aft-facing lounge that accommodates three and offers storage beneath, shielded by a white cover. Centrally located, this lounge provides an engine room access hatch, simplifying maintenance tasks.

The cockpit features combing bolsters for enhanced comfort and a three-person folding bench seat aft, complete with stainless steel grab rails, expanding seating options. For added convenience, there is a dockside water inlet with a regulator, a 125V 30A power cord inlet with a breaker on the port side, and a 50 Amp 120-240V power cord on a Cablemaster reel with shore power shut off on the starboard side. Entertainment and connectivity are assured with a TV/telephone inlet on the port side and a Fusion stereo remote control MSNRX200i, complemented by two Clarion speakers with tweeters.

Ample storage solutions include molded fiberglass steps leading to the walkways, a removable storage compartment flush with the cockpit deck, and a removable 5-foot catch well. A hinged access hatch to the fuel tank valves, a cockpit shower with hot and cold water, and both fresh and raw water washdowns enhance functionality. The cockpit is illuminated by two LED courtesy lights, two recessed LED Lumitech floodlights, and three overhead halogen lights, creating an inviting ambiance.

Fishing enthusiasts will value the two Lee stainless steel recessed rod holders on both the port and starboard sides, as well as under-gunnel rod and gaff storage. Safety is bolstered with stainless steel grab rails on both sides for boarding, powder-coated grab rails for the hardtop, and on the windshield for walk-around side decks. Tinted canvas curtains with a zip-up door to starboard offer privacy and protection from the elements. Finally, three molded fiberglass steps lead up to the helm deck, completing this meticulously designed cockpit.

Helm Deck

The helm deck of this yacht exemplifies exceptional design and functionality, featuring a Tiara composite windshield frame with three tempered safety glass panels, including a power-operated center section for optimal airflow. The three windshield wipers, equipped with irrigators, guarantee clear visibility in any weather. A clear connector seamlessly joins the Tiara hardtop to the windshield frame, while the tinted polycarbonate side and aft enclosures offer both privacy and protection from the elements.

At the core of the helm deck is the Tiara hinged helm console, paired with a wood and stainless steel steering wheel, providing both elegance and precision. Navigation is supported by a Richie Powerdamp Plus compass, and the extra-wide Stidd helm seat, which is electrically adjustable in all directions, ensures comfort on long journeys. Dedicated marine air conditioning keeps

the helm area cool, while Cummins emergency controls are conveniently stored in a hinged cabinet.

The helm is outfitted with low idle controls, VDO engine gauges, and Teleflex engine controls, along with transmission oil pressure gauges for both port and starboard. Battery voltmeters for both engine and house batteries, as well as fuel gauges for port and starboard, keep you informed of the yacht's status. Safety and functionality are further enhanced by bilge pump indicator lights, a generator indicator light, and an engine synchronizer control. The helm features 26 rocker switches, 22 DC pop breakers, trim tab controls, and an ACR spotlight control, along with a Westmar bow thruster control and key start/stop switches.

For nighttime navigation, four overhead night nav lights illuminate the helm, while an FRP footrest and helm drink holders add to the comfort. The port side navigation center includes a covered chart flat and additional drink holders, and a five-person curved lounge to port offers ample seating with four storage lockers below and an FRP footrest. On the starboard side, a wet bar with a sink, Icer-ETTE icemaker, and bottle storage ensures refreshments are always at hand. Entertainment is provided by two Clarion stereo speakers with tweeters, and a 12V outlet is available for additional devices.

Safety is paramount with an emergency fire system and two blue interior grab rails on the windshield frame. The fiberglass non-skid decking with a carpet overlay ensures secure footing, and a centerline hatch provides easy engine access. Finally, a sliding acrylic door leads to the salon, completing this well-appointed helm deck.

Electronics

The yacht's electronics suite is crafted to deliver cutting-edge navigation, communication, and entertainment features. At the helm, dual Cummins engine displays provide real-time performance metrics, keeping you informed

of the yacht's operational status at all times. The Raymarine E-125 and E-127 hybrid touch multifunction displays (MFDs) offer intuitive navigation and system control, while the Raymarine 8000i Autopilot ensures precise course management for smooth sailing.

Communication is robust with the Raymarine VHF 215, complete with a handheld microphone, and the ICOM IC-M502 VHF, guaranteeing reliable contact with other vessels and shore stations. For depth tracking, the Raymarine ST60 digital depth recorder offers precise readings, enhancing navigational safety. Entertainment and information are seamlessly integrated with the Raymarine 45 STV satellite TV system and Direct TV receiver, allowing you to enjoy your favorite programs while at sea. The Raymarine SR150 Sirius XM weather system keeps you informed of weather conditions, enabling confident journey planning.

The Fusion stereo MS-IP700i provides high-quality audio throughout the yacht, creating a pleasant atmosphere for relaxation or entertaining guests. The ACR URP 102 spotlight control improves visibility during nighttime operations, while the helm air booster fan maintains a comfortable environment at the helm. This comprehensive electronics package ensures that every voyage is as enjoyable and secure as possible.

Salon

Descending three teak steps covered with a removable carpet, you enter the yacht's salon, a space crafted for both leisure and entertainment. On the port side, an ultra-leather convertible L-shaped dinette with a recliner provides a luxurious seating area. This settee effortlessly converts into a Pullman berth, accommodating two extra guests for overnight stays. The focal point of the salon is a finished table with two leaves on a high-low pedestal, ideal for dining or relaxing while enjoying the 40" Samsung TV.

The salon is thoughtfully designed with an overhead hatch that includes a

blackout shade and screen, offering both natural light and privacy. Beneath the steps, three battery cut-off switches provide easy access to power management, while two courtesy lights illuminate the steps for safety. The marine air control panel allows for precise climate adjustments, complemented by ambient rope lighting. Two portholes and recessed speakers enhance the ambiance, while reading lights fore and aft offer focused illumination.

For an immersive audio experience, the salon is equipped with a subwoofer and a Bose surround sound stereo DVD/CD player. The AC/DC distribution panels, along with volt and amp meters, provide comprehensive control over the yacht's electrical systems. The Fireboy liquid level monitor tracks fresh and black water levels, and the shore power/generator switch-over ensures seamless power transitions. The salon's teak and holly sole with a carpet overlay, combined with a vinyl headliner, adds a touch of elegance to this welcoming space.

Galley

Directly to port, the yacht's galley exemplifies both efficiency and elegance, boasting a Corian countertop that offers a sleek and resilient workspace. The stainless steel sink is complemented by a faucet with a detachable sprayer, enhancing convenience for cooking and cleaning. The Kenyon two-burner stove, with Corian covers, maintains a seamless appearance when not in use. Beneath the counter, the Nova Kool refrigerator/freezer provides generous storage for perishables, while a stainless steel Panasonic microwave is positioned above for quick meal preparation. With eight teak cabinet doors, the galley offers abundant storage for all your culinary essentials.

The galley is illuminated by four counter lights, creating a bright and welcoming atmosphere. Safety is paramount, with a CO alarm and smoke detector installed for reassurance. A porthole allows natural light to enter,

enhancing the spacious feel of the area. Above the microwave, a stainless steel pantry door offers additional storage solutions. An exhaust fan effectively eliminates cooking odors, maintaining a fresh environment. The teak and holly sole with a carpet overlay, paired with a vinyl headliner, adds a touch of sophistication to this practical and well-equipped galley.

Guest Stateroom

The Plan C optional private stateroom layout is an ingenious use of space, enabling owners to host guests in a dedicated second stateroom, alongside the standard salon Pullman sleeping arrangement found in other layouts. This well-considered design ensures guests experience both comfort and privacy during their stay.

The guest stateroom is equipped with over/under berths positioned outboard, offering a snug sleeping setup. A porthole allows natural light to stream in, creating a bright and welcoming atmosphere. Each berth is fitted with reading lights, allowing guests to enjoy a book before sleep. A hanging locker, complete with Raymarine antenna control aft, provides ample storage for clothing and personal belongings. The fan speed control lets guests adjust airflow to their preference, enhancing their comfort.

Additional storage is available beneath the lower berth, and a handy nightstand is placed at the lower berth for personal items. The stateroom is accessed through a bifold teak door, adding a touch of elegance. The teak and holly sole with a carpet overlay, paired with a vinyl headliner, completes the refined and inviting ambiance of this well-equipped guest stateroom.

Head

The head of this yacht is a meticulously crafted area, constructed from molded fiberglass to guarantee both durability and easy upkeep. An overhead hatch

with blackout and insect screens allows natural light and airflow while ensuring privacy. The outboard storage cabinet offers generous space for toiletries and essentials, keeping the area neat and organized.

The vanity is tastefully designed with a Corian countertop and features an under-mount sink paired with a stainless steel faucet, blending style with practicality. A medicine cabinet with a mirrored door enhances convenience, providing extra storage and a grooming area. The Vacuflush toilet ensures efficient and dependable operation, while an exhaust fan maintains a fresh environment.

The molded shower enclosure stands out as a highlight of the head, featuring a glass door that adds a luxurious touch. A portlight brings in natural light, enhancing the space, while the molded seat and shelf provide convenience and comfort. The overhead light ensures the shower is well-illuminated, and a towel bar offers a convenient spot for towels. The shower is equipped with both a handheld and fixed shower head, providing flexibility and ease of use. This thoughtfully designed head merges practicality with elegance, creating a comfortable and welcoming space.

Owners Cabin

The owners cabin is a haven of luxury and comfort, featuring an island berth with pneumatic storage beneath, offering generous space for personal items. This expansive area is meticulously designed to include a dedicated section for the Flow Marine 7000 BTU air conditioning unit, ensuring a pleasant climate at all times. An overhead hatch allows abundant natural light to fill the cabin and is equipped with a blackout shade and screen for privacy and light control. Entry to the cabin is through a bifold teak door from the salon, and there is an ensuite teak door leading directly to the head, providing both convenience and privacy.

The cabin is outfitted with teak hanging lockers with lights on both port and

starboard sides, offering ample storage for clothing. The Marine Air air conditioning control allows for easy climate adjustments, while a Sharp Aquos TV provides entertainment options. Teak bookshelves on both sides add a touch of sophistication, and six teak cabinets offer additional storage space. Safety is paramount, with a carbon monoxide sensor and alarm, as well as a smoke detector, ensuring peace of mind.

The cabin's teak and holly sole with a carpet overlay, combined with a vinyl headliner, adds a touch of elegance to the space. Two overhead lights and ambient rope lighting create a warm and inviting atmosphere, making the owners cabin a perfect retreat on the water.

Engine Room

The engine room of this yacht is a powerhouse of performance and efficiency, featuring twin Cummins QSM-11 engines with only 693 original hours, guaranteeing dependable operation and durability. Under the centerline sole, four maintenance-free batteries deliver strong power support. The area is brightly illuminated by four DC fluorescent lights with safety lenses, ensuring clear visibility and safety during maintenance.

Essential systems include a head waste discharge pump and a head waste pump-out diverter valve, promoting effective waste management. A GFCI-protected duplex 110-volt outlet is available for additional electrical requirements. The main engines are fitted with water collector type fiberglass mufflers on both port and starboard sides, ensuring quiet operation. The Reverso oil change pump system, with its five-point access, simplifies maintenance tasks.

Dripless shaft seals and Racor 1000 fuel filters for the engines, along with a Racor fuel filter for the generator, ensure clean and efficient fuel delivery. The autopilot pump and fresh water connection, located centerline aft, enhance operational convenience. Two coolant recovery systems maintain optimal

engine temperatures, while the Cablemaster shore power reel with a cord storage bin on the starboard side ensures easy power management.

Access to the engine room is made easy by a stainless steel four-step ladder leading to the cockpit hatch. Fuel selector valves and an air conditioning raw water pump are strategically positioned for ease of use. The room is equipped with two Professional Mariner zinc saver galvanic isolators, a fiberglass muffler for the generator, and a blower for ventilation. The air conditioning system includes a 16,000 BTU unit and a 6,000 BTU unit, ensuring a comfortable climate throughout the yacht.

Additional features include a 12-volt air compressor with a tank, a Fireboy 23-lb FE 241 cylinder for fire safety, and ZF transmission with ZF311A and a 2.033:1 ratio. Transmission filters, a bow thruster battery shut off and fuse, and a Rule 2000 bilge pump complete the comprehensive setup, making this engine room a well-equipped and vital component of the yacht's operation.

Electrical

The electrical system of this yacht exemplifies Tiara's dedication to quality and dependability, featuring a bespoke 12-volt DC system alongside a 120-volt/240-volt AC setup. This dual configuration ensures that all onboard electrical requirements are met with efficiency and accuracy. The yacht is equipped with a 240-volt, 50-amp, 65-foot shore power cable, offering strong connectivity to shore power sources.

The yacht is powered by four engine batteries and four house batteries, providing ample energy reserves for both propulsion and onboard amenities. The Victron Energy Centaur 12-volt/60-amp battery charger ensures optimal battery performance, while the C-Charger 12-volt regulator maintains consistent voltage levels. A battery parallel solenoid is included for enhanced reliability, facilitating seamless battery management.

At the heart of the yacht's electrical capabilities is the Kohler 8-kilowatt generator, which has only 488 hours of operation, delivering reliable power for extended journeys. This comprehensive electrical system is crafted to support all facets of life on board, from essential operations to luxurious comforts, ensuring a seamless and enjoyable yachting experience.

Remarks

The 4200 Open has long been a preferred choice among Tiara enthusiasts since its introduction, and the reasons are clear. The spacious cockpit provides generous room that can be customized to suit various needs, whether for relaxation or angling. The Plan C layout is especially attractive, offering guests their own private stateroom, which guarantees both comfort and seclusion during their visit. With plentiful seating areas both above and below deck, the "50/50" is ideally suited for both cruising and fishing in style. This blend of intelligent design and adaptable functionality makes the 4200 Open a distinguished option for discerning yacht aficionados.

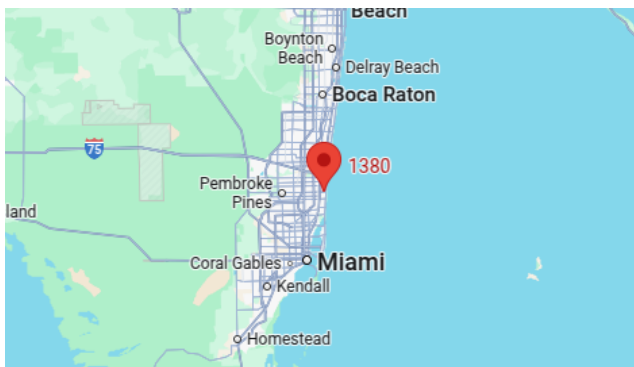
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
