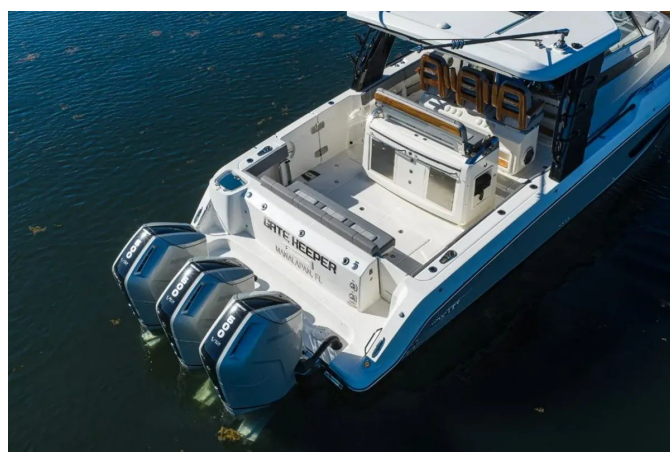
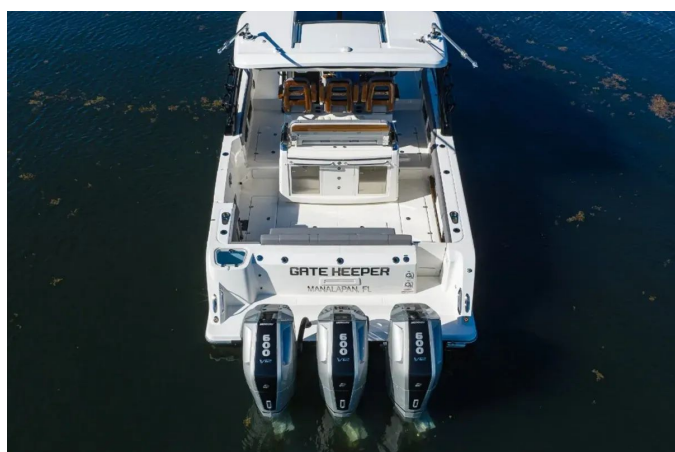

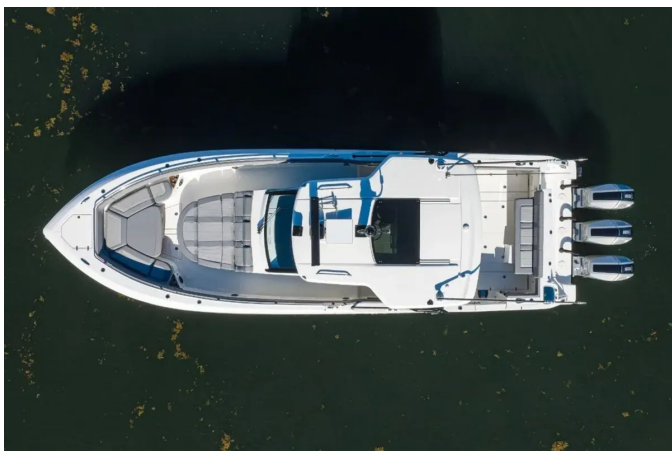


















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

GATE KEEPER is a meticulously outfitted 2024 Boston Whaler 42 Outrage, propelled by three Mercury V12 Verado 600 hp outboards that register only 64 hours of use. Producing a combined 1,800 horsepower and fitted with Mercury Joystick Piloting, she delivers thrilling speed with refined, confidence-inspiring control for offshore passages. A Seakeeper gyroscopic stabilizer, a 6kW bow thruster and premium Gemlux outriggers further enhance her seakeeping and handling, while paint protection film applied to the hull, engines and arch when new preserves her finish and adds lasting protection.

The helm has been elevated with a comprehensive Simrad electronics package centered on triple sixteen-inch NSO multifunction displays, augmented by HALO open-array radar, an S5100 CHIRP sonar with 3D imaging, FLIR thermal imaging, AIS, Sirius marine weather and Starlink Internet for reliable situational awareness and connectivity well offshore. Systems supporting extended time aboard include a 12kW Fischer Panda diesel generator, a Yacht Mate watermaker, reverse-cycle air conditioning and robust electrical distribution.

Interior appointments combine comfort and functionality with a fully equipped cabin and galley, an enclosed head with shower, a 32-inch Samsung QLED 4K TV and a premium JL Audio sound system for elevated onboard entertainment. On deck, refined teak accents, electric sunshades and a full hardtop enclosure create a luxurious environment, with the option of a summer kitchen for flexible cruising or entertaining. Fishing and expedition capability remain uncompromised with refrigerated fishboxes, a pressurized livewell, a dive door and abundant rod storage, making GATE KEEPER equally at home chasing trophies, hosting guests or undertaking long-range offshore adventures.

Electronics

The helm is appointed with three Simrad NSO 16-inch multifunction displays that serve as the nerve center for a fully integrated electronics suite, paired with Mercury VesselView Link to present seamless engine monitoring and diagnostics. Voice and data communications are handled by a Simrad RS40 VHF radio equipped with AIS and an HS40 wireless handset, while precise navigation is provided by a GS25 GPS antenna 15 N2K with an integrated heading sensor. Beneath the surface, a Simrad S5100 CHIRP sounder module with 3D imaging renders exceptional bottom definition, and an upgraded FLIR M364C thermal camera extends confident visibility after dark; docking is made simpler with a Simrad IP CAM-1 rear-view video camera. Expansive situational awareness is achieved through a Simrad WM-4 Sirius Marine Weather receiver and a Simrad HALO radar mounted with a 48-inch open array antenna. Security and onboard connectivity are enhanced by a theft deterrent system with remote, the Whaler Watch® connectivity system, Starlink internet, plus Sirius marine weather and music. Maneuvering precision is delivered by Mercury Joystick piloting control, and added convenience comes from a remote-operated powered VHF antenna and mast light, both controllable through the multifunction displays.

Stereo system

Integrated with the Simrad navigation package, the JL Audio entertainment system transforms every cruise with pristine, concert hall fidelity. Centered at the helm is a JL Audio MM105-HR receiver, accompanied by a dash-mounted remote that delivers convenient volume and mute control and supporting AM/FM/HD Radio, USB audio playback and Sirius XM™ readiness. iPhone and Android devices pair effortlessly via Bluetooth 5.0, while a JL Audio MMR-40 stereo remote at the bow places intuitive command within reach forward. The

sound system is built around eight JL Audio waterproof speakers, two 10-inch subwoofers and two dedicated amplifiers—one rated at 600W and the other at 800W—providing authoritative low end and pristine dynamics. Belowdecks, a JL Audio MMR-40 remote governs four 6.5-inch JL Audio cabin speakers to produce an immersive, richly detailed audio environment throughout the interior.

Notable options and accessories

Power is supplied by triple 600 hp V12 Mercury Verado outboards fitted with Joystick Piloting, while a Seakeeper gyroscopic stabilizer provides serene steadiness at rest and a 6kW 24v bow thruster with its own dedicated battery bank and charging system enables precise low speed control. Extended autonomy comes courtesy of a Yacht Mate watermaker, and protective PPF film has been applied to the hull, engines and arch. Six blue LED underwater lights—three transom mounted and three bottom mounted to the hull—create a dramatic night time presence, and offshore capability is enhanced with premium Gemlux outriggers. Onboard entertainment is delivered through a premium JL Audio package, and the teak exterior detail package, including matching tables and accents, brings timeless warmth to the exterior. Shade and enclosure options are comprehensive, with a manual bow sunshade that attaches to the hardtop via four forward poles, an electric rear sunshade and full hardtop enclosure curtains, while the summer kitchen option expands alfresco versatility and two 12 V receptacles at the transom are provided for electric reels or downriggers. A built in automatic engine flushing system simplifies after run care, and thoughtful provisions include a Boston Whaler dishware set with dedicated storage, six dive tank holders, six stainless steel pull out flush mounted fender clips and a First Mate Safety & Security FOB Kit with additional man overboard FOBs for extra passengers. Practical storage and refrigeration are addressed with a hardtop roof rack and

port and starboard fishboxes cooled by a Refrigeration Frostbox chiller system (120v 60Hz), and a starboard side fiberglass cockpit foldout bench seat replaces under gunnel rod holders and one gunnel rod holder to maximize comfort without sacrificing deck utility.

Deck / cockpit

Throughout the deck and cockpit, all fittings and railwork are executed in 316L stainless steel, providing both enduring strength and a highly polished aesthetic. Ten-inch stainless steel pull-up cleats are strategically positioned—two at the bow, two dedicated to spring lines and two crosstie cleats at the transom—augmented by additional ten-inch stainless cleats including two in the stern cockpit set alongside a gunnel board hawse pipe and one at the anchor locker. A generous 28-inch interior freeboard contributes to a secure, comfortable on-deck experience, while access is effortless via an acrylic transom door secured with a stainless steel latch, an integrated transom boarding ladder and a molded fiberglass portside boarding and dive door that houses a removable stainless steel dive ladder and its own storage. Forward, a heavy-duty polished stainless steel bow tow eye is fitted for towing and mooring duties, and the hull is protected by a heavy-duty black rub rail with a stainless steel insert. Atmosphere and safety are enhanced by blue LED courtesy lighting in the cockpit, and anglers will appreciate the pressurized, insulated 24 gallon livewell in the aft port corner, complete with a clear lid, blue interior and red and white LED illumination. Ample rod storage is provided by gunwale-mounted holders—four at the bow, four at the aft cockpit starboard side, two to port—supplemented by three transom-mounted holders and three beneath the gunnel. A self-bailing cockpit sole helps keep the deck dry and confident in all conditions, and anchoring is managed by a windlass with a 400-foot rode and chain operated by handheld remote, a stainless steel swivel and a polished stainless steel 44-pound anchor.

Helm console

Take command with assurance from the center helm layout, where two A/C vents keep the captain cool and a prominent compass provides precise heading while a sculpted dash visor minimizes glare for unobstructed visibility. Ergonomic touches benefit both helm positions, including a portside passenger fold-down footrest and a console-molded footrest that incorporates a fold-down standing platform finished in a maintenance-free, antifatigue synthetic surface for enduring comfort. Intuitive control is delivered through an electrical switch panel outfitted with stainless-steel switches and illuminated text, paired with Mercury DTS dual binnacle controls that include integrated engine trim controls for seamless throttle and trim response. Starting is effortless thanks to remote ignition key switches in the cabin and a push-button start/stop at the helm. Visibility remains pristine with a windshield defogger featuring remote shutoff control and wipers to port and starboard, complemented by a second compass and an additional dash visor that further enhance clarity. Practicality and security are assured by a lockable acrylic sliding entry door and a lockable glovebox housing 12 V receptacles and a USB charging port, while thoughtful storage solutions — a recessed compartment atop the dash and dedicated storage in the starboard coaming pocket with a dual USB receptacle — keep every device and essential conveniently at hand.

Open windshield hardtop system

A bespoke powder-coated frame, seamlessly integrated into the deck, creates unobstructed walkways and is finished in either white or black to coordinate with your chosen frame color. Above the helm a locking-latch electronics box keeps vital gear secure, while a port-side ladder built into the hardtop frame provides easy, intuitive access. Lighting has been carefully considered to enhance ambiance and safety, with LED overhead blue lighting, an LED

overhead courtesy/chart light with selectable red and white modes, a single LED bow floodlight, two LED cockpit floodlights and full LED navigation lights. The enclosure balances shelter and openness with open tempered side glass complemented by an upper removable rigid acrylic canvas curtain, and six rod holders are neatly incorporated into the hardtop supports. For shade on warm days, a cockpit sunshade travels on a telescoping polished stainless-steel frame that deploys and retracts electrically. Forward, the helm is protected by a full height windshield in tempered glass that features an electrically actuated center vent, inviting a refreshing breeze at the touch of a switch.

Seating exterior

A discreet foldaway stern bench seat stows away to free the cockpit whenever desired, while the forward console lounge indulges guests with fold-down armrests, four dedicated drink holders, supportive sculpted backrests and a removable cushion. At the forward tip of this lounge a clever flip-up backrest converts the area into true wraparound seating. Forward port and starboard seats are fitted with folding backrests and four drink holders, with a conveniently placed stereo remote and a 12 V receptacle on the port side. The helm is outfitted with three bolster-style helm and companion seats that include fold-down armrests; the center seat is electrically actuated and the port and starboard chairs rotate to face aft for socializing.

Cabin interior

Enter a beautifully appointed cabin where contemporary conveniences are married to refined comfort, beginning with a 32" Samsung QLED 4K Smart TV and a comprehensive digital control suite that includes an iPad housed in an inductive charging case running the C Zone app to monitor systems and operate DC circuits. Electrical access is effortless with a 120 V receptacle on

the port side and 12 V USB charging ports positioned on both port and starboard, while safety and climate control are handled by a carbon monoxide detector and a 12K BTU air conditioner that keeps the atmosphere perfectly tempered. Natural illumination streams through console side windows with two opening port lights and shades, hull side windows with shades, and a skylight equipped with an integrated shade system, and after dark a layered lighting design creates ambiance with LED diffused blue courtesy lights, LED diffused white overhead fixtures, and two dedicated LED reading lights. Exquisite materials and careful workmanship are evident throughout, from the hardwood cabin sole and the elite interior color package to easy to clean finishes that preserve the salon's pristine appearance. Seating and sleeping options are flexible and luxurious: a convertible pullout settee and a convertible double berth with a filler cushion furnished with a fitted sheet, comforter, and two regular size pillowcases, while a wood table lowers to support the filler cushion for the forward double berth and three throw pillows complete the inviting scheme. Practical storage is equally considered with a hanging locker, rod storage for four, and a central vacuum system with hose and attachments housed in dedicated storage.

Galley

Designed for effortless life on the water, the galley features both 120-V and 12-V receptacles to power appliances and charge essentials, while a polished stainless-steel handrail provides secure support underway. A built-in microwave and a stainless-steel refrigerator/freezer that operates on 12-V/120-V with 1.7 cubic feet of capacity deliver dependable culinary performance. Cleverly arranged storage includes a pullout drawer beneath the sink for dishes, an overhead cabinet with dedicated dish space and a discreet pullout waste receptacle for easy cleanup. The sink sits beneath a refined faucet on a luxurious solid-surface countertop, and a matching solid-surface

sink filler with an integrated cutting board expands your food-preparation area while maintaining the galley's seamless aesthetic.

Enclosed head compartment

Enter an artfully finished head where solid-surface tile underfoot provides a polished foundation, and an enclosed shower with a rain shower head and hot-and-cold faucet offers a spa-like experience while a shower curtain protects the vanity area. The electric Vacu-Flush® toilet is complemented by a holding tank fitted with a vent filter, overboard discharge and dockside pump-out, as well as a clear tank level indicator for effortless oversight. LED overhead lighting and an opening portlight bathe the space in soft light and fresh air, while the vanity—appointed with a sink, polished chrome faucet and backlit mirror—delivers both style and function; a solid-surface pullout countertop located forward of the vanity adds convenient workspace. A full-length mirror visually expands the cabin, and a dedicated shower sump keeps the compartment dry and comfortable.

Mechanical

Crafted for confidence and effortless operation, the mechanical package begins with an ACR spotlight and an advanced battery management system that incorporates in-cabin electric switches and charging relays with remote paralleling for seamless power control. Climate comfort is delivered by reverse-cycle air conditioning—a 12,000 BTU cabin unit and a reverse-cycle 18,000 BTU helm deck unit—while electrical resilience is provided by GR31 AGM batteries secured in dedicated trays, twin 30-amp shore power inlets that feed battery chargers and isolation transformers, and 50' shore power cords; a dockside cable TV inlet and a designated dual sounder transducer mount area round out the ship-to-shore connectivity. Safety and performance are

paramount, with a high-water bilge pump with alarm rated at 2000 GPH, automatic bilge pumps rated at 1100 GPH forward and 2000 GPH aft, electric trim tabs with indicator, four engine fuel/water separators, and robust stainless steel propellers. Underwater integrity is ensured by a bonding system protecting through-hull fittings, cast bronze thru-hulls below the waterline and cast stainless steel thru-hulls above the waterline. The freshwater and utility arrangements are comprehensive and thoughtfully placed: a freshwater anchor washdown with integrated coiled hose system; a hot-and-cold freshwater system with dockside hookup and a tank level indicator integrated into Vessel View; a pullout hot-and-cold transom shower; a 60-gallon freshwater tank; a hot-and-cold retractable freshwater washdown hose reel at mid-ship and a raw-water washdown with retractable hose reel at mid-ship. Long-range capability is supported by dual 300-gallon aluminum fuel tanks linked by a manifold plumbing system with an individual valve for each circuit, while LED lighting in the cockpit and machinery spaces improves visibility. Completing the mechanical specification are an electric dual trumpet horn and an onboard water heater, delivering comfort and dependability in every condition.

Summer kitchen

Meticulously designed for effortless entertaining, the summer kitchen features a solid-surface countertop that incorporates an integrated cutting board and an electric grill beneath a hinged solid-surface lid that, when closed, provides generous additional workspace. A freshwater sink equipped with hot and cold water complements a 120-V outlet and a pump switch panel that includes a 12-V outlet to keep small appliances and systems running smoothly. Flanking the station to port and starboard are twin stainless-steel drawer refrigerators that can be powered by either 12-V or 120-V systems, each delivering 2.3 cubic feet of chilled storage. LED task lighting bathes the entire prep area in clear,

flattering light, while the forward face of the prep station is fitted with a leaning-post cushion that quickly converts into a comfortable three-person bench, creating a true second row of seating. Thoughtful storage solutions abound, with a central drawer module replacing the livewell and a dedicated storage lid equipped with tool holders, storage nets, and leader holders to keep gear organized and accessible.

Hardtop canvas aft enclosure

The helm deck is fully enclosed in Black Stamoid® with rigid Makrolon® panels, offering uncompromising protection while preserving an elegant, open feel. Crystal-clear polycarbonate glazing maintains uninterrupted sightlines, and forward wing curtains with adjoining side panels seal the helm against wind and spray. Aft, full-beam panels wrap around the second-row seating to form a secure, weatherproof retreat. When you prefer open air, a purpose-designed storage bag and a protective mesh bag keep the complete enclosure meticulously packed and protected for stowage.

Teak detail package exterior

Every exposed surface benefits from an elevated teak treatment in this exterior detail package, which includes a teak bow table and an array of high-gloss teak appointments: helm seat backs and armrests finished in high gloss, a high-gloss teak second-row bench seat back, high-gloss teak tow rail shelves integrated into the cockpit and a high-gloss teak helm. Footrest covers at both the helm and the second-row seating are crafted from high-gloss teak with a slip-resistant texture for secure footing, and the bow area is refined with high-gloss teak covers for the cup holders alongside the teak bow table, which is also offered with a high-gloss teak finish.

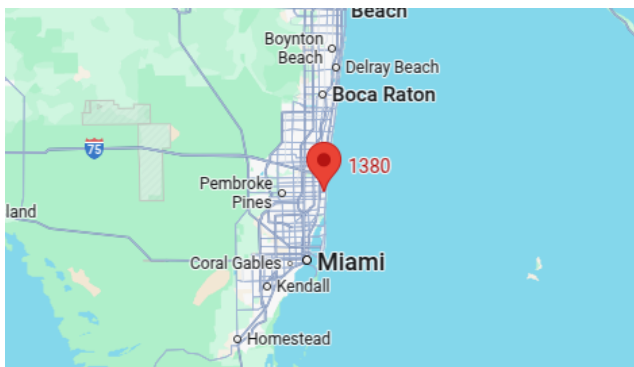
