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OVERVIEW

Presenting the 1989 Ocean Alexander 42, an aft-cabin motor yacht that unites refined styling with practical seakeeping. Measuring 42.25 feet overall and constructed in stout fiberglass, her semi-displacement hull is designed to deliver a composed, efficient ride. Power comes from twin G.M. 8.2 T diesel engines, each rated at 250 hp, driving an inboard direct-drive system that provides sure-footed handling; with roughly 2,400 hours on the engines, the Sheridan Eagle remains ready for new voyages. Interior arrangements are thoughtfully conceived, offering two generous staterooms and two heads to accommodate family and guests in comfort, while an electric windlass makes anchoring effortless and elegant. More than simply a boat, the Ocean Alexander 42 is a vessel for memorable moments afloat, blending handcrafted luxury with everyday utility.

Recent upgrades have enhanced both reliability and onboard electronics, including electrical system refinements and navigation improvements centered on a newer 15-inch multifunction flat-screen that supports AIS and depth sounder readouts, together with radar and chart plotting capability. Be sure to inquire about the famously appreciated “marriage-saving” remote for the Sidepower bow thruster.

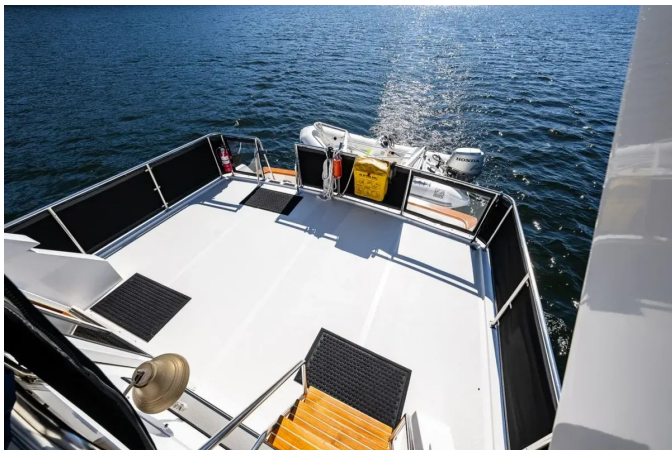


















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Additional information—annual services and updates

Engines and generators receive professional servicing every 100 hours, while the exterior benefits from an annual machine-applied wax and meticulous washes on a three-week schedule throughout the year. A marine electrician conducted an exhaustive systems overhaul and inspection to bring the vessel up to current standards. The hull received new bottom paint and replacement anodes in 2023, and routine dive inspections are carried out annually, with the most recent survey in 2025 confirming the hull and appendages are in very good condition. Maneuvering is assisted by a Sidepower bow thruster with wireless remote controls, and navigation and bridge systems have been modernized with an updated Furuno TZT15F multifunction display networked to the Simrad autopilot, plus a Standard Horizon VHF radio with integrated AIS displayed on the MFD. The Vacuum Flush toilets have been recently rebuilt. For much of her life, when not underway the yacht has been kept in fresh water in a covered slip. All canvas has been renewed, the flybridge windows are fitted with crystal-clear Eisenglass, and the forward windows were removed, resealed and refitted as part of routine maintenance.

Galley

Designed for effortless living and refined entertaining, the galley is fitted with a Whirlpool in-cabinet microwave oven, an electric cooktop paired with an oven and a Norcold refrigerator and freezer, while a U-Line ice maker discreetly serves the saloon. A double stainless-steel sink with a new hot-and-cold water spigot streamlines preparation and cleanup. The atrium-style layout floods the

space with natural light and generous headroom, and an opening portlight provides welcome additional ventilation.

Accommodations - primary

Situated aft, the primary stateroom is anchored by a queen-sized bed and enveloped in wraparound built-in cabinetry, with a series of generous drawers to neatly house clothing and extra blankets for you and your guests. A private head with an enclosed shower provides discreet comfort and convenience, while a spacious closet crafted from hand-made teak delivers substantial wardrobe capacity. A discreet pull-out seat completes the suite, converting effortlessly into a desk or dressing table for added versatility.

Accommodations-vip

The forward stateroom unfolds as a gracious private retreat, appointed with an additional queen-sized berth and a dedicated second head with an enclosed shower to provide guests with both convenience and discreet comfort. Generous storage combined with large portlights floods the cabin with natural light and amplifies the sense of volume, making this stateroom exceptionally comfortable.

Dinghy & davit

Meticulously appointed for both convenience and safety, the tender package is anchored by a 2002 Zodiac inflatable featuring a fiberglass hard bottom and driven by a 40 HP Honda four-stroke outboard, providing reliable and whisper-quiet propulsion. A Roskelly dinghy lift secures the tender clear of the wake while improving aft visibility, and its operation is remarkably simple thanks to an electric winch that smoothly raises and lowers the dinghy to and

from the water. The arrangement is finished with a bespoke cover tailored for the tender and a Life sling equipped with a water light, offering added protection and peace of mind whether underway or at anchor.

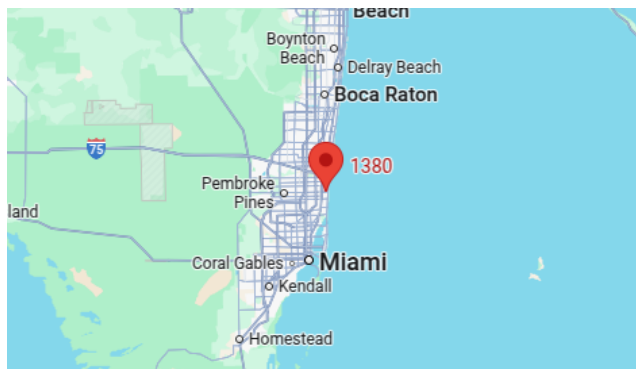
