Easy to handle single-handed yet generous enough to host a lively group, she boasts a broad beam for confident stability, abundant seating and bespoke layout options designed to accommodate everything from sport fishing and scuba diving to extended day cruising. Renowned for stout craftsmanship, the model pairs a twin-step running surface with lightweight, advanced-composite construction methods to yield a refined balance of speed, agility and comfort. With an open-deck footprint and thoughtfully devised ergonomics, she provides discerning owners a capable, roomy platform that embodies premium dayboat versatility on every voyage.

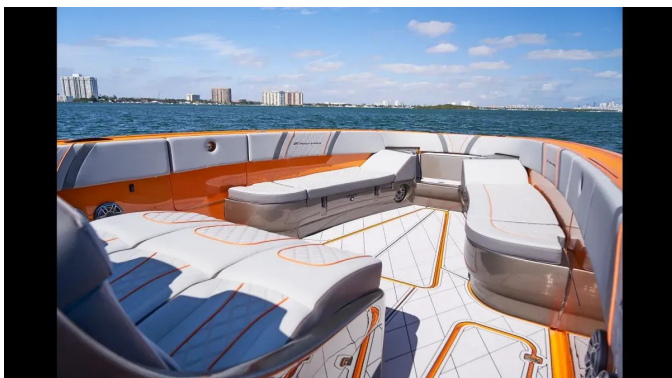

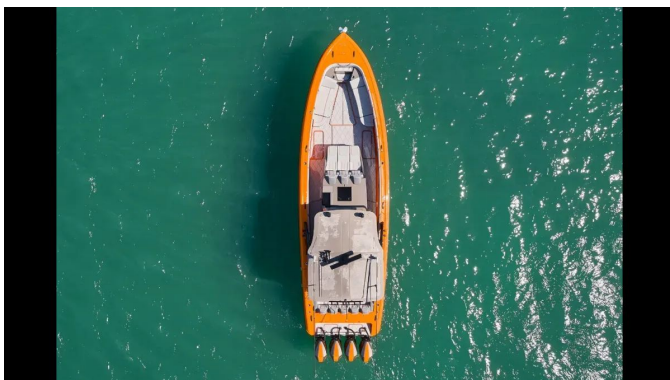

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull and top

A bespoke gelcoat hull hue establishes the yacht's presence, with every antenna on the hardtop color-matched to the vessel and a painted pinstripe tracing the hardtop's perimeter for a polished accent; the quartet of 450's receive a two-tone finish and are highlighted by four vinyl motor decals, while the hullside and deck are painstakingly painted from rubrail to sole, including all deck hatch openings, ensuring even the smallest components — the hardtop itself included — present a seamless, integrated appearance. Designed for serious angling without compromising refinement, 15' Tigress telescopic outriggers are mounted in the hardtop, supported further by a pair of aft-mounted outrigger supports and accompanied by a six-rod holder rack on the hardtop. Appointments are elevated with black anodized Euro-style cleats and fill caps, and an extended hardtop adds comfort and convenience with a freshwater shower positioned at the stern. Luxurious upgraded upholstery introduces supportive headrests and refined cross-stitch detailing, while foam decking throughout the cockpit, console and transom well, available in a choice of colors, completes the sophisticated aesthetic.

Console interior

Sumptuously appointed for comfort and convenience, the console interior features a 5,000 BTU reverse cycle air conditioning unit to ensure year round comfort and a 5.0 kW gas generator that supplies independent onboard power, with its remote start panel thoughtfully positioned within the cabin. An integrated 110V distribution panel is also installed and is required whenever additional 110V appliances or a generator are added.

Electronics

At the helm a flush-mounted Garmin 8622 chartplotter anchors a sophisticated navigation suite, accompanied by a depthsounder built around the GSD24 module and a 1 kW transducer installed in-hull. A 4 kW HD open-array radar is fully integrated into the Garmin network, while a FLIR thermal system affords roughly 240 degrees of observational coverage for superior situational awareness. Sub-surface visibility is extended by an underwater camera, and precise course holding is delivered by the Garmin AutoPilot GHP20 equipped with a SmartPump. The carbon-fiber dash reinforces the yacht's performance character, finished with an LED spotlight mounted on the hardtop and operated from a remote point pad on the dash. Entertainment is exceptional: a premium JL sound system fills the cockpit with ten speakers and four 10-inch subwoofers driven by four amplifiers, supported by an MP3 player dock, an AV650 DVD player and Sirius radio (subscription required), all controllable through the Garmin display; Bluetooth streaming and two additional speakers in the cabin bring the audio experience indoors, while a pair of Bazooka speakers on the hardtop further enhance the outdoor soundstage. Practical refinements include a glovebox in the dash, additional switches arranged for the 43-44 configuration and a separate glovebox housing the key switch. A trumpet air horn provides an authoritative signal, stainless-steel cupholders have been upgraded to LED-lit holders with a total of seventeen throughout, and three transom-mounted underwater LED lights offer striking blue/white illumination after dark.

Forward

A sculpted fiberglass U-seat forms a graceful social enclave, inviting guests to gather in comfort, while an electrically actuated fiberglass table elevates seamlessly for formal dining, converts the seating into a generous sunpad and

then lowers to sit perfectly flush with the floor under single button control.

Miscellaneous

The foredeck is appointed with a Quick Anchor windlass that handles a 300-foot line and a 10-foot galvanized chain terminating in a 33 lb polished stainless-steel anchor, all guided through a bespoke polished stainless-steel anchor roller assembly with a remote control conveniently mounted at the dash. Precision maneuvering is provided by an 80 kg bow thruster engaged via a rocker switch at the helm, and a Seakeeper 6 has been fitted to deliver exceptional stability and onboard comfort whether underway or at rest.
