OVERVIEW

A 43-foot performance sport yacht conceived for the Aegean and beyond, she was built in 2018 and registered as a 2021 model, currently moored in Greece and ready for sunlit island-hopping. Her keen, deep V hull fashioned from robust fiberglass pairs with a clean fiberglass deck to offer a dry, assured ride; she cuts through open seas with composure and settles with equal grace at anchor. With an 11-foot beam for steady stability and a remarkably shallow draft of about 2.6 feet, this yacht grants access to sheltered coves and crystalline beaches that larger, deeper craft must forgo.

Power comes from triple Mercury outboards, a straightforward petrol-driven arrangement that yields a comfortable fast cruise of approximately 32 knots and the ability to sprint up to 55 knots when the moment calls for it. Outboard simplicity and dependable petrol propulsion are matched by a generous 301-gallon fuel capacity, delivering the range to pursue ambitious day runs or extended coastal weekends. Freshwater needs for day outings are accommodated by a 26-gallon tank, and a neatly appointed enclosed head ensures onboard comfort from morning swims through evening returns.

On deck the layout prioritizes sociable, open-air living, keeping the sea in constant view. Broad, uncluttered walkways and secure sightlines lead to an intuitive helm that inspires confidence whether threading island passages or charging offshore. The deep V geometry rewards an engaged driver with precise handling, while the wide beam creates an inviting platform for relaxed conversation, casual dining and sunlit lounging. Surfaces throughout are designed to be both elegant to the touch and easy to maintain, so the boat appears as polished on Monday as she was on Saturday.

Equally suited as a chic Mediterranean weekender or as a capable companion to larger superyachts, this versatile 43 epitomizes do it all elegance: swift, shallow draft, seaworthy and beautifully balanced. It represents an ideal

choice for owners who desire high performance without surrendering refinement, a blend that elevates routine passages into memorable voyages. Poised at the intersection of several coveted categories—sport yacht, performance cruiser, center console, open yacht, express cruiser, dayboat, chase boat and luxury tender—this 43 stands as a compelling statement of style and speed, tailored for life on sparkling blue water.



















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Ribco Venom 44 "JEMAB"

"JEMAB" is a true machine built to explore the seas: the Venom 44 from Ribco is an athletic, long range RIB whose stepped deep V hull delivers composed, efficient performance. She cruises comfortably at around 35 knots and sprints to 55 knots, propelled by three Mercury 300 hp engines that provide both reassuring acceleration and economical cruise ability. Laden with extras and meticulously maintained by her captain, she is equally at home as a refined chase tender or as the centerpiece for long, carefree days on the water with family and friends. Thoughtful detailing abounds: beneath the generous sunpads she cleverly sleeps four — two under the stern sunbed and two under the bow — while a WC is discreetly housed inside the console. The deep V geometry inspires confidence, ensuring safe, high speed running in all conditions, and when she is off the water she is stored in covered parking, preserving her immaculate condition. The result is an exceptionally well kept Venom 44 that blends thrilling pace, practical versatility and the go anywhere spirit that defines Ribco.
