OVERVIEW

This recent trade is the sole 405 Conquest outfitted with the coveted quad Mercury V10 400s, backed by MERCURY PLATINUM WARRANTY THROUGH 11/14/2031, where low hours combine with Seakeeper gyro stabilization for unparalleled offshore comfort; HullMaxx clear bottom paint preserves the underwater finish, while Starlink and FLIR-equipped cameras ensure connectivity and situational awareness, complemented by twin Simrads at the helm and a 24/26-inch Simrad opposite. A Diesel Panda generator (192 hrs), a summer galley with refrigerator, rosewood interior, hardtop with sunroof, engine flushing system, and canvas covers complete this offshore walkaround — an express cruiser and sportfishing cabin cruiser of refined capability.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Broker description

Trades are welcome, with flexible financing and nationwide transport available to make ownership effortless. This fresh trade-in stands apart as the only 405 Conquest equipped with the preferred quad V10 400 Mercury outboards, all covered by Mercury Platinum warranty through 11/14/2031, pairing exhilarating performance with long-horizon peace of mind. Low engine hours and active warranty coverage underscore its pedigree, while Seakeeper gyro stabilization delivers remarkable poise at rest and underway. Efficiency and ease of upkeep are elevated by HullMaxx clear bottom coating, and always connected cruising comes courtesy of Starlink. A comprehensive camera suite with FLIR thermal imaging enhances situational awareness day and night, and navigation is intuitive with twin Simrad displays at the helm complemented by a single 24/26-inch Simrad opposite the helm. Power needs are met by a Panda diesel generator showing 192 hours, and entertaining is a pleasure with a summer kitchen complete with refrigerator beneath a hardtop crowned by a sunroof. The Rosewood Interior Package enriches the cabin with warmth and sophistication, while an engine flushing system and a full canvas cover package simplify care and protection between adventures.

Additional descriptions

Thoughtful comforts begin belowdecks with a 120 V receptacle and air conditioning vents from the main cabin served by a 16,000 BTU unit, ensuring balanced climate control. Safety and craftsmanship are evident in the carbon monoxide detector and in the solid teak flooring and entry steps with a satin finish. Illumination is both functional and atmospheric, with two LED reading lights, diffused LED RGB courtesy lighting on a dimmer, and LED white

overhead lights with dimmer switches—one in the main area and two over the bed. Rest comes easy on a six inch thick Premium Handcraft pillowtop innerspring mattress with a hinged panel granting access to storage, complemented by a privacy curtain for quiet retreat. Intelligent stowage abounds: a cedar lined hanging locker with removable shelves and a galley dish storage area activated by a door switch light, plus a large compartment beneath the mattress accessed via a powered hatch that opens to storage drawers and a substantial molded in fiberglass trunk. Powering devices is simple with a Vimar single USB receptacle, and the mid berth is presented ready for use with a fitted sheet, a comforter, and two regular size pillowcases.

On deck, hardware and layout are tailored for both sport and serenity. The stern cockpit features two ten inch stainless steel cleats with gunwale hawse pipes and, forward, the anchor locker carries one ten inch cleat; at the bow two ten inch stainless steel pull up cleats are joined by two for spring lines and two crosstie cleats at the transom. The interior freeboard measures 27 inches for reassuring depth, and movement around the boat is eased by an acrylic transom door secured with a stainless latch. Anchoring is authoritative with a windlass feeding 400 feet of rode and chain, operated by a handheld remote, linked via a stainless swivel to a polished stainless 44 lb anchor resting on a polished stainless bow roller davit. A transom boarding ladder simplifies water access, while a heavy duty polished stainless bow eye and a chrome Boston Whaler logo/model designator affirm pedigree. Coaming bolsters add comfort, and the molded portside dive door with removable stainless steel dive ladder—stowed neatly within the stern seat—makes side boarding and water entry effortless. Refreshment is always at hand with stainless drink holders arrayed thoughtfully: four in the bow, two in the hawse pipes, two at the helm, two at the port console, two at the port lounge, and two per side in recessed pockets beside the aft helm deck seats. After dark, multicolor LED courtesy lighting sets the mood, and anglers will appreciate the

pressurized, insulated 19 gallon livewell in the aft port corner, complete with a clear lid, a blue interior, and dual white LED lights. Secure handholds abound with welded stainless steel rails in the companionway to the helm deck and into the cabin, along the boarding ladders, and at the prep station; high welded stainless bow rails, a white rub rail with stainless insert of heavy duty specification, and stainless toe rails in the cockpit with an under gunwale storage shelf that includes downrigger weight holders—one per side—underline the boat's capability. Rod storage is comprehensive, with gunnel mounted holders comprising three to starboard in the aft cockpit and two to port, five mounted across the transom, and two more under the starboard gunwale. A self bailing cockpit sole keeps the deck clear, and freshwater showers with hot and cold mixing are placed both near the dive door and near the transom door. For precise nighttime navigation, an ACR RCL 75 spotlight crowns the hardtop. The enclosed head is a private, refined retreat, with a 120 V receptacle at the vanity and dual access from both the cabin and the master stateroom. Flooring blends practicality and luxury with solid surface material in the shower and satin finished solid teak in the vanity area. Two LED overhead lights on a dimmer pair with LED RGB courtesy lighting on its own dimmer to set the perfect ambiance. A full length mirror mounted on the acrylic stateroom access door, an opening portlight, and a stainless handrail add convenience and safety. The shower is fully enclosed, fitted with a rain head and a handheld sprayer, hot and cold faucet control, and a bi fold acrylic divider, all draining through a dedicated shower sump, while a frosted glass skylight brings in gentle daylight. Practical touches include a toilet paper holder inside the vanity, a towel ring and bar, and a counter integrated trash chute. The Vacu Flush electric toilet connects to a holding tank with a vent filter, supports overboard discharge and dockside pump out, and provides a tank full indicator alert with progressive tank level indication integrated into the digital network. Ample vanity storage and a

ceramic vessel sink with a polished chrome faucet complete the space, which is kept fresh by forced air ventilation. Culinary duties are a pleasure in a galley designed for voyages large and small. A 120 V receptacle supports appliances, while an overhead cabinet neatly houses the AC and DC vessel system controls. Storage is generous, with spaces behind the sink for galley provisions and a dedicated dish cabinet, all framed by satin finished teak cabinetry with maple lining both under the counter and over the galley. Cooking is handled by a single cooktop burner set into a solid surface countertop with an undermount sink and sleek faucet. Mood and task lighting are optimized with LED RGB courtesy lighting beneath the overhead cabinet and along the countertop on a dimmer, paired with one LED white overhead light. A microwave is integrated into the overhead cabinet, and a pullout waste receptacle tucks discreetly beneath the counter. A stainless steel handrail assures security underway, while a stainless 12 V/120 V refrigerator/freezer drawer of 3.0 cubic feet (CR85) preserves perishables. Thoughtful details include a matching solid surface sink filler with an integral cutting board and six illuminated wine glass holders tucked beneath the cabinet.

At the helm

console, the same emphasis on convenience and organization shines through, with a 120 V receptacle, an overhead cabinet containing the AC and DC vessel system controls, and additional storage behind the sink and for dishes.

Satin finished teak cabinets with maple lining are located under the counter and above, and a single cooktop burner and a solid surface countertop with an undermount sink and faucet support refreshments on the helm deck.

Lighting mirrors the galley specification, featuring LED RGB courtesy lighting beneath the overhead cabinet and along the countertop with dimmer control, complemented by one LED white overhead light. A microwave is set into the overhead cabinet, a pullout waste receptacle is positioned under the counter, and a stainless handrail ensures secure footing. Cold storage is delivered by a

stainless 12 V/120 V refrigerator/freezer drawer of 3.0 cubic feet, model CR85, while a matching solid surface sink filler with integral cutting board and six illuminated under cabinet wine glass holders complete this well appointed helm deck service area.

The master stateroom offers true retreat, with 120 V receptacles to port and starboard and an 8,000 BTU reverse cycle air conditioner with LCD control. The island bed provides trunk style front storage access via a gas assist hatch and features an eight inch thick Premium Handcraft pillowtop innerspring mattress with an electrically actuated hinged backrest; linens include a fitted sheet, a comforter, and two regular size pillowcases. Overhead cabinets to port and starboard with flip up doors expand storage, while carbon monoxide and smoke detectors enhance safety. A sliding pocket door separates the stateroom from the salon, and the satin finished solid teak flooring and entry steps carry the yacht's premium aesthetic forward. Lighting is abundant and versatile, with four LED overhead fixtures, two LED overhead reading lights, and LED RGB diffused courtesy lighting on a dimmer. An opening hatch invites sea breezes, and service access is thoughtfully provided to the A/C unit through the forward bulkhead and to the bow thruster through the floor. Storage solutions include a cedar lined hanging locker with a door activated light on the starboard side and a cedar lined locker with shelves and a door activated light on the port side. Entertainment and housekeeping are equally well addressed by a 24 inch flat screen HDTV with Apple TV integration and a Dyson V7 handheld vacuum with charging holder. Controls are intuitive with a Vimar overhead light switch on the starboard nightstand and Vimar single USB receptacles on both port and starboard nightstands, while hull side windows with pull down pleated shades offer privacy on demand.

Underpinning the entire build, all hardware is 316 L stainless steel and every rail is welded 316 L stainless steel, while a vinyl ester barrier coat is applied over the entire hull and hull sides for

long term structural integrity and finish protection.


