## OVERVIEW

Easy to view in Fort Lauderdale, FL (Lauderdale-by-the-Sea).

This 2009 Intrepid 430 artfully combines the sleek presence of a sport yacht with the functionality of an express cruiser, wrapped in custom-grade appointments throughout. Her motion across the water is whisper-quiet, controlled, and remarkably composed, inspiring genuine confidence offshore. The helm is appointed with dual Garmin navigation displays complete with radar and integrated mapping, supplemented by an ACR searchlight and a bow thruster among other high-end conveniences that refine every passage. Propulsion comes from triple Yamaha 350s with just 790 hours, offering effortless power and extended cruising capability. True to Intrepid's pedigree, she sits on a fully cored, stepped hull designed and engineered to produce speed, nimble handling, and exceptional stability, making her equally adept as a performance-focused cruiser or an elegant weekender.

The upgrades are numerous and best judged in person—step aboard once, and you'll want to own her.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Description

---

Easy to inspect in Fort Lauderdale, Florida (Lauderdale-by-the-Sea), this 2009 Intrepid 430 is a multipurpose sport yacht that marries sleek styling with the luxury-class amenities of a custom build. Her fully cored stepped hull is engineered for speed, delivering a notably smooth, stable ride across changing sea states. At the helm, dual Garmin electronics with radar and mapping are paired with an ACR remote spotlight and a bow thruster to make close-quarters handling effortless. Power comes from triple Yamaha 350s showing 790 hours, a proven performance package that underscores the brand's pedigree. Like so many Intrepid models, the result is a fast, confident, impeccably finished platform that has benefitted from numerous upgrades—the kind of yacht that sells itself the moment you step aboard.

## Below deck and accommodations

---

Below deck, a forward queen berth offers a serene retreat, while a portside settee converts to a single berth to welcome an additional guest. A bright aft cabin with windows and a TV extends the living space, all set over a classic teak-and-holly floor. The head features a separate stall shower and a teak-and-holly sole, with cedar-lined closets adding both luxury and practicality. The galley integrates seamlessly into the layout with its TV, microwave, sink, and durable Mystera countertops, creating a refined environment for extended weekends or spontaneous overnights.

## Decks and equipment

---

On deck, new enclosure panels and a fresh Sea Deck surface elevate comfort

and style, joined by a new cockpit refrigerator to keep provisions perfectly chilled. A hullside dive door simplifies water access, while a custom electric lounge-extension sun pad in the cockpit transforms relaxation at the touch of a button. The half tower carries a fiberglass top with a custom Bomar hatch, and its aluminum framework is powder-coated in white for a crisp, enduring finish. The spectacle continues after dark with six underwater lights and an additional four underwater lights that bathe the hull in a dramatic glow. A bow sunpad invites lingering at anchor, cushioned cockpit coaming bolsters enhance security and comfort, and dedicated cockpit lights set the mood. A glass windshield with a stainless-steel frame keeps the helm quiet and dry, and a cockpit table shifts between two mounts—one aft in the cockpit and another in the cabin—while a removable rear bench seat maximizes flexibility. Custom window tinting on the hullside windows completes the tailored look.

## Electronics

---

The helm suite is comprehensively equipped with two GPS/Plotter/Radar/sounder units presented on two Garmin 7616 displays, sharpened by a 1000-watt oil box 50/200 kHz Raymarine transducer for the color sounder and a Garmin dome radar for crisp targets. A Raymarine satellite weather interface keeps you ahead of changing conditions, while a Garmin autopilot eases long runs. Night operations are enhanced by an ACR RCL 100 dual-lamp remote spotlight and the FLIR Navigator II thermal imaging system. Communications and entertainment are equally robust with an Icom M604 VHF with remote RAM mic, a Fusion stereo unit driving JL Audio speakers and amp, Satellite TV supported by a TrackVision Marine SAT TV receiver system, and the reassurance of an onboard Security Siren System.

## Mechanical

---

Performance and control are anchored by triple 350 hp Yamaha four-stroke engines, supported by a custom engine flush system that simplifies care after each run. Bennet trim tabs with auto retract and trim indicators fine-tune running attitude, while Latham power steering delivers confident, fingertip control. A diesel generator and air conditioning extend the season in comfort, and a Vetus bow thruster makes docking intuitive. Ground tackle is handled by a windlass with 300 ft of line and 15 ft of chain, paired to a stainless-steel anchor for reliable holding.

## Propulsion

---

The propulsion package consists of three Yamaha outboard four-stroke engines rated at 350 hp each, gasoline-fueled and showing approximately 900 hours per engine, delivering the punch and reliability that define this model's performance.

## Specifications

---

Designed for speed and range, this Intrepid 430 cruises comfortably at 32 kn and can reach 50 kn when asked. She measures 43 ft length overall, carries a beam of 12.5 ft, and draws a minimum of 2.5 ft, with cabin headroom of 6.33 ft for generous interior volume. Her dry weight is 15,000 lb. The boat is equipped with an electric windlass, features a 21 deg deadrise at the transom, and is constructed in durable fiberglass. Tankage supports extended days aboard with 90 gal of fresh water, 395 gal of fuel, and a 20 gal holding tank. Accommodations are arranged as two guest cabins.


