The Tiara 43 Open is a remarkable blend of luxury and strength, perfect for both cruising and offshore adventures. Its interior is adorned with genuine teak cabinetry, dovetail craftsmanship, and a solid teak and holly floor, exuding elegance. The yacht's layout includes two well-appointed staterooms, featuring a queen pedestal bed with an innerspring mattress in the forward master suite. The guest cabin offers upper and lower bunks, each with comfortable innerspring mattresses. This vessel is fully equipped with factory-installed options (listed below), fishing gear, and is powered by dependable twin Cummins QSM-11 715HP diesel engines, ensuring outstanding performance. This yacht is in pristine condition, with only about 519 hours of use, and was originally commissioned by its first owner in October 2012. The current owner is considering an upgrade to a 52 or 55 Viking Convertible. 

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

This yacht is a marvel of design and opulence, featuring an extensive selection of factory-installed options that boost both its performance and comfort. Among its impressive features is the Upper Cockpit Cool Helm A/C, combined with a robust 32BTU/11.5KW generator, which guarantees a pleasant atmosphere even in the warmest climates. The yacht is fitted with four portlights, a bow thruster for effortless navigation, and a macerator for the waste system, all contributing to a smooth and enjoyable journey on the water. The 30-inch swim platform, complete with a built-in ladder, allows for easy water access, while the teak table in the upper cockpit for the curved companion lounge adds a touch of sophistication. The steering wheel, made from 17.5-inch mahogany, enhances the yacht's elegant design. For those who love to entertain, the wet bar drawer refrigerator, powered by DC, ensures that refreshments are always within reach. The starboard aft prep center tackle drawers and the 50-gallon transom baitwell are perfect for fishing enthusiasts, while the hardtop and Rainier side enclosures provide protection from the elements.

Inside, the salon and galley are exquisitely furnished with satin-finished teak cabinetry, a solid teak and holly floor, a high-gloss varnished dinette, and Ultraleather upholstery. The salon includes optional opening stainless steel port lights, a U-shaped Hi-Lo convertible dinette, and a 32-inch LCD flatscreen TV, paired with a Bose Lifestyle DVD/CD stereo system. The galley features Corian countertops, a stainless steel undermount sink, a two-burner recessed electric cooktop, and a four-drawer refrigerator freezer with an optional icemaker.

The master stateroom provides bi-fold doors from the salon, a private

entrance to the head, and a pedestal queen berth with an innerspring mattress. There is ample storage, with large drawers under the berth, port and starboard upper hillside storage lockers, and a cedar-lined hanging locker. The guest stateroom includes upper and lower bunks with innerspring mattresses, quilts, and pillow shams, along with a hanging locker and an optional flat screen TV with DVD.

The helm and upper cockpit are outfitted with a 32,000 BTU upper cockpit reverse cycle A/C and heat, a Stidd 4-way electric helm seat, and a composite windshield frame with tempered glass. The optional hardtop, attached to the windshield with vents, features a skylight and opening hatch. The helm electronics package includes an optional bow thruster, SmartCraft VesselView displays, Raymarine E120W chart plotters and fish finders, and a 4KW HD digital open array radar.

In the lower cockpit, a large scupper ensures quick drainage, while the transom door and optional bait prep tackle drawers enhance functionality. The cockpit is equipped with combing bolsters, a hot and cold shower, and fresh and raw water washdowns. The optional 30-inch swim platform with a built-in ladder and 50-gallon transom baitwell add to the yacht's versatility.

The deck is equipped with a molded fiberglass bow pulpit, a rope/chain electric windlass, and a one-piece welded stainless steel bow rail. The engine room contains twin Cummins QSM-11 715 HP engines with 619 hours, and an upgraded 11.5KW generator in a sound shield. The electrical system includes 12v DC and 120v/240v AC panels, a 50 amp shore cord with Glendinning reel, and an 80 amp battery charger.

This yacht exemplifies luxury and performance, offering a wide range of optional extras to meet every need, ensuring an unmatched experience on the water.

Manufacturer provided description

The 4300 Open is an extraordinary yacht that honors the legacy of its predecessors while setting the stage for future models in the Open Series. This vessel is crafted to be ready for both fishing and cruising, providing a stable platform for handling challenging sea and weather conditions. Its hull design and power system, featuring twin Cummins QSC 550 or 600 H.P. diesel engines, guarantee top-notch performance, handling, maneuverability, and fuel efficiency.

The upper cockpit, covering 98 square feet, is fitted with a large Stidd electrically adjustable helm seat, offering both comfort and control. A conveniently located wet bar at the rear includes a sink, drawer storage, and an optional drawer refrigerator. The portside curved companion lounge features a forward-facing swivel seat and an aft-facing mezzanine lounge seat, with the option of adding a refrigerator/freezer. Engine room access is made easy with a drop-down hatch, and a teak table for the companion lounge is available for added elegance.

In the lower cockpit, there are two insulated flush floor storage boxes and large floor hatches divided into four smaller ones. The molded-in transom door and gate, along with a 24" x 24" aluminum backing plate laminated into the cockpit floor, enhance functionality. Transom options include an aft fold-down lounge, an L-lounge, or a transom baitwell. The L-lounge can be paired with a teak or fiberglass table and a sun pad conversion. For swimming enthusiasts, an optional 30" or 42" swim platform with a built-in ladder is available. The yacht also offers a choice between a cruising hardtop or a tournament hardtop, and premium fishing equipment from the Tiara Tournament Series (TTS) can be specified.

Inside, the 4300 Open features a luxurious and spacious interior, with a salon/dinette/galley greatroom combo and two large private staterooms. The

forward master stateroom and the port guest stateroom are both elegantly designed, with solid teak or optional solid teak and holly hardwood floors throughout. A foredeck skylight bathes the salon, galley, and master stateroom in natural light. Optional hullside portlights and a central vacuum system are available for added convenience.

The salon includes a port U-shaped lounge/dinette that seats 4-5 people and features a high-gloss removable table. The lounge can be transformed into a double lower berth, with the backrest converting into an upper Pullman. The entertainment center, situated opposite the lounge/dinette, includes a Sharp Aquos 32" flat screen LCD TV and a Bose Lifestyle 18 DVD/CD stereo system. Teak companionway entry steps with hinged storage underneath and a trash receptacle add to the functionality. The salon is kept comfortable with a Marine Air Systems 12,000 BTU air conditioner with reverse cycle heat.

The starboard U-shaped galley is equipped with Corian countertops, a stainless steel undermount sink with a Corian cover, under-counter storage, and a large aft galley pantry. It also includes a two-burner electric cooktop with a Corian cover, a microwave/convection oven, and Vitrifrigo dual refrigerator drawers and a refrigerator/freezer combination, with an optional ice maker.

The forward master stateroom is spacious, with a bi-fold entry door from the salon hallway and a private entrance to the head. It includes a queen-size pedestal berth with an innerspring mattress, a storage compartment, and two storage drawers underneath. A starboard cedar-backed hanging locker and upper hullside storage cabinets provide ample storage space. Optional underberth rod storage is available, and the stateroom is equipped with a Sharp Aquos 19" flat screen LCD TV with a built-in DVD player. A Marine Air 10,000 BTU air conditioner with reverse cycle heat ensures comfort in the master stateroom and head.

The guest stateroom, with a private separate entry from the salon hallway, includes upper and lower bunks with innerspring mattresses, storage under

the lower bunk, and a hanging locker with shelves. An optional TV with a built-in DVD player is also available.

The fiberglass head features two full-frame entry doors, one from the salon hallway and another for private entry from the forward master stateroom. It includes a Corian vanity countertop and sink, a mirrored lighted medicine cabinet, upper and lower storage, and a linen cabinet. The stall shower has a glass door and an integrated fiberglass seat.

The foredeck is equipped with a skylight/hatch system, a molded-in fiberglass bow pulpit, a flush forward anchor rode locker, an automatic rope/chain anchor windlass system, and a one-piece welded 316L stainless steel bow rail. Available options include a 30" or 42" swim platform, hullside portlights, a forward deck sun pad, upper and/or lower cockpit carpet, a Stidd helm seat, an aft fold-down lounge or L-lounge, and wet bar and prep center options.

The 4300 Open is a versatile and luxurious yacht, offering a range of options to suit both fishing and cruising enthusiasts, ensuring an exceptional experience on the water.

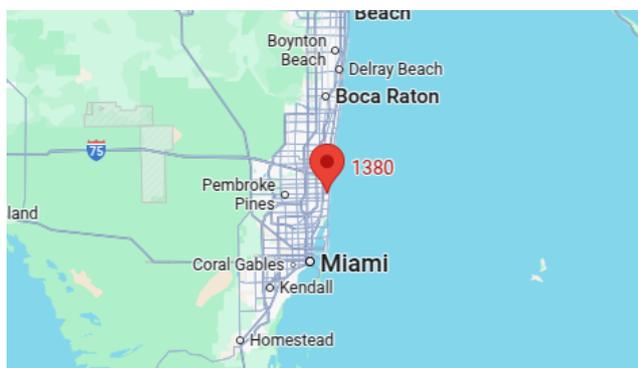
