OVERVIEW

Discover the refined elegance of this 43' Jim Smith walkaround, masterfully fashioned with cold-molded construction for a hull that marries lightness and strength. Power comes from four 2023 Mercury Verado outboards at 350 hp each, showing approximately 370 hours and protected by extended Platinum engine warranties effective from the date of purchase. The yacht is equipped with a diesel generator and a spacious, climate-controlled bridge deck with air conditioning, while a Seakeeper gyro stabilizer delivers exceptional onboard comfort and seakeeping.

Entertainment and convenience are thoughtfully addressed with a new KVH TV5 satellite dome and a fresh EZ2CY enclosure, complemented by plush cushions by Canvas Designers and a full bow lounge pad for leisurely days afloat. Currently stored out of water on a lift, the vessel displays a handsome teak cockpit and cover boards, a practical mezzanine seat with rocket launcher, a faux painted toe rail, and full walkaround non-skid decks that blend style with functionality. For buyers seeking a yacht that balances performance and luxury, explore yacht sales in the current boat location and claim this stunning vessel.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview and accommodations

The one and only 43' Jim Smith Tournament Boats walk-around is a remarkable vessel that has recently undergone significant upgrades and is now unexpectedly available, presenting an exceptional opportunity for discerning owners. The yacht offers a comfortable bridge deck with air conditioning and new Canvas Designers cushions on a white ladderback bench helm seat, complemented by a second lounge seat forward of the helm, while cabin access is through a sliding panel door located forward on the port side. Descending five steps into the cabin reveals satin-finished teak cabinetry that is both beautiful and expertly crafted, with the starboard-side galley featuring a bullnose Corian countertop for sleek functionality. Forward, a V-shaped seating lounge with a teak table converts into a berth with the addition of a filler cushion, and just aft on the port side a full head with a separate shower stall presents a vanity top that matches the galley. A separate aft cabin offers generously sized twin berths and convenient storage beneath, with the main cabin TV mounted above the cabin door; the cabin sole is finished in Amtico laminate teak and holly, tying the interior together with refined elegance. Kept on a boatlift, this yacht received four new 350hp white Mercury Verados in the summer of 2023, each covered by Platinum warranty protection for long-term reliability and peace of mind.

Bridge deck

The bridge deck is a masterclass in design and functionality, featuring a 2023 Canvas Designers three-quarter enclosure with the forward three panels in EZ-2-CY and soft side panels equipped with U-Zips, while the deck itself is graced with elegant teak decking for a timeless aesthetic. The varnished teak

helm pod and Mercury control binnacle are mounted on teak for a seamless look, and the upright electronics console houses three 16-inch Garmin displays protected by sliding clear Lexan panels with a magnetic compass perched atop. Opening cabinets flank the helm pod with mounted instruments for immediate access, and the space is enhanced by air conditioning for comfort on extended runs. Helm seating is configured as a bench/cabinet with a removable ladderback, new Canvas Designers cushions and a fold-down aluminum footrest; the cabinet is accessible from the cockpit and contains dedicated tackle drawers and storage for practical use. Forward of the helm console a lounge seat with new cushions conceals two stainless-lined, insulated refrigerated boxes that can be set as freezers, with a small opening step beneath for shoe or general storage, reflecting the thoughtful and purposeful design of this exceptional bridge deck.

Electronics, navigation, and entertainment

The electronics, navigation, and entertainment suite is state-of-the-art, anchored by three Garmin 7616 multi-function GPS/chartplotters that deliver precise charting and situational awareness. Radar capabilities are provided by a Garmin GMR 2526 xHD2 open six-foot array with bird mode for enhanced detection, while a Garmin GSD CHIRP recording echosounder paired with an Airmar B275LH wide CHIRP transducer offers superior underwater imaging and depth analysis. Weather information is available via the Garmin GXM52 Sirius Weather module, and the Garmin GHP Reactor autopilot with SmartPump and GHC 20 control maintains smooth and accurate course management. Communication is handled by two Standard Horizon Matrix-series GX2000 VHF radios with Comrod four-foot antennas, complemented by a Ritchie PowerDamp five-inch magnetic compass for traditional navigation. Security and tracking are enhanced by the GOST NavTracker 1.0, and visibility is improved by an ACR RCL-100D remote control

spotlight. Entertainment is exceptional with a KVH Track-Vision five SAT TV antenna installed in 2023 and a Direct TV H24 HD Sat TV receiver, while audio comes from a Fusion BB300R marine stereo with AM/FM, Bluetooth and satellite radio capability, driven by a JL Audio MHD 600 amplifier and delivered through two JL Audio M770 speakers in the cockpit and two 6.5-inch JL Audio speakers on the bridge deck for rich, vessel-wide sound.

Cabin and galley

Access to the cabin from the bridge deck is through a tinted glass sliding door framed in white aluminum that leads down five teak steps into an interior of refined elegance, where satin-varnished teak cabinetry and wainscoting create a warm and inviting ambiance. To starboard the galley features Corian countertops with a bullnose curved edge and is equipped with a Dometic CR-0110S three point three five cubic foot under-counter refrigerator, an LG stainless steel front microwave housed neatly in a cabinet, and a Blanco stainless steel single basin undermounted sink paired with a Moen faucet with a removable spray nozzle head for convenience. Amtico teak and holly laminate flooring runs throughout, complemented by ample teak drawers and cabinets and a trash can located beneath the sink. Forward, a V-shaped lounge with blue upholstered cushions surrounds a teak triangular table that lowers and converts into an extra berth with a filler cushion, while the port-side door leads to the head and aft the stateroom with twin berths provides private sleeping quarters, with a Samsung flat-panel TV mounted above the stateroom door to keep entertainment close at hand.

Stateroom

The stateroom aft offers an inviting teak-framed entry that sets the tone for its refined interior, featuring twin bunk berths with convenient storage beneath

each berth to keep personal effects organized. A teak nightstand between the berths doubles as a cover for the Seakeeper gyro, integrating function and form, while Amtico teak and holly laminate flooring and teak cabinetry outboard and along the aft bulkhead provide abundant storage and an elevated aesthetic. A new Samsung flat-panel TV installed in 2023 is mounted on the forward bulkhead wall ahead of the portside berth, ensuring entertainment and relaxation options within easy reach; the stateroom balances comfort and practical design for restful nights aboard.

Head

The head blends function and elegance with a Headhunter freshwater toilet for reliable performance and Amtico teak and holly laminate flooring for a sophisticated foundation, accessed through a hinged teak door with a magnetic opening keeper. The vanity is finished with a Corian top and backsplash and features an oval Kohler Caxton undermount ceramic sink paired with a brushed nickel Moen faucet, while a large teak-framed mirror above the vanity enhances light and sense of space. Teak cabinetry provides both drawer and door storage for toiletries and essentials, and the separate shower compartment is finished in white paint with a molded seat and shower wand fixture for comfortable, private bathing; additional features include a 110v outlet and an exhaust fan to ensure functionality and ventilation in this thoughtfully appointed head.

Fishing equipment

The fishing equipment is arranged to satisfy serious anglers, anchored by Rupp Top Gun Z-30 radial outriggers with eighteen-foot silver single-spreader poles, currently stored off the boat for safekeeping, and supported by underdeck fishboxes that offer ample storage for the catch. The transom livewell with

light and fish box ensures bait and fish remain fresh, while two 12v outlets under the gunwale provide convenient power for electric reels. A teak six-rod rocket launcher mounted on a four-inch chrome stanchion provides sturdy rod storage, complemented by six flush-mounted rod holders in the coverboards and two rod holders on each rear hardtop support to maximize fishing versatility. Tackle storage is cleverly integrated inside the aft side cabinet doors of the helm bench seat and mezzanine seat backrest, keeping gear organized and within easy reach for efficient and enjoyable fishing excursions.

Cockpit

The cockpit is a refined blend of style and practicality, featuring a teak cockpit with rounded teak coverboards and both fresh and saltwater washdown spigots for easy cleanup after a day of fishing or cruising. An Eskimo crushed ice machine beneath the deck feeds directly into the fishbox to preserve the catch, while stainless scupper drains in the aft corners ensure efficient drainage. A three-sided canvas fly cover offers element protection, Lumitec cockpit spreader lights molded into the hardtop provide night illumination, and an aft-facing cushioned lounge mezzanine offers comfortable seating. Beneath the lounge, machinery space access reveals the generator, battery chargers, pumps and water heater neatly arranged for serviceability, with additional storage beneath the steps to the bridge deck on either side; a dockside power 50amp inlet plug ensures shore power connectivity. This cockpit is purposefully organized for both high-performance fishing and relaxed social time on the water.

Hull and deck equipment

The hull and deck equipment are engineered for performance and comfort, with a cold-molded hull built to a Donald Blount bottom design known for

efficiency and stability, and maneuverability enhanced by a Wesmar DC bow thruster with a nine-inch tunnel, with a new bow thruster scheduled for installation on October 1, 2024. Humphree x-series interceptor blades with an auto-trim controller provide optimal trim and stability, while a stainless steel towing eye on the bow and an elegantly painted toe rail mimicking teak contribute durability and refined styling; walk-around decks are finished in non-skid paint for safety. A Canvas Designers forward deckhouse sun-lounge cushion introduced in 2023 features Bentley stitching and an attached headrest pillow, protected by a fitted zippered water-resistant cover with a cutout for the forward deck hatch. Anchoring is managed by a Lewmar electric windlass with a stainless pulpit chute and polished chrome anchor housed in a foredeck locker, and the deck hardware includes eight stainless steel cleats, six of them pop-up style with recessed back plates. An Armstrong dive ladder with an attach bracket at the transom provides water access, and a white single trumpet air horn mounted on the hardtop completes the deck equipment, reflecting careful attention to both function and presentation.

Electrical equipment

The electrical system provides dependable power and efficient energy management, with a 50amp 240v dockside shore power system including a 50-foot cord and a Cablemaster cord winder for convenient handling. Onboard power generation is supplied by a Kohler M-9EK02D 8.5kW generator housed in a sound shield enclosure to minimize noise. The main electrical panel inside the cabin offers 120v/240v AC and 24v DC circuit breakers with voltmeters and amp meters for precise monitoring, while additional 12V DC switches are located aft beneath the helm seat. Six AMG PC1200T batteries with radial shutoff switches provide the vessel's DC reserve, maintained by a Mastervolt battery charger and a Guest ChargePro battery maintainer to ensure optimal battery performance. An audible high water bilge alarm enhances safety, LED

lighting is installed throughout the cabin, cockpit, bridge deck and utility spaces, and two Lumishore underwater lights add ambiance and visibility. A Raritan 6.5-gallon hot water heater supplies onboard hot water, completing a comprehensive electrical package designed for reliability and comfort.

Engines and mechanical equipment

Powering the yacht are four white Mercury 350hp Verado outboards installed new in 2023 with approximately 370 hours of use, each covered by a Mercury Platinum engine warranty extending through spring 2030 to provide long-term assurance. Engine monitoring is delivered via a Mercury Marine Smartcraft Vessel View 703 display with separate start/stop switches for convenient operation, while fuel management employs Mercury Marine spin-on fuel filters and a digital throttle and shift control binnacle for smooth responsive control. Stability is enhanced by a Seakeeper 6 gyrostabilizer installed in 2020 with its control panel located in the cabin below the main electrical panel, and steering is managed by a SeaStar power steering system. Four aluminum fuel tanks with fills on both port and starboard sides provide ample fuel capacity with Aeroquip CG approved fuel lines for added safety. Mechanical systems include an automatic fire suppression system in the utility/generator room, a freshwater washdown water pump, a Headhunter 110v freshwater system pump supported by a two-gallon Jabsco accumulator pressure tank, and bilge management via two Rule 2500 automatic bilge pumps aft and two forward. Climate control comes from two self-contained FCF 12k BTU air conditioning systems and a Dometic self-contained bridge deck A/C, while bronze underwater thru-hull seacocks complete the mechanical package for dependable operation.

Jim Smith Tournament Boats are renowned for high-quality, handmade construction and innovative design, and this forty-three foot model exemplifies that legacy; this hull was the beginning of a series of outboard walk-around boats from the builder, demonstrating their commitment to excellence and creativity. With a set of new engines accompanied by extended warranty coverage and the addition of a Seakeeper gyro for enhanced stability, the yacht delivers reliable performance and a notably smoother ride in varied sea conditions. The comfortable bridge deck, practical cockpit and outdoor sun lounge create ideal spaces for relaxation and entertaining during cruising days, and the vessel's combination of luxury, performance and versatility presents a compelling option for a fortunate new owner seeking a turnkey outboard walk-around with premium systems and thoughtful detailing.

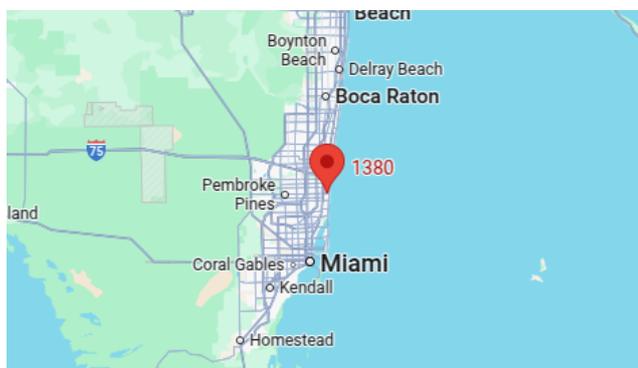
