OVERVIEW

Sleek and self-assured, this 43-foot 2004 model (built in 2003) marries spirited performance with refined comfort, an ideal companion for cruising America's coastal waters and inland waterways. Her timeless profile and confident stance promise spontaneous getaways, long weekends, and effortless entertaining, while the thoughtful engineering beneath her lines ensures each outing feels composed and enjoyable.

Her hull and deck are fashioned from robust fiberglass, reinforced with advanced composite materials to provide a solid underfoot presence and a quiet, controlled motion through chop and swell. Beneath the waterline, twin Caterpillar inboard diesels deliver the dependable torque and smooth power delivery experienced mariners rely on, offering responsive close-quarters handling as well as relaxed, efficient passage-making. The result is a yacht that combines spirited responsiveness with unflappable composure, comfortable whether slipping out for a sunset run or covering distance on a full day's cruise.

Inside, the atmosphere is warm and inviting, with an interior layout that balances open social areas and private retreats. Generous windows and carefully conceived sightlines keep the salon bright and connected to the surrounding sea, while the galley and lounging spaces are arranged to encourage easy conversation and seamless hosting. Aft and fore deck areas provide versatile outdoor rooms for alfresco dining, basking in the sun, or preparing for a day on the water, and throughout the yacht practical appointments are matched with refined finishes that reward both use and admiration.

With durable composite construction and reliable twin Caterpillar diesel power at her core, this 43-footer distinguishes itself as a polished, capable cruiser—perfect for owners who prize quality and understated luxury. It offers

the Motor Yacht experience with the agility of an Express Cruiser and the range of a Coastal Cruiser, evoking Sport Cruiser poise, Diesel Inboard confidence, and classic Fiberglass Yacht craftsmanship.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

Power is provided by a proven Caterpillar C12 rated at 700 hp with just 1,000 hours; all services are current and the aftercoolers were serviced in November 2024 to ensure confident, efficient running. Shipboard power is delivered by a Westerbeke 8 kW generator, serviced October 2025, supplying quiet, reliable electricity for every comfort and system aboard. The helm is guided by a modern electronics suite anchored by Garmin 8617 and Garmin 8616 displays from 2022, a Garmin GSd26 sounder from 2022, a Garmin 1224 XHD2 open array radar from 2022 and an Airmar B265JH transducer from 2022 for crisp target definition and reliable depth intelligence. Communication and control are handled by a Standard Horizon VHF from 2022, Raymarine autopilot and Raymarine data repeater, while Starlink added in 2024 elevates offshore connectivity. Entertainment flows through a Fusion Apollo stereo from 2022 paired with JL Audio speakers for immersive sound throughout the salon and cockpit.

Below decks the primary stateroom is a serene retreat anchored by a queen V-berth framed in rich cherry cabinetry with cedar-lined storage under the bed, a cedar-lined hanging locker, second-zone A/C control, warm reading lamps and a flat-screen TV, creating a comfortable, private sanctuary. The guest stateroom offers a twin berth arrangement with cedar-lined storage under the beds, a cedar-lined hanging locker and its own flat-screen TV, providing inviting accommodations for family or friends. The head is thoughtfully appointed with a Jabsco electric toilet, a Corian countertop with sink, a large mirror with a built-in medicine cabinet and a proper shower; two entrances, including direct access from the primary stateroom, make it both private and practical. The galley is equally refined with Corian countertops, a Sub-Zero refrigerator, a

Sub-Zero refrigerator/freezer, a two-burner cooktop, a microwave, ample storage and a handsome holly sole that reflects the care and quality throughout.

Notable options and recent updates amplify capability and comfort, from topsides painted for a fresh, modern sheen to bottom paint and running gear serviced October 2025, plus a new six-piece enclosure installed in 2024 for all-weather confidence and an aft sunshade with carbon fiber poles added in 2022. A Freedom Marine tender lift enhances tender handling, new salon A/C installed in 2022 and new forward A/C in 2024 provide climate control throughout, 30 amp electric reel outlets supply fishing conveniences, new interior carpet from 2022 refreshes the living spaces, freezer plate and chill plates in the cockpit freezer were added in 2024, and a Glendening cablingmaster keeps shore-power management tidy.
