OVERVIEW

The Tollycraft 44 Aft Cabin offers an impeccably appointed interior where hand-selected teak, finished in a soft satin sheen, is paired with light-toned bulkheads and elegant fabrics in the staterooms to evoke a serene, high-end atmosphere. Expansive windows in the salon and galley flood these spaces with natural light, enhancing the perception of volume and reinforcing the open, airy character of a motor yacht. A hallmark of this aft-cabin cruiser is the seamless flow between salon, galley, and dinette; with the galley positioned just a couple of steps below the salon, the cook remains intimately connected to guests and the conversation above. This thoughtful configuration marries comfort, practicality, and timeless design to create an inviting onboard environment ideally suited to cruising and refined motor-yacht living.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Salon

The salon greets guests with handcrafted teak joinery and a plush carpeted salon floor that together create an inviting, refined ambiance. Forward to starboard a side helm station with a sliding deck access door facilitates smooth passage along the side deck, while centerline aft a pair of teak double doors opens elegantly onto the aft deck, promoting effortless indoor-outdoor flow. Forward to port, a breakfast serving bar extending from the galley enhances casual dining and service, complemented by a beverage center with cabinet storage, a sink with hot and cold water and a U-Line icemaker to keep refreshments perfectly chilled. Light and privacy are managed with large opening window shades paired with roller-style window shades, essential systems are within reach via AC/DC power distribution panels, and a Sony stereo system provides curated entertainment to complete the space.

Galley

Carefully configured in a U-shaped layout, the galley is designed to optimize both cooking and storage, featuring sumptuous teak cabinetry with overhead lockers finished with graceful tambour-style sliding doors, abundant drawer space and an integrated cutting board for effortless meal prep. Culinary appointments include a Princess stainless-steel three-burner electric range, a Contoure convection microwave, a Norgold refrigerator and freezer and a Roper Mfg. trash compactor, while a double stainless-steel sink paired with a Moen single-lever faucet ensures efficient cleanup. Underfoot, a teak parquet sole lends warmth and refinement, and an opening window—complete with screen and curtains—floods the space with fresh air and natural light; a convenient salon icemaker is also on hand to supply chilled refreshments.

Dining area

The dining area is appointed with two opposing settees surrounding a central table that effortlessly converts into a double berth, while ample bulk settee compartments and additional drawer storage ensure personal items are discreetly and efficiently stowed. Warm parquet flooring lends an inviting elegance underfoot, and cleverly integrated in-floor lockers maximize storage capacity for extended cruising.

Owner's stateroom

A commanding full-beam aft suite, the owner's stateroom is designed as a tranquil sanctuary centered on a queen island bed, flanked by two dedicated headboard reading lights for evening relaxation. Thoughtful ventilation and discretion are achieved through port and starboard opening sliding windows with insect screens, with window blinds available for added privacy, creating gentle cross-breezes throughout the cabin. Two discreetly integrated transom escape hatches provide an added measure of safety and reassurance. Storage is generous and well-considered, including a starboard nightstand with six drawers, two hanging lockers for clothing, and a port-side bureau for supplementary capacity. Practical comforts include a 120VAC electric heater and a 12VDC outlet to support onboard appliances, while a dressing mirror enhances daily grooming. The suite is completed by an ensuite head featuring a full stall shower for a truly residential level of comfort.

Owner's stateroom head

An inviting ambiance is created by warm wood flooring beneath your feet in the owner's stateroom head, where a refined vanity showcases a cultured

marble countertop, integrated sink and chrome-finished faucet. A mirror accompanies generous drawer and cabinet storage that blends elegance with practical organization, while a stall shower makes daily routines effortless. Fresh airflow is maintained by a 12VDC ventilation fan, and for added safety and convenience a GFCI-protected 120VAC duplex outlet completes this impeccably appointed space.

VIP stateroom

The VIP stateroom exemplifies contemporary design, finished in light, luminous tones and centered on a generous V-berth with a filler tucked beneath a mirrored headboard. Natural light and ventilation flow through matched port and starboard portlights and an overhead skylight with screen, while practical comforts include drawer and cabinet storage, a hanging locker, 12VDC and 120VAC power outlets, and two headboard reading lights. Completing this private sanctuary is an ensuite head that enhances both comfort and convenience.

VIP stateroom head

Layered in comfort and utility, the VIP stateroom head presents a vanity crowned with cultured marble that unites countertop and sink, paired with a chrome-finished faucet and matching mirror. Thoughtful storage is provided by drawer and cabinet compartments, while a dependable Dometic electric toilet ensures modern convenience. A portlight with screen invites natural light and airflow, aided by a 12 VDC ventilation fan, and onboard power needs are served by a 120 VAC duplex. The space is rounded out by an elegantly finished shower, creating a refined and functional retreat.

Helm

A stainless steel destroyer style wheel commands the helm, offering assured, pinpoint steering while imparting a timeless nautical elegance. Immediately alongside, a sliding side deck access door permits a rapid transfer onto the side deck, making docking and line handling more effortless and preserving an uninterrupted flow of movement around the yacht.

Aft deck & cockpit

A factory-fitted hardtop crowns the area, matched by textured non-slip decking that ensures confident footing. Rich teak doors lead into the main salon, while two fiberglass deck boxes serve as dual-purpose seating and practical storage. A recessed ladder provides access to the cockpit, and the aft deck is intentionally open with no enclosure.

Electrical equipment

Meticulously engineered for seamless operation both at anchor and alongside the dock, the yacht is equipped with twin 125V/30A shore power inlets and a matching 125V/30A shore power cord to ensure simple, secure marina connections. The engine room houses 12 V DC air-ventilation blowers to promote efficient cooling and circulation, while a dedicated Guest Charge Pro 20A battery charger keeps the bow thruster batteries consistently topped and ready. When you venture away from shore services, a 6 kW generator provides dependable onboard electrical supply, and navigation is supported by a Simrad chart plotter.

Mechanical equipment

Propulsion is provided by twin 340 HP Mercruisers with 1,100 hours on the clocks, mated to Twin Disc transmissions and safeguarded by Racor fuel filters. A Honda outboard serves as auxiliary power for added maneuverability, while traditional shaft packing glands and a set of spare propellers reinforce the vessel's dependable running gear. Comfort and protection from the elements are assured by reverse-cycle marine air and heat, an aft-deck hardtop and a flybridge enclosed on three sides.
