With the solar energy system, this yacht can stay anchored for long durations while effectively powering five onboard refrigerators. The integrated generator kicks in automatically when battery levels fall to 30% and shuts off once they are fully charged at 99%.



















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull

The hull of this yacht exemplifies cutting-edge marine design, boasting an intricate sandwich construction. This innovative design integrates polyester resin and glass fiber, skillfully layered around a balsa core. This combination not only provides remarkable strength and resilience but also contributes to the vessel's lightweight character, enhancing its performance on the water. The exterior is adorned with a flawless white gel coat, offering a sleek and polished look that is both visually appealing and protective against environmental elements.

Below the surface, the structural hull counter molding is constructed from a monolithic laminate, once again employing the sturdy combination of polyester resin and glass fiber. This construction method ensures a robust and dependable foundation, capable of enduring the challenges of the sea.

The hull's semi-floating profile is a strategic design choice that maximizes stability and efficiency. This configuration allows the yacht to glide effortlessly through the water, providing a comfortable and pleasurable experience for everyone on board. Whether cruising through tranquil waters or facing more demanding conditions, this hull design guarantees an exceptional maritime journey.

Deck

The deck of this yacht exemplifies a perfect blend of style and utility, constructed with a sandwich design that integrates polyester resin and glass fiber around a balsa core. This cutting-edge approach results in a strong yet lightweight structure, perfect for exceptional performance and longevity. The

deck is further strengthened with structural counter molding in monolithic laminate, again using the reliable combination of polyester resin and glass fiber. A white gel coat finish not only elevates the deck's visual appeal but also acts as a protective barrier against the elements.

For safety and functionality, the deck is equipped with a diamond tip non-slip surface, ensuring stable footing in all conditions. The stainless steel guard sheer rail on the hull and teak bulwarks add both sophistication and practicality, while a gangway door to starboard provides easy access.

Mooring is simplified with a stainless steel bow fitting and anchor platform, enhanced by bow stainless steel protection. The yacht features a robust 1000 W vertical electric windlass, facilitating smooth anchor operations with upward and downward movement, controllable from the windlass, wheelhouse, and flybridge. Six aluminum mooring cleats, each 400mm in length, offer secure mooring options, while stainless steel gunwale guards and two stainless steel fairleads at the aft of the cockpit provide additional safety and convenience. The deck also includes two self-draining compartments with teak-slatted hatch covers, enhancing the vessel's practicality.

Safety on deck is a top priority, with a stainless steel pulpit that is open and encircles the cockpit up to the steps, creating a secure environment. A leather-covered stainless steel handrail in the cockpit deckhead and an extra stainless steel handrail at the entrance to the port side deck offer further security and support, ensuring peace of mind for everyone on board.

Cockpit

The cockpit of this yacht is crafted with a focus on both utility and comfort, featuring a self-draining system that efficiently removes water, ensuring the area remains dry and secure. The teak gunwales contribute an element of sophistication and strength, enhancing the overall visual appeal of the space. Practicality is further highlighted by two lockers at the cockpit's base, equipped

with gas pistons and locks, offering secure storage for your belongings.

A cleverly integrated gas bottle within the staircase optimizes space usage, while the cockpit shower, providing both hot and cold water, adds a touch of luxury and convenience for rinsing off after a swim. Access to the cockpit is straightforward with a dedicated door, allowing for smooth movement throughout the yacht.

The bathing platform is a remarkable feature, designed with a natural teak surface and accented by a stainless steel rubbing strake. With dimensions of 3.41 by 1.00 meters, it offers plenty of space for relaxation and enjoyment. An ergonomic bathing ladder with handholds is built into the platform, ensuring safe and easy water access.

Moreover, there is an access door to the starboard side deck from the cockpit, featuring a grey tinted port, which not only complements the yacht's sleek design but also enhances privacy and comfort. This cockpit perfectly combines style, safety, and functionality, making it an ideal area for both relaxation and entertainment.

Flybridge

The flybridge of this yacht is a masterpiece of design and practicality, featuring a self-draining system that efficiently removes water, ensuring a dry and secure environment. Access to the flybridge is both elegant and safe, with a stainless steel staircase and ramp adorned with stylish teak steps. The area is shielded by a grey tinted windscreen made from PMMA, offering both clear visibility and a sleek look, with entry through a PMMA hatch.

Encircling the aft of the flybridge is a stainless steel pulpit, adding a touch of safety and elegance. The white lacquered swing mast is a versatile addition, accommodating navigation lights, radar, aerials, and a deck spotlight, ensuring the yacht is fully equipped for any voyage. At the core of the flybridge is the

central steering console, which houses a comprehensive control panel. This panel includes electrical engine controls, electric windlass control, thruster and flaps, along with gauge indicators and a tiller angle indicator. There is ample room for navigation electronics, and the stainless steel steering wheel is paired with a steering compass and hydraulic steering for precise control.

Additional features include a fog horn and a 12 V socket for added convenience. Comfort is a priority, with an adjustable pilot seat and a co-driver's seat to port, both upholstered in the luxurious twin-colored Diamante Storm & Snow PVC. The flybridge saloon to port provides an inviting area with an L-shaped bench seat, built-in lockers, a removable teak table, and matching upholstery, creating an ideal setting for relaxation and socializing.

A GRP unit with a sink, handrail, and storage enhances the practicality of the space, while a dedicated area for a life raft with stainless steel fixing bolt plates ensures safety is never compromised. This flybridge is a seamless blend of luxury, safety, and functionality, making it a standout feature of the yacht.

Accommodations

The accommodations aboard this yacht seamlessly combine opulence and functionality, showcasing exquisite Alpi Mahogany woodwork and parquet-style laminated floors that radiate warmth and sophistication. Taupe cushions add a layer of refinement, creating an inviting ambiance throughout the living areas.

In the saloon, the generous headroom of 1.98 meters (6'6") imparts an open and airy atmosphere. The sofa converts into a double berth, providing flexibility for extra sleeping arrangements, and is complemented by a dividing rail and curtains for added privacy. The area is furnished with a stool and two folding armchairs, centered around a semi-folding, height-adjustable, varnished wood table. Storage is plentiful, with cupboards and shelves, while the three-leaved aft window door with a black lacquered aluminum frame

allows natural light to illuminate the space. A leather-covered handrail on the deckhead adds a touch of luxury and safety.

The galley, also with a headroom of 1.98 meters (6'6"), is U-shaped and features an opening window for ventilation. It is equipped with a Corian® Sagebrush countertop with a sink cover, two stainless steel sinks with pressurized cold/hot water mixer taps, a gas oven, and a 3-burner hob with a protective glass cover. The 130-liter front-opening fridge (12 V) keeps your provisions fresh, while a cutlery drawer, stowage, and drawers, along with a bin, offer practical storage solutions.

The owner's cabin, situated forward, provides a headroom of 1.92 meters (6'4") and features a spacious double berth measuring 2.06 by 1.60 meters (6'9" x 5'3"). A marine mattress ensures a restful night's sleep, with storage available beneath the berth and on both sides. The cabin is equipped with a mirror, two illuminated hanging cupboards, and an opening deck hatch with a fitted mosquito net. Two opening hull portholes with blackout curtains offer both light and privacy.

The head, located starboard-forward, offers a headroom of 1.98 meters (6'6") and includes a mirror with backlighting, a cupboard, and an open stowage locker. An opening deck hatch with a fitted mosquito net ensures ventilation, while the inset resin basin and separate shower compartment with a fold-down seat over the WC provide convenience. The quiet flush electric toilet and additional stowage complete this well-appointed space.

Guest cabins on the port side also offer a headroom of 1.98 meters (6'6") and feature a double berth measuring 1.96 by 1.45 meters (6'5" x 4'9"). A marine mattress, four drawers, cupboards, and storage under the berth ensure comfort and practicality. Two opening hull portholes with blackout curtains offer light and privacy.

The aft starboard head mirrors the forward head with a headroom of 1.98 meters (6'6"), a mirror with backlighting, a cupboard, and two opening

portholes. It is equipped with a quiet flush electric toilet, an inset resin basin, a mixer tap, and a shower, ensuring all the comforts of home are at your disposal.

Engines

The engines of this yacht are crafted to provide outstanding performance and dependability, featuring a shaft line propulsion system that is both efficient and sturdy. Outfitted with four-blade propellers, the yacht is driven by twin Volvo D4 engines, each delivering 300 horsepower (221 kW), ensuring a powerful and smooth journey. The fuel system is meticulously engineered with fuel filters that include sediment reservoirs and sea water filters, maintaining peak engine performance.

The engine room is insulated with high-density foam, 40mm thick, which significantly reduces noise and vibration, enhancing the onboard comfort. Air intakes on the hull sides ensure effective cooling of the engine compartment, while safety is prioritized with the inclusion of two fire extinguishers. Fuel management is streamlined by a fuel tank deck filler and two interconnected aluminum fuel tanks, each with a capacity of 700 liters (185 US gallons). These tanks are pre-configured for a Fuel Polishing System (FPS) connection, improving fuel quality and engine efficiency.

The steering system is expertly designed, featuring two bronze underhung rudders and hydraulic steering for precise maneuvering. Electric trim tabs and a Quick BTQ 185 85 12 bow thruster further enhance maneuverability, making docking and navigation effortless.

Additionally, the yacht is equipped with Volvo's advanced software, including a trip computer, cruise control, and a single lever for simplified operation. These features combine to offer a seamless and enjoyable yachting experience, ensuring that every voyage is as smooth and efficient as possible.

Electrical

The electrical system on this yacht is crafted to deliver dependable and efficient power management, ensuring all onboard systems operate smoothly. Central to the system is a comprehensive electrical panel that accommodates both 12 V and 220 V operations, allowing for flexible power distribution. The yacht is equipped with 220 V shore power, ensuring all electrical requirements are fulfilled when docked.

There are eight 220 V outlets strategically distributed throughout the yacht: two in the lounge, two in the galley, one in the owner's cabin, one in the guest cabin, one in the forward head, and one in the aft washroom. Additionally, there are two dedicated outlets for TV connections, located in the saloon and the owner's cabin, offering entertainment options for all guests.

For connectivity, the yacht is equipped with two double antenna sockets, supporting both TNT and SAT connections. The power system is robust, featuring two 12V 140Ah service batteries, four 12V 50Ah engine start batteries, and two 12V 50Ah bow thruster batteries, ensuring all systems have the necessary power to function efficiently. Two 25 Ah battery chargers are included to maintain optimal battery performance.

The yacht also includes two 12 V sockets for additional power needs. Lighting is both functional and elegant, with LED overhead and reading lights providing interior illumination, while exterior lighting includes navigation lights and a mooring light with stainless steel mountings, ensuring visibility and safety during nighttime operations. This comprehensive electrical system ensures that all aspects of the yacht's power needs are met with efficiency and reliability.
