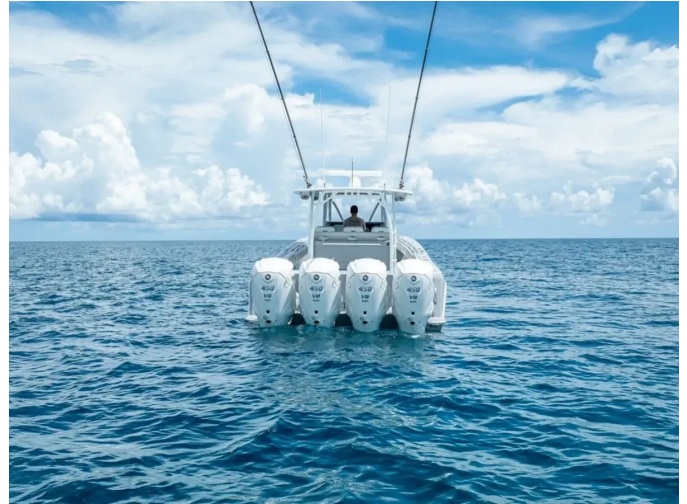




















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Console

At the helm a meticulously conceived console unites practical purpose with exquisite finish, crowned by an M-Series forty-four-inch LED light that delivers outstanding illumination and complemented by a larger side entry door for easier access. Within the console, daily amenities are presented with understated luxury: an integrated sink and shower, a porthole to invite natural light and fresh air, and a durable Corian countertop that refines the workspace. The switch panel is mounted up on the dash for intuitive operation, while the teak package inside the console introduces warm, handcrafted detail that completes the elegant, purposeful helm environment.

Custom top

Masterfully crafted for both protection and high-performance, the bespoke hard T-top is finished in glossy Matterhorn white with a refined Haze Grey underside, presenting a sophisticated silhouette from above. The forward legs are anchored by two aluminum plates set into the deck that also house four integrated rod holders, while a further two rod holders are mounted on the T-top for immediate access. Lighting is thoughtfully arranged and purposeful, featuring three spreader lights, a dedicated LED work light, an anchor light and a pair of discreet puck lights. An overhead antenna and outrigger pads are ready for action, and movement around the cockpit is assured by sturdy grab rails and tactile finger grip handrails. Sound is supplied through two dedicated speaker boxes, and the helm enjoys protection behind a pycarbon M Series Eisenglass enclosure. Built for serious trolling, Gemlux Bluewater outrigger bases are paired with Gemlux twenty-two foot telescoping outrigger poles, and a white powder coating package unifies the overall premium aesthetic.

Navigation

Assured passages begin at the wheel, where a high-speed compass and a dedicated navigation light combine to keep headings exact whether under the noon sun or a starlit sky. The Helm Master EX, fully integrated with Quad XTO engines, delivers complete maneuverability with both tilt and power steering, while a stainless-steel helm outfitted with a control knob provides the fine-tuned response required for precise handling. Sea-keeping and performance are further honed by Livorsi Model 1050 trim tabs and a thru-hull transducer that supplies accurate bottom and water-column information, and an additional one hundred gallons of fuel capacity quietly extends your cruising range for longer, more confident passages.

Electronics

A refined electronics package enhances every voyage, beginning with an onboard card reader for seamless data management and anchored by the Garmin GMR 2524xHD2 radar paired with the GXM 54 satellite weather receiver for commanding situational awareness; communications are delivered through twin VHF 215 AIS units mated to two eight-foot antennas on stainless mounts, while the B275LHW transducer together with the GSD 26 provides crisp, high-definition sonar imaging. Daily convenience is covered by a dual USB outlet, and onboard ambiance and entertainment are treated with equal care: a Fusion Apollo MS RA 770 helm unit powers a full JL Audio system comprising ten 7.7-inch speakers, two 12-inch subwoofers and two MHD 900/5 amplifiers, with lighting moods governed by a Shadow Caster LED controller. Passenger comfort is further elevated by a Seakeeper 3 gyro stabilizer, dramatically reducing roll to keep the yacht steady and guests serene.

Deck and hull

Every element of the deck and hull has been considered to deliver effortless days aboard, from a side-entry swim door that simplifies boarding to an anchor chute housing the anchor and operated by a windlass fitted with a locking system, plus a pop-up cleat on the bow for neat, secure mooring. Practical touches are plentiful, including two stainless-steel cup holders and a pair of pop-up fender cleats, a freshwater system and saltwater washdown, and 30 amp shore power with an onboard battery charger and dedicated power cord. After dusk the yacht takes on a new character with multicolor under-gunnel lighting and four multicolor underwater lights creating a sophisticated nocturnal atmosphere.

Comfort and ergonomics are equally refined, with Stadium Seating positioning front triple, pedestal-mounted Liebroc seats—each with footrests—on a molded fiberglass module, while a rear m-series leaning post bench sits beneath an extended hard top, complete with a folding footrest for additional support. Forward bench seating features plush cushions and a cockpit coaming bolster for long-day comfort, and exterior cushions are finished in light grey with mystic white piping and matching light grey upholstery stitching. A third transom cooler that doubles as a livewell, finished in ice blue, further enhances functionality for days spent cruising or fishing.

Engines and electrical

Propulsion is supplied by four Yamaha XTO white outboards, each delivering 450 hp and turning stainless-steel propellers, all operated from refined binnacle controls. Confident handling is assured by Helm Master EX steering alongside complete instrumentation and electronic controls, with secure key switches providing reliable start-up control. Each engine is supported by its own heavy-duty marine battery and dedicated fuel filter, while rigging

harnesses and an hour meter make routine maintenance straightforward. An intelligent fuel-management system brings water temperature, fuel gauges, engine hours, tack and a multifunction gauge into a clear, centralized display. Onboard systems are rounded out by a bilge pump with switch and an electric head, backed by a battery with switch for dependable operation.

Fishing and accessories

Engineered with the serious angler in mind, the cockpit features an aft fish box that drains overboard via a Gulper pump, supported by four electric reel outlets rated at 30 amps each to power heavy-duty tackle. Intake efficiency is assured by two Gemlux flush-mounted scoops, while live bait is preserved in style with three livewells fitted with clear lids, an additional insulated livewell integrated into the transom well, and three dedicated livewell lights for superior visibility. Rod storage is generously and thoughtfully arranged: five vertical holders at the console, twelve along the gunnel, four Mate Series cup/rod holders, two swivel rod holders, and six under-gunnel rod racks provide secure, accessible stowage for a full array of rods. A polished stainless steel pump box houses four 1500 gph pumps, ensuring robust circulation and dependable operation of all onboard systems.

Seating

The helm features Stadium Seating that pairs a forward trio of pedestal-mounted Liebroc seats—each equipped with footrests mounted on a molded fiberglass module—with an aft M-series leaning-post bench, all protected beneath an extended hard top that delivers exceptional shelter while maintaining outstanding visibility. A folding footrest at the leaning post increases comfort under way, and cushioned forward bench seating provides an inviting spot for relaxed cruising. A padded cockpit coaming bolster

encircles the working deck to offer supportive comfort, while the exterior cushions are presented in light grey with mystic white piping and matching light grey upholstery stitching, and the livewell is finished in a refined ice blue to complete the cohesive aesthetic.

Enhancements

Discreet refinements heighten every experience on board, beginning with an anchor chute supplied with anchor and a windlass fitted with a locking system, alongside a pop-up cleat on the bow that guarantees secure mooring. Practical comforts are woven into the design, including two stainless-steel cup holders and two pop-up fender cleats, a freshwater system paired with a saltwater washdown, and dependable 30-amp shore power complete with a battery charger and power cord. As daylight fades, multicolor under-gunnel lighting combined with four multicolor underwater lights bathes the vessel in a welcoming, customizable glow.

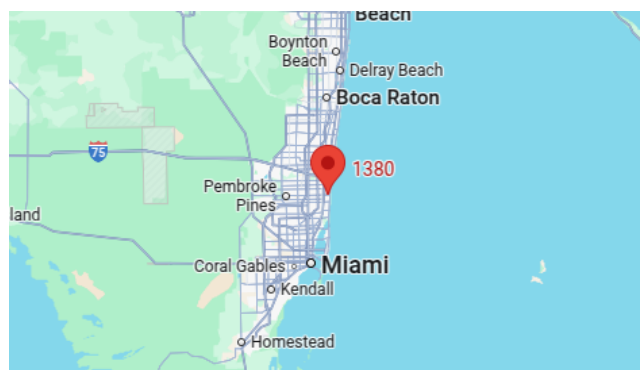
