DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

The yacht's hull is a marvel of craftsmanship and innovation, showcasing "Super Yacht" portholes in the Master and VIP cabins that exude elegance and luxury. Protected by antifouling and finished with Awlgrip paint, the hull combines durability with a striking appearance. Built with a core-infused sandwich Vinylester, it is further strengthened by stringers supported by transverse bulkheads and floors, offering remarkable strength and stability. A stainless steel rub rail provides additional protection, while bronze seacocks on all underwater through-hull fittings guarantee reliability and safety. The bow is fitted with two Xenon "head-lights," enhancing visibility and safety during night navigation. Volvo QL Trim Tabs are included for optimal handling and performance.

The yacht's superstructure is equally remarkable, with Awlgrip paint delivering a sleek and polished finish. The deck is constructed using a sandwich design with core support from bulkheads and frames, ensuring both strength and lightweight performance. Surrounding the yacht are 316 Oval SST handrails, offering both safety and style. A radar arch with a dome and SST mast is included, along with Lopolight LED navigation lights for enhanced visibility and safety.

On the deck, every detail has been meticulously considered for both functionality and aesthetics. All decks, steps, and the cockpit are finished with Esthec composite decking, providing a durable and attractive surface. The Zeelander Design flagpole and custom oval railing and bollards add a touch of sophistication. The sundeck or seating group includes lounge cushions for comfort and relaxation. An anchor windlass with a 70 ft chain and polished 20 kg anchor ensures secure mooring, while eight mooring lines and eight fenders

with lines and covers, featuring the "Zeelander logo" or "Boat Name," provide additional security and style. The deck is equipped with two pairs of spring cleats on each side, two bow cleats, and two aft cleats, all made of stainless steel. A stainless steel bow roller with an anchor stop and a bow plate add to the yacht's robust design. The chain locker and fender stowage ensure everything is neatly organized. For convenience, the deck includes three windscreen wipers and washers, safety handrails, deck wash outlets, and a self-draining cockpit. A round escape hatch in the Master cabin and an entrance hatch to the storage area provide easy access and safety. The engine room hatch is electrically controlled, and cockpit lighting ensures visibility and ambiance. A Kahlenberg chrome trumpet horn with an air compressor is included for signaling, and the yacht is equipped with eight USCG-approved life jackets, along with a USCG safety and medical kit.

The platform and garage are designed for ease of use and safety, featuring a remote-controlled stern platform with an emergency button for opening from the water. An integrated swimming ladder in the platform and Esthec composite decking on the swimming platform provide convenience and style. The platform includes a deck wash outlet, dockside water inlet, and a 50 amp shore power connection. An emergency engine room bilge pump can be operated from the deck, ensuring safety in all conditions.

In the wheelhouse, comfort and control are paramount. An outside seating area accommodates six persons, and a wet bar with a sink provides hot and cold water. The wheelhouse includes an eight-person seating and dining area, an adjustable helmsman's chair available in different options, and a wheelhouse locker for storage. An electric sliding sunroof with a composite panel allows for natural light and fresh air. The dashboard is equipped with system control switches, Volvo electronic engine controls, steering, joystick control, engine monitoring, and an alarm panel. Volvo QL trim tabs control, a compass, and a CD player with four speakers complete the wheelhouse's features.

The Master cabin offers a queen-size bed, air conditioning with reversed cycle heating, and ample storage under the berth and in lockers above the bed. The cabin is finished with ceiling and wall coverings, Ocean Air screens, and privacy covers. Reading lights, AC power points, teak flooring, a 10-gallon water heater, a fire extinguisher, and a smoke detector ensure comfort and safety. Entertainment is provided by a CD player with two speakers and a TV with radio, CD, DVD, and iPod/MP3 USB compatibility.

The kitchen is equipped with a refrigerator and freezer, "Superyacht" portholes, a main control panel for AC/DC, battery charger, and generator control. AC power points, storage lockers above and below the countertop, a recessed ceramic hob with an extractor fan, a combination microwave, and a sink with a hot and cold water mixer tap provide all the necessary amenities. The Corian counter, special built-in garbage storage, a 50-gallon holding tank with deck discharge and monitoring, teak flooring, a fire extinguisher, and carbon monoxide and smoke detectors ensure both functionality and safety. In the bathroom, a sink with a hot and cold water mixer tap, storage lockers, mirrors, a Corian counter, and teak flooring create a luxurious space. The vacuum water-flushed electrically operated toilet, composite enclosed shower with a glass door, rain shower with a thermostat, ventilation fan, AC power points, and "Superyacht" portholes complete the bathroom's features.

The VIP cabin offers a queen-size bed, "Superyacht" portholes, storage lockers beside the bed, reading lights, AC power points, and teak flooring. A 2000 GPH automatic bilge pump with control at the helm, a fresh water tank with monitoring, a variable speed fresh water pump and filter system, a fire extinguisher, a smoke detector, and a radio with CD and iPod/MP3 compatibility ensure comfort and safety.

The storage room includes a fire extinguisher, a composite fuel tank with vents, Volvo fuel tank level senders, storage-room lights, a DC main fuse box, an 80 Amp battery charger, 12V service batteries, a toolbox, and Silent Line

Group sound insulation bulkheads and ceiling. Special mounts for engines and generator, two diesel engines Volvo Penta IPS 600, a Volvo galvanic corrosion system for IPS, high output alternators, 12V start batteries, an emergency battery interconnect, a generator in a sound cover, an electrical bonding system, a sea strainer filter for A/C and generator, water-cooled exhausts, bronze seacocks on all underwater through-hulls, stainless steel hull side engine room, a 2000 GPH automatic bilge pump, an FE-227 automatic/manual fire extinguisher, Racor fuel filters for main engines, engine room lights, a bypass exhaust system, and a compressor airhorn complete the yacht's technical specifications.

Safety and equipment are paramount, with eight life jackets, two child life jackets, a life ring with a 100 ft floating line, and a flare set with hand, parachute, and smoke options ensuring preparedness for any situation.

Custom features

This yacht boasts an array of bespoke features that elevate both its performance and opulence. Central to its propulsion are dual Volvo IPS 600 engines, each offering 435 horsepower, paired with joystick control and a 7-inch display for precise handling. The Volvo IPS Dynamic Positioning System (DPS) further augments the vessel's stability and control, simplifying docking and navigation.

For those who value comfort in warmer climates, the yacht is fitted with an enhanced A/C Florida Package. This split system includes extra air handlers in the VIP cabin and wheelhouse, ensuring a consistently cool and pleasant atmosphere. The yacht's visual allure is heightened by three underwater lights, creating an enchanting ambiance during evening voyages.

The helm area is crafted for both convenience and luxury, featuring a wet bar with options like an icemaker and refrigerator, ideal for entertaining guests. An aft seat table and support offer a relaxing space, while the ultra-luxe helm seat

provides exceptional comfort for the captain. In the galley, an additional refrigerator and a dishwasher enhance convenience, while granite countertops add a touch of sophistication. The cabin floor is made from solid teak and holly, contributing to the yacht's refined interior.

For those who relish outdoor living, the yacht is equipped with a bimini top and a drop curtain, offering shade and protection from the elements. An aft deck enclosure and a windshield cover further enhance the yacht's adaptability, allowing for comfortable cruising in diverse weather conditions. These custom features come together to create a yacht that is not only a joy to operate but also a luxurious sanctuary on the water.

Electronics

The yacht boasts a cutting-edge electronics suite, upgraded in 2022, to provide the most advanced navigation and communication capabilities. Central to this system is the Garmin 16 XSV Electronics Package, offering extensive functionality to meet all maritime requirements. The 17X High Sensitive GPS ensures precise location tracking, crucial for safe and efficient travel.

Communication is facilitated by the 200 VHF Radio, guaranteeing clear and dependable connections with other vessels and shore facilities.

For underwater exploration and safety, the yacht is equipped with a GSD22 Digital Sonar, paired with a robust 1kw B260 Transducer with fairing, delivering detailed and accurate insights into the underwater environment. The GMI-10 Graphic Color Display provides a vivid and clear interface for monitoring various system parameters, while the GHC-10 Autopilot Control Head, in conjunction with the GHP 10V Autopilot System, enables effortless and precise course management.

Radar capabilities are elevated by the 6kw GMR604 x HD Digital Array Radar, offering high-definition imaging for exceptional situational awareness, even in challenging conditions. Additionally, the yacht features an inverter in the

storage room, offering flexibility and convenience for powering various electronic devices onboard. This comprehensive electronics suite ensures the yacht is fully equipped for both leisurely cruises and more demanding journeys.
