Updates 2024/2025

In the 2024/2025 updates, the yacht has received substantial improvements to guarantee top-tier performance and luxury. The windows have been carefully removed and reinstalled, ensuring flawless alignment and finish. A new set of propellers has been fitted, with an additional spare set provided for extra convenience. The shafts and bearings have been replaced, enhancing the yacht's smooth and efficient operation. The aftercoolers have been serviced, and the extensive 2,000-hour maintenance has been completed, ensuring all systems are in excellent condition. All mechanical services are current, as is the out-of-water service, ensuring the yacht is prepared for any journey. These enhancements demonstrate a dedication to maintaining the yacht at the highest level, providing the owner with confidence and dependability.

Layout & accommodations

The yacht features a breathtaking interior crafted entirely from teak, radiating sophistication and warmth throughout its design. It comfortably hosts up to four guests, creating a welcoming and intimate environment. The master suite is strategically located aft to port, offering a secluded haven for relaxation. At the front, the V Berth provides extra sleeping options, accompanied by a well-equipped head with a shower, ensuring ease and comfort for everyone on board. This layout is expertly designed to deliver both opulence and practicality, ensuring every voyage is an enjoyable experience.

Salon

Galley

The wooden flooring infuses the area with warmth and sophistication. Generous cabinet and drawer storage keeps all culinary essentials well-organized and within easy reach. The galley includes a stainless steel refrigerator freezer, offering ample room for both fresh and frozen items. Cooking is simplified with a Samsung convection oven and a microwave, providing a range of options for meal preparation. The refrigeration compressor is cleverly located in the engine room, maximizing space and efficiency. A double sink offers plenty of space for washing and food prep, while the carpet adds a comforting feel underfoot. This galley perfectly marries style with practicality, creating an inviting space for culinary adventures on the open sea.

Entertainment

The yacht's entertainment system is crafted to deliver an outstanding audio-visual experience. It includes a flat screen TV, ideal for watching films or shows in high definition. The stereo system is enhanced by surround sound, providing an immersive auditory experience throughout the yacht.

Furthermore, the vessel is fitted with a Fusion stereo system, renowned for its excellent sound quality and dependability. To further elevate the audio experience, JBL speakers are strategically positioned to offer sharp and clear sound. This entertainment configuration guarantees that whether you're hosting a vibrant party or enjoying a peaceful evening, the ambiance is always just right.

Companionway

The companionway on this yacht is carefully crafted to offer effortless access to the staterooms and head, ensuring convenience and smooth movement throughout the vessel. It includes a hanging locker, ideal for storing outerwear and maintaining an organized space. Additionally, a storage locker with shelves provides plenty of room for personal belongings and essentials. Natural light streams in through port lights, creating a bright and inviting ambiance. The walls are tastefully wallpapered, adding a touch of elegance, while the carpeting underfoot enhances comfort. For added ease, a Haier electric dryer is available, making laundry tasks simple and efficient. This companionway is a perfect fusion of functionality and style, enriching the overall onboard experience.

Master stateroom

The master stateroom is gracefully situated port midship, providing a tranquil

escape with its carefully planned layout. It includes oversized, crisscrossed over-and-under bunks, offering generous sleeping accommodations and a distinctive look. Beneath the lower bunk, there is practical drawer storage, ideal for keeping personal belongings neatly tucked away. Additional storage can be found in the credenza drawers, ensuring everything is in its rightful place. A hanging locker provides extra room for clothing and accessories. The room is completed with a carpeted floor, adding warmth and comfort underfoot. Natural light streams through the port lights, enhancing the welcoming ambiance. The stateroom also features a private head, ensuring convenience and privacy for its residents. This master stateroom blends practicality with elegance, creating a luxurious retreat on the water.

Head

The head on this yacht is a well-designed area, featuring a single head with a separate shower situated on the port side. It includes a mirrored vanity that brings both elegance and practicality. The marble countertop with a built-in sink exudes luxury, while the spacious stall shower provides plenty of room for comfort. Outfitted with a Raritan fixture, the head guarantees reliability and quality. The mirrored ceiling enhances the sense of openness and brightness, creating a welcoming atmosphere. A closet with shelves provides practical storage options, and the wallpapered walls add a touch of sophistication. The shower is conveniently located on the port side of the companionway, and the sink is designed to drain overboard, ensuring efficient water management. This head blends style with functionality, making it a standout feature of the yacht.

Vip

The VIP stateroom is crafted to provide both comfort and convenience, featuring V Berth bunks on the port and starboard sides, offering generous

sleeping accommodations for guests. Underneath the bunks, drawer storage is available, ensuring personal items are neatly organized and easily accessible. The room is completed with a carpeted floor, adding warmth and comfort underfoot. Port holes allow natural light to flood the space, creating a bright and welcoming atmosphere. Additionally, there is access to the rope locker, offering practicality and ease for managing equipment. This VIP stateroom blends functionality with a hint of luxury, making it a welcoming retreat for guests on board.

Engine room

The engine room of this yacht houses robust Cummins QSB engines, each producing 600 HP, with around 3,250 hours of use. These engines, marked by serial numbers 60337308 and 60337460, are paired with ZF Marine Gears, Model ZF 286 A, identified by serial numbers 20289725 and 20289724. The room is equipped with high-output alternators and engine block heaters to ensure peak performance under various conditions. Engine monitoring is supported by VDO mechanical gauges and dual Cummins Smart Craft systems, offering precise data and control. Designed for safety and efficiency, the engine room includes an engine shutdown system and Isoelastic motor mounts to minimize vibration. The exhaust system features 6-inch in-line mufflers and stainless steel exhaust elbows, with raw water cooling to regulate engine temperature. The stainless steel shafts, measuring 1 3/4 inches, are fitted with Tides dripless shaft seals, complete with spares for added reliability. Control is managed via a single lever Glendinning system, ensuring smooth operation. Safety is a priority, with a fixed fire suppression system, FE 241 Marine type, Model #MA2 FE 241, providing peace of mind. This engine room exemplifies engineering excellence, blending power, precision, and safety.

Electrical system

The yacht's electrical system is sturdy and fully equipped to handle all power requirements. It includes Newage Phasor generators, Model #98420471 K3-8 PMS, delivering power ratings of 12KW and 8KW, with operating hours around 1568 and 1211, respectively. These generators are backed by a primary Racor 500 MA fuel filter, ensuring clean and efficient performance. The system is fused at the battery switch for safety. The yacht is powered by Deka and Blue Optima battery banks, featuring three batteries for the port engine, three for the starboard engine, and one for the generator. Battery boxes and a four-position battery switch ensure organized and secure power management. The electrical system is equipped with a voltmeter and amp meter for monitoring, along with a Mastervolt 12/100-3 12V charger to maintain battery health. GFI outlets are installed for added safety and convenience. This comprehensive electrical configuration guarantees reliable power distribution and management throughout the yacht.

Electronics and navigation

The yacht's electronics and navigation system is cutting-edge, guaranteeing a smooth and secure voyage. It includes three Garmin 7612 XSV units, with unit numbers 3949810547, 3949604754, and 3949622725, offering extensive navigation capabilities. The Garmin GMI 20, identified by Unit ID 3954094285, provides precise instrumentation, while the Garmin GHS 10 ensures dependable communication. The Garmin autopilot GHC 20 unit simplifies navigation, and the Garmin radar, Model No: GMR 624, covers a range of up to 72 miles, ensuring excellent situational awareness. A Danforth compass offers traditional navigation support, complemented by the VHF ICOM - IC M506 for clear communication. The system is equipped with VHF and GPS antennas for optimal signal reception. For entertainment, the yacht features a Fusion

MS-NRX300 stereo system and JBL speakers, delivering superior sound quality. Additionally, a satellite TV system is installed, ensuring entertainment options are always available. This comprehensive suite of electronics and navigation tools ensures that every journey is both enjoyable and secure.

Miscellaneous mechanical

The yacht's various mechanical systems are crafted for peak performance and dependability. It includes hydraulic steering with the Sea Star Optimus system, offering precise maneuverability. The propellers measure 26"x 26" with four Nibral blades, and spare propellers are provided for extra assurance. The shafts are constructed from 1 3/4" Aquamet, paired with dripless Tides shaft seals. Trim tabs are fitted to improve stability and handling. The yacht boasts a comprehensive air conditioning system, featuring a Cruise Air unit in the salon with a capacity of 16,000 BTU, identified by Serial No: 33998930. Two Dometic compressors, Model No: RX16, with Serial Nos: 34199741 and 34199740, offer additional cooling capacity. The air conditioning is managed by two Dometic units, Model No: AC C MD 115V, with Serial No: MPH211319, operating at 110V. An electric pump system aids the air conditioning, and ventilation is effectively distributed to the V berth, mid stateroom, galley, and salon. This configuration ensures a comfortable and controlled climate throughout the yacht.

Flybridge

The flybridge of this yacht exemplifies exceptional design and functionality, providing a panoramic view and numerous features for both navigation and leisure. Central to its design is a console with a centrally aligned storage area, offering plenty of room for essential gear. The brow storage enhances practicality, keeping everything easily accessible. A teak pod with a stainless steel bezel houses the analog engine gauges, adding a classic element to the

modern setup. The single lever controls and stainless steel wheel ensure precise maneuverability. Comfort is key, with a Rybovich helm chair featuring cushions and a footrest, creating the ideal spot for the captain. Additional bench seating on both port and starboard sides includes storage and cushions, making it perfect for guests. The flybridge is enclosed on three sides with EZ2CY, providing protection from the weather while maintaining clear visibility. A composite hardtop with teaser reels and a belly band with five rod holders caters to fishing enthusiasts. Access to the bridge is facilitated by a sturdy ladder, ensuring safety and ease. This flybridge is a seamless blend of luxury and practicality, crafted to enhance every journey.

Cockpit

The cockpit of this yacht seamlessly combines elegance with practicality, showcasing a varnished teak bulkhead with centrally aligned doors that add a layer of sophistication. The deck and covering boards are made from teak, offering a timeless and robust finish. For added convenience, the cockpit includes box freezers on both port and starboard sides, along with extra storage on the starboard side. Access to the lazarette is straightforward, with ample storage available on both sides. The cockpit is equipped with a 50-amp shore power inlet, ensuring dependable power connectivity. Stainless steel hawse pipes and hardware enhance both durability and visual appeal. A bridge ladder allows easy access to the upper levels, while washdown systems for both raw and fresh water maintain cleanliness and upkeep. The deck also features two fish boxes, catering to fishing enthusiasts. This cockpit is crafted to fulfill both leisure and functional needs, making it a standout aspect of the yacht.

Fishing

The fishing configuration on this yacht is crafted for dedicated anglers, offering a full suite of features to elevate the fishing experience. Central to the setup is a Release teak 130 fighting chair, offering a robust and comfortable platform for reeling in large catches. The rocket launcher Release enhances functionality, allowing for effective rod management. An electric teaser reel is built into the hardtop, simplifying the deployment and retrieval of lines. The deck includes two fish boxes, providing ample room for storing the day's haul. A livewell is available to keep bait fresh and active. The yacht is equipped with Rupp XXX outriggers and a center rigger, delivering the necessary reach and stability for trolling. A dedicated bait prep area and tackle station ensure all fishing equipment is organized and ready for use. This fishing setup is carefully designed to cater to both novice and experienced fishermen, ensuring every fishing excursion is a success.
