OVERVIEW

A streamlined 45-foot motor yacht, built in 2008 and presently lying in Turkey, this express cruiser marries speed, refinement, and practical comfort to create unforgettable days and weekends afloat. Her contemporary silhouette is balanced by a 12-foot beam that expands interior volume and cockpit breadth, while a shallow draft of just under 4.6 feet encourages confident access to secluded coves and stylish marinas alike.

Twin Yanmar diesel engines provide dependable motive power, yielding a relaxed 24-knot cruising pace with an exhilarating top end of up to 32 knots—swift to plane, hushed in operation, and steady through varying sea states. The fiberglass hull and deck construction promise a solid, low-maintenance ride, and with approximately 317 gallons of fuel and 185 gallons of water aboard, she is well prepared for extended coastal passages and leisurely anchorages.

Deck arrangements favor sociable entertaining and effortless movement, with generous lounging areas and flowing social zones that lead naturally from the cockpit forward. The interior is bright and inviting, featuring clean architectural lines, tasteful finishes, and considered appointments that form a tranquil, modern sanctuary. Clever storage keeps living areas uncluttered, the galley is arranged for easy hospitality, and two well-appointed heads provide the privacy and convenience expected for comfortable overnighting and longer escapes.

Equally adept as a lively sport cruiser or a polished coastal companion from sunrise swims to sunset voyages, this 45-footer pairs twin-diesel efficiency with nimble handling and a resilient fiberglass build, making her an inspired choice for Mediterranean cruising and beyond. Positioned squarely in the Motor Yacht and Express Cruiser segments, she embodies true Sport Cruiser and Performance Cruiser character with the assurance of twin-diesel confidence, a

capable and elegant yacht designed to elevate every passage.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed information

CINTONIK stands among Turkey's most iconic, masterfully built lobster boats, the product of a Builder celebrated for diesel inboard engineering and steadfast shaft propulsion, and she invites a different kind of weekend: one that lingers. By heritage lobster boats are medium-sized, often trailerable craft adored for time honored short cruises, yet CINTONIK's low draft and generous beam make her exceptionally stable and versatile at anchor, welcoming around six passengers to savor life afloat together. Beneath her classic lines the general arrangement is composed for effortless living: a serene master cabin with a double berth, two bathrooms equipped with electric WCs for privacy and convenience, a practical, well proportioned galley and two inviting sitting areas that flow naturally between interior comfort and open air enjoyment. Her mechanical heart is all about confidence and control; twin Yanmar 380 BHP diesel main engines show approximately 1250 hours and drive through ZF 220V gearboxes with a 2.5:1 ratio to deliver smooth, efficient thrust on shafts, while a diesel Onan generator rated at 9.5 kW handles hotel loads with quiet assurance and a 12 VDC and 220 VAC electrical system keeps every onboard comfort at your fingertips. Ground tackle is handled by a Fast windlass, underwater lighting adds drama to evening waters, and a power operated automatic passerella eases boarding, with even the everyday considered down to the handy onboard kettle. Navigation and handling are comprehensively specified: a Raymarine C80 chartplotter, Raymarine autopilot to ease longer passages, a Raymarine radio for clear communications and a Serenity AIS device for enhanced awareness, supported by both bow and aft thrusters for precision maneuvering, Lenco flaps to refine underway trim and a 360 degree projector to cast confident light wherever the adventure leads.

The galley is smartly equipped to elevate life onboard with a Vitrifrigo refrigerator plus an additional refrigerator, a Vitrifrigo ice maker to keep drinks perfectly chilled, a Smev electric cooker and a Can electric grill for culinary versatility, and a concealed marine sink that keeps the working area clean and refined. Safety and readiness are evident throughout: a Lalizas "Zero" can type six person unit stands at the ready, supported by three fire extinguishers, four life buoys and eight life jackets, with pyrotechnic materials and navigational charts maintained to current dates. Creature comforts abound across the other facilities and equipment, where a multi zone air conditioning system serves the saloon, cabin and galley, a marine satellite and TV antenna feed a LED TV, entertainment flows through a Kenwood multimedia system (DVD, MP3, Radio and Bluetooth) paired with a JBL sound system in salon and cabin, and practical refinements such as a folding table with lift, sunbed style foredeck loungers, separate summer and winter awning and canopy sets for the aft cockpit, and Fifer living room glass shades complete a thoughtful fit out. Flying the Turkish flag, CINTONIK presents as thoroughly complete and impressively equipped, ready to cruise with poise and personality.
