OVERVIEW

A sublime tribute to mid-century boatbuilding, this 45-foot 1960 wooden motor yacht encourages a gentler tempo and the pleasure of the passage. Crafted by hand in an age when beauty and seaworthiness were inseparable, her warm timber decks and elegantly balanced silhouette confer a harbor presence that commands attention. Located in the United States, she awaits a new custodian who values authenticity, character, and the quiet assurance of a genuine classic.

Her generous 13-foot beam delivers the uncommon marriage of intimate, old-world charm and genuinely usable interior volume. Boarding reveals richly grained joinery and a salon that invites leisurely conversation and serene afternoons. The layout is practical and considered: a well-equipped galley suited to easy days underway, abundant cabinetry to support extended cruising, and a bright, welcoming head that answers the accommodations with straightforward nautical sensibility.

Power comes from twin Cummins inboard diesel engines, providing the dependable, steady performance experienced mariners prize—smooth, reliable propulsion with the reassuring temperament of proven diesel engineering. A deep, confidence-inspiring draft combined with a solid wooden hull produces a composed, sea-kindly motion, tracking true in a seaway and rewarding a steady hand at the wheel. With approximately 450 gallons of fuel aboard, she is prepared for unhurried coastal passages and weekend forays, while roughly 100 gallons of fresh water ensure comfortable overnighting at anchor.

It is the meticulous details that linger: the warm glow of hand-finished woodwork, the balanced interplay of traditional lines, and the palpable sense of heritage that only a vessel built to endure can impart. This is a yacht for the collector seeking a living chapter of nautical history, for the cruiser drawn to

the romance of wooden craft, and for the connoisseur who recognizes that genuine luxury is found in authenticity, quiet moments, and the steady cadence of a thoughtfully designed hull cutting through the water.

Ready for elegant afternoons along the shoreline or a longer stay in a beloved harbor, this 1960 wooden motor yacht extends an invitation to sail with grace. Step aboard and rediscover why true classics endure: because beauty and substance remain timeless.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Vessel walkthrough

All the way forward, V-bunks with storage drawers beneath are complemented by a concealed head, creating a tidy and practical forward sleeping area, while aft to port an enclosed head with shower serves the accommodations and further aft to port the master stateroom presents a queen berth, a hanging locker, and generous drawer storage for orderly personal effects; along the starboard side, the full galley is appointed with a ceramic cooktop, a deep stainless-steel sink, a GE microwave/convection oven, a custom stainless-steel refrigerator and freezer, and dedicated pantry storage that keeps provisions organized; ascend the companionway to the salon, where an L-shaped sofa to port converts into a queen berth beside an end cabinet with drawer storage, and to starboard a concealed rod locker, a classic barrel chair, and a cabinet with an ice maker aft enhance comfort and utility while an overhead-mounted TV occupies the starboard aft corner, all unified by rich mahogany floors that run throughout and lend a warm, cohesive finish.

Salon

Rich mahogany floors set a warm tone for the salon, where an inviting L-shaped sofa to port converts seamlessly into a queen berth and is complemented by an end cabinet with drawer storage; to starboard, a classic barrel chair and a cabinet with an ice maker anchor the space, while a ceiling-mounted TV in the starboard aft corner completes this elegant and functional retreat, combining refined finishes with practical sleeping and entertaining arrangements.

Galley-starboard

The starboard galley is fully equipped for serious cruising, featuring a sleek ceramic cooktop, a deep stainless-steel sink, a GE microwave/convection oven, and a custom stainless-steel refrigerator and freezer, all framed by practical pantry storage that keeps provisions neatly organized for extended passages and easy provisioning.

Master stateroom-port aft

Nestled port aft, the master stateroom offers restful privacy with a queen-size berth, a dedicated hanging locker, and thoughtful under-berth drawer storage to keep essentials close and the space beautifully uncluttered, presenting a serene owner's retreat aft of the accommodation spaces.

Guest stateroom-forward

Forward, the guest stateroom features a classic V-berth with generous under-berth storage, creating a bright and efficient retreat for family or guests with easy access to the forward head and a comfortable layout that maximizes available space.

Head-forward

The forward head is thoughtfully appointed with a toilet, a sink, and a shower, delivering everyday comfort in a compact, well-finished space that serves the forward accommodations with convenience and tasteful finishes.

Cockpit

Purpose-built for action, the cockpit places the controls to starboard and the

tackle center with sink to port, all set against handsome teak decking and covering boards; a transom door eases access, while a rocket launcher with bait tray, four flush-mount rod holders, and two Rupp outriggers equip you for serious angling days and underline the boat's readiness for offshore sportfishing.

Flybridge/electronics

Up top, a Rybovich helm chair fronts the Rybovich helm with an aluminum wheel and single-lever controls beneath a Rybovich custom hardtop and a three-sided enclosure, while guests relax on wraparound U-shaped seating and the electronics suite provides comprehensive navigation and entertainment capability with Furuno NavNet including radar, a GPS plotter and color bottom machine, a Clarion stereo, a Simrad AP21 autopilot, a Standard Horizon VHF, trim tabs control, an Intellian SAT TV receiver, five bridge rail rod holders, and bright halogen lights for clarity after dusk.

Electrical

Power at anchor comes from a Northern Lights generator M753K rated at 8 kW, delivering reliable, efficient onboard electricity.

Engine/mechanical equipment

Performance and confidence are delivered by two Cummins 6BTA 5.9 M3 370 HP diesel engines paired with ZF HSW 800A 2.01:1 gearboxes, complemented by Rybovich controls and steering; safety and serviceability are addressed with a Fireboy fire system, Bennett trim tabs, a hot water heater, a Marine Air reverse-cycle A/C, an oil change system, a high-water alarm, four automatic bilge pumps, and an engine alarm system to ensure dependable operation and

peace of mind underway.

CYGNET is a donated vessel and is available for lease to purchase, presenting a compelling opportunity to step aboard a beautifully outfitted craft with exceptional pedigree.
