OVERVIEW

Meet Katerina, a 2021 Pardo 43 that marries Italian elegance with purposeful engineering. This 14.00 m (45'11") open hardtop walkaround has been kept in exemplary, turn key condition and presents a rare combination of sculpted Mediterranean lines, purposeful performance from twin Volvo Penta IPS 650 pods, and the easy sociability of a dayboat built for refined coastal cruising and island hopping. With roughly 380 hours on the clocks and a comprehensive yard period in September 2025, she is prepared for the 2025/26 season with every major system attended.

Boarding Katerina reveals the design intelligence of Zuccheri Yacht Design: a genuine walkaround deck allows safe, seamless movement from bow to stern while entertaining flows naturally between a spacious cockpit dining lounge that converts to a sunpad and the forward chaise and bench seating. The large cockpit is complemented by aft and bow sunpads and a generous wet bar/galley, creating an expressive social platform. Accommodation comprises a forward owner's cabin and a flexible aft twin/utility cabin, with a dedicated head and separate shower, delivering both comfort and practicality for weekend escapes or extended days aboard.

Her hull is a sophisticated GRP/vinylester infusion with foam sandwich construction and carbon reinforcements for added rigidity, quieter passage making, and long term durability. The relatively shallow draft of approximately 1.05 m (3'5") and a broad beam of about 4.20 m (13'9") give her a stable, confidence inspiring footprint while preserving the sleek profile expected of a Pardo. Fuel capacity sits near 1,200 L (≈317 US gal) with fresh water on the order of 300–400 L, supporting comfortable range and autonomy for coastal runs and short cruises.

Underway she is enlivened by twin Volvo Penta IPS 650 drives with joystick control, offering punchy acceleration, intuitive docking, and reduced

maintenance compared with traditional shaft systems. A QUICK gyro stabilizer adds a substantial measure of comfort both on passage and at anchor, mitigating roll for a more composed experience. All driveline work has been maintained: in September 2025 the vessel underwent a full haul out and service regime, including Volvo IPS pod servicing by authorized technicians and replacement of selected running gear components, ensuring the propulsion and steering systems are current and professionally documented.

Recent yard work completed September 2025 returns the exterior and systems to a high standard: fresh bottom paint, new running gear parts, pod service, full exterior compound followed by ceramic coating for deep gloss and long lasting protection, renewed caulking around the hardtop, windscreen, and deck fittings, and new sinks fitted throughout. HVAC units were inspected and serviced, the black water/holding system was verified and serviced, and comprehensive records, invoices, and logbooks accompany the sale. The hull and topsides present beautifully beneath the ceramic finish while interior joinery and soft goods remain clean, lightly used, and well cared for.

Katerina is presented as a true turn key proposition: engines, pods, and onboard systems have been attended by qualified professionals, and there is no deferred maintenance to worry about. CE Class B (Offshore) certification underlines her suitability for offshore passages within that category, and the combination of Italian pedigree, family friendly walkaround ergonomics, joystick IPS handling, and gyro stabilization make her an ideal choice for Florida and Bahamas cruising, coastal cruising, or as an elegant dayboat. For buyers seeking provenance and peace of mind, the vessel's thorough service trail and recent major yard period in September 2025 are distinguishing features. With approximately 380 engine hours, full logs and invoices on file, and attention lavished on both mechanical and cosmetic elements, she represents a compelling balance of style, capability, and documented upkeep.
