OVERVIEW

Preliminary listing: a new arrival, the 2010 Sea Ray 450 Sundancer, currently the best-priced 2010 450 available. This refined express cruiser—equally at home as a sport yacht or motor yacht—blends graceful lines with purposeful engineering, propelled by twin Cummins QSB 6.7 diesel engines showing about 750 hours and recently given a comprehensive engine and transmission service for true turn-key confidence. Lightly run and freshly maintained, she stands out in the luxury yacht and cabin cruiser ranks, offering the poise, comfort, and performance discerning owners expect.

Sea Ray's forward-thinking equipment on the 450 Sundancer makes boating both simpler and more pleasurable. The Axis joystick propulsion system gives fingertip precision for tight dock work, while the sleek fiberglass hardtop with an opening sunroof and bonded windshield offers protection without sacrificing light or breeze. The cockpit is designed for conviviality: an entertainment center can be outfitted with a grill and TV to elevate alfresco gatherings, and a unique media room below decks underscores the model's entertainment-first philosophy.

Above deck the continuous hardtop and expansive windshield create an inviting, climate-controlled cockpit, aided by a forward vent, the retractable sunroof, and available cockpit air conditioning and heat so mornings and afternoons remain comfortable no matter the weather. At the helm twin doublewide seats with flip-up bolsters and supportive armrests make long passages relaxing, while the operator benefits from an integrated suite of navigation and vessel-management tools. SmartCraft VesselView consolidates critical engine and system data at a glance; Axis or Zeus joystick systems make close-quarters maneuvering intuitive; and the remarkable Skyhook feature holds position at the press of a button. For owners tailoring propulsion, Sea Ray offered twin diesel Zeus pods with QSB 380 or QSB 480

options to match cruising style and waters.

The cockpit invites lingering and easy conversation. A generous U-shaped lounge centered around a removable table is ideal for sunset hors d'oeuvres, and the clever aft backrest splits and pivots to expand the sun pad for reading, napping, or stargazing. Beneath that sun pad, deep storage swallows lines, fenders, and gear. To starboard, an oversized L-shaped wet bar with icemaker anchors social time; add the optional grill, refrigerator, and removable flatscreen to create an outdoor galley ambiance that turns the aft deck into a floating terrace.

Below decks the 450 Sundancer blends timeless craftsmanship with contemporary amenities. Hand-finished cabinetry from Sea Ray's Cape Canaveral facility, supple Ultraleather seating, brushed-chrome accents, and available wood soles create a warm, tailored interior. Oversized hull windows and a skylight bathe the salon in natural light, enhancing an earth-toned palette that feels both elegant and welcoming. Forward, the private stateroom is a boutique-hotel retreat with a full-island berth appointed with memory foam, an electric extension, and a supportive Posturepedic backrest; Shoji-style sliding doors add a refined touch. The split head layout, with separate shower and toilet compartments fitted with tiled soles, streamlines morning routines with privacy and practicality.

The main cabin's portside galley is laid out for proper provisioning, featuring gleaming stainless-steel appliances and abundant storage. Opposite, a lounge with a folding dining table converts easily into an additional berth for guests. Entertainment systems are comprehensive: the Sony audio package integrates an iPod dock, CD player, Sirius satellite receiver, amplifier, and subwoofer to deliver rich, room-filling sound whether at anchor or underway.

Immediately aft of the salon, the signature media room provides an indulgent retreat with theater-style seating, accent lighting, and a full AV suite ready for movie night or gaming. A 32-inch TV is standard, with an available upgrade to a

Bose 3-2-1 system and 37-inch display for a true cinematic experience. Dual ottomans conceal storage and flip between cushioned tops and wooden tabletops for versatile use, surrounding lockers and cabinets keep the area shipshape, and the theater seats slide out to form a comfortable double berth complete with a privacy curtain for overnight guests.

A robust options catalog allowed owners to tailor the 450 Sundancer to their cruising aspirations: advanced electronics, generator, teak decking, a foredeck sun pad for lazy afternoons, a hydraulic-lift swim platform for tender and water-toy convenience, rod holders for casual trolling, and upgraded audio/visual packages throughout. The result is a refined, highly adaptable cruiser equally suited to weekend getaways, extended coastal passages, or lively dockside entertaining.

For buyers seeking a luxury express cruiser, sport yacht, or cabin cruiser that marries joystick precision with welcoming spaces and meticulous craftsmanship, this 2010 Sea Ray 450 Sundancer is a rare opportunity—recently serviced, lightly run, and attractively priced to move. It is the essence of a modern motor yacht: intuitive to handle, beautifully finished, and brilliantly arranged for the way you live on the water.

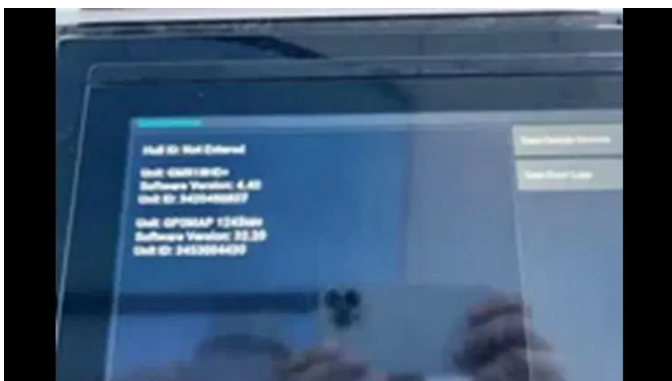

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Preliminary Listing — New Arrival 2010 Sea Ray 450 Sundancer, the lowest priced 2010 450 Sundancer on the market. Powered by twin Cummins QSB 6.7 diesels showing only 750 hours and just treated to a comprehensive engine and transmission service, this yacht presents as a turn key opportunity with the pedigree and performance that have made the 450 Sundancer an icon. The manufacturer's vision shines through with forward thinking innovation: a standard Axius propulsion system with intuitive joystick control, a sleek fiberglass hardtop crowned by a retractable sunroof, a climate managed cockpit entertainment center with optional grill and TV, and a rare, purpose built media room below. Up top, a seamless hardtop and bonded windshield, aided by a forward vent, sunroof, and available cockpit air conditioning and heating, deliver true all weather versatility. Two doublewide benches with flip up bolsters and armrests serve the helm and port companion position, while the helm itself is equipped to inspire confidence with SmartCraft VesselView, Axius or Zeus joystick control, and the remarkable Skyhook station keeping feature. For those seeking tailored thrust, twin diesel Zeus pod drives were offered with either QSB 380s or QSB 480s, allowing owners to match power to their cruising style. Leisure flows naturally in the expansive U shaped cockpit lounge with a removable table, where a split aft backrest pivots open to extend the sun pad and reveal generous stowage for lines, fenders, and all the day's essentials. To starboard, an L shaped wet bar with icemaker keeps refreshments at the ready, with options for a grill, refrigerator, and a removable 19 inch flatscreen TV to create a true outdoor galley ambiance. Beneath the 450's streamlined profile is a classic contemporary interior finished to a high standard with cabinetry

crafted at Sea Ray's Cape Canaveral Woodworking and Finishing Facility, Ultraleather seating, brushed chrome accents, and optional wood flooring. Oversized hull windows and a skylight bathe the salon in natural light, enriching the earthy materials and soothing palette. The forward stateroom centers on a full size island V berth with memory foam mattress, electric extension, and Posturepedic backrest, complemented by a Shoji style sliding door and separate head and shower compartments trimmed with tile floors. The main cabin hosts a spacious portside galley with stainless steel appliances and abundant storage, opposite a starboard dinette with a folding table that converts swiftly to a sleeper. Entertainment is comprehensive, with a Sony stereo featuring an iPod docking station, CD player, Sirius satellite receiver, amplifier, subwoofer, and more. Aft of the salon, the signature media room awaits, complete with theater seating, accent lighting, and an entertainment suite offering a gaming system port, MP3 port, DVD player, and a 32 inch TV; for a true big screen, surround sound experience, the optional package elevates the space with a Bose 3.2.1 System and a 37 inch flatscreen. Twin ottomans do double duty with internal storage and reversible tops—wood tabletop on one side, plush cushion on the other—so you can set down appetizers and drinks, then flip them to kick back in comfort. Hanging lockers to port and starboard and a dedicated storage cabinet enhance onboard organization. At day's end, the theater seats glide out to form a double berth, with a privacy curtain ensuring restful nights. A long list of available options rounds out the 450 Sundancer's capability, from advanced electronics and generators to teak exterior decking, a foredeck sun pad, a hydraulic lift swim platform, rod holders, and upgraded stereo and TV selections throughout. Marrying innovation with comfort, this 450 delivers the adaptable, user friendly express cruiser experience discerning owners seek.

Features

This 450 Sundancer is equipped for effortless cruising with a shore power inlet and a generator to support hotel loads away from the dock. Navigation and situational awareness are comprehensive, with a depthsounder, radar, log speedometer, plotter, autopilot, compass, GPS, and a VHF radio, complemented by entertainment that includes a TV set, a flat screen TV, and a CD player. Comfort below is assured by an electric bilge pump, a microwave oven, air conditioning, an electric head, heating, hot water, and a refrigerator, while outdoor living benefits from a cockpit shower, plush cockpit cushions, a cockpit table for al fresco dining, and a swimming ladder for easy access to the water.

Propulsion

Power is delivered by a matched pair of 2010 Cummins QSB 6.7 inboard diesels, each rated at 480 hp, showing 750 hours and turning efficient pod drives. This dependable diesel configuration combines joystick ready maneuverability with the smooth thrust and economy that suit an express cruiser of this caliber.

Specifications

She runs with confidence at a cruising speed of 30 kn and can reach a top speed of 42 kn. Dimensions underscore her sweet spot proportions with a length overall of 45.42 ft, a beam of 13.17 ft, a max draft of 3.17 ft, and a min draft of 2.67 ft. Her dry weight is 21,750 lb, and construction features a fiberglass hull with a deep vee shape, a 19 degree deadrise at the transom, and an electric windlass on the bow. Tankage is generous, with 70 gal of fresh water, 285 gal of fuel, and a 42 gal holding tank. Accommodations include 1 guest cabin and 1 guest head, thoughtfully arranged for efficient, luxurious weekends on the water.

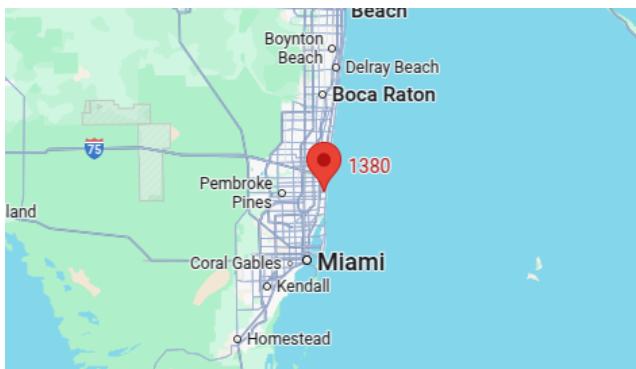
