OVERVIEW

2013 Sea Ray 450 Sundancer — Luxury Motor Yacht in Palmetto, FL
Cummins QSB Diesels • Zeus Pods with Joystick & Skyhook • Excellent Condition

Step aboard this meticulously maintained 2013 Sea Ray 450 Sundancer, moored in Palmetto, Florida, and discover an express cruiser that marries elegant styling with capable engineering. Twin Cummins QSB diesel engines drive Zeus pod propulsion, offering assured performance, fingertip joystick docking and the Skyhook station-keeping system for effortless positional control while cruising or at anchor.

Aboard, thoughtful systems and creature comforts are woven into the design: a fiberglass hardtop with a full enclosure shelters the cockpit and, paired with dedicated cockpit heat and air conditioning, creates true four-season usability; a doublewide helm and companion seating with flip-up bolsters provide ergonomic support and superior sightlines at the controls; and a power-lift engine hatch opens at the push of a button to reveal a clean, well-arranged machinery space. The extended swim platform includes a sturdy stainless boarding ladder for easy water access, while a TNT hydraulic tender lift launches and retrieves your dinghy without sacrificing deck real estate.

The cockpit is arranged for convivial living and convenience, with a wet bar featuring a sink, solid-surface countertop, stainless rail, trash receptacle and dedicated storage to keep refreshments and gear organized. Inside, the interior unfolds in an airy, open plan that flows from the forward master stateroom to an aft media lounge, ideal for entertaining or extended cruising. The salon and galley are integrated for easy service and socializing, and the media room is appointed with theater-style seating, a 40-inch flat-screen, Bose surround audio, ambient lighting and a remote DVD system for on-board cinema nights. The private owner's suite delivers boutique-hotel comfort with a

separate enclosed shower and head, offering true privacy and refinement.

This 450 Sundancer stands out by balancing luxury appointments with proven seaworthy design. Whether used for weekend escapes or coastal passages, it presents the poise, performance and high-quality finish that define the Sea Ray 450 Sundancer class.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

Every space is finished with thoughtful cabin features, from silver-alloy blinds, carbon monoxide monitors, elegant curtains with drape trim, and plush carpeting to warm wood flooring in the V-berth. Stainless-steel handrails and low-heat LED lighting enhance comfort and safety, while polished chrome outlet and switch plates add a refined touch. You'll find 120V GFI-protected outlets alongside 12V accessory outlets throughout, and the entryway steps are crafted in wood with a stainless-steel handrail for a secure, inviting welcome below. In the salon, an L-shaped Ultraleather sofa with generous storage below converts effortlessly into a comfortable bed with filler cushions, creating instant flexibility for guests. Entertainment is curated with an iPod interface port and docking station, plus a Sony 12V AM/FM single CD unit paired with a Sirius satellite receiver and antenna, an amplifier, a subwoofer, speakers serving both zones (four in the cabin and four in the cockpit), a digital cockpit remote, and speaker selector switches. Abundant stowage includes gunwale cabinets and a discreet in-floor compartment, while the dinette table's high-gloss wood surface and dedicated storage bring dining sophistication underway. The galley is appointed for real culinary service, featuring a 120V coffeemaker, a solid-surface countertop with integrated sink, single-lever faucet, and a fitted sink cover, all supported by a stainless-steel handrail. A 120V microwave with stainless front, a 12V power vent with stainless grill, and a dual-voltage refrigerator/freezer with stainless front keep provisions fresh and ventilation crisp. Purposeful storage abounds: drawers with a cutlery insert, upper and lower cabinets with designated plate and glass stowage, and a recessed two-burner 120V stove with a solid-surface cover. A built-in trash receptacle completes this sea-ready galley. The forward stateroom delivers

true suite-style privacy with a handcrafted solid-wood door fitted with translucent screens. Its full-size, island-style berth features an electrically actuated extension and a Posturepedic backrest with a visco elastic foam mattress, plus drawer storage beneath. A decorative rope-locker bulkhead with accent lighting lends nautical charm, while wood flooring, 12V task lighting port and starboard at the head of the bed, coordinated linens with pillows and sheets, and gunwale cabinets to port and starboard enrich the ambiance. A flatscreen TV with DVD player sets the tone for quiet evenings. The starboard forward head is smartly finished with tile floors, stainless-steel handrails, a VacuFlush head, a mirror, a 12V power vent with stainless grill, a robe hook, a towel bar, Sea Ray towels, and a vanity with a solid-surface countertop, sink, faucet, and storage below. Access is available from both the forward stateroom and the salon, while the audio extends into the space with two speakers, and the suite adds two under-berth storage drawers and a mirrored gunwale cabinet for refined organization. To port, the forward shower is a private, tiled retreat accessed from the forward stateroom, complete with a shower curtain, stainless-steel handrails, a robe hook, and a seated shower with an adjustable wand and dedicated shampoo-bottle storage, plus a gunwale cabinet to keep essentials tidy. The mid-stateroom offers its own sense of occasion, beginning with a privacy curtain and dedicated storage. An entertainment center invites downtime with a gaming system port, an MP3 port with a 12V outlet (one in the salon and one at the helm), a 40" flatscreen TV with DVD player and gaming system port, and an Audio/DVD player for the media room. Port and starboard hanging lockers with lights, LED accent lighting, and two movable ottomans with dual-purpose tops (cushions or cocktail tables) and storage below add flexibility. The conversation-pit seating converts to a double berth on a smooth slide-out base, finished in Ultraleather, with an additional starboard storage cabinet to keep the space shipshape. Climate is finely tuned by a zone-controlled, reverse-cycle cabin system rated at 22,000 BTU, breathing through a custom integral vent system for

whisper-quiet comfort in every berth and lounge.

Electronics

Precision navigation and effortless command define the helm, with an integrated autopilot, a chartplotter, and radar forming a confident trifecta. The dedicated 12V/50 Amp electronics circuit supplies clean power, while a VHF radio with a remote speaker and an 8' fiberglass antenna keeps you clearly heard and reliably connected offshore. At the control station, high-water alarms for both bilge and cabin stand vigilant, a battery parallel switch unites the engines when needed, and the gel-coated dash with a high-gloss instrument panel frames a brilliantly organized helm. Concealed dual-trumpet air horns announce your arrival with authority, while Axius joystick control elevates close-quarters handling. Hydraulic power steering pairs with a wood-accent Isotta tilt wheel for a tactile, tailored feel, and electronic shift and throttle controls deliver smooth, precise response. Factory-integrated instrumentation includes custom Sea Ray SmartCraft gauges with low-glare blue night lighting and chrome bezels, complemented by two four-in-one multigauges that combine fuel level, oil pressure, voltmeter, and water temperature, alongside two tachometers for exact engine monitoring. The SmartCraft VesselView display consolidates critical intelligence, presenting propulsion data such as engine hour meters, engine status, performance and fuel, peak performance, optional boost pressure, troll control, and cruise control, as well as vessel information including vessel status, tank status, steering position, and generator data.

Electrical

The yacht's electrical backbone is engineered for reliability, beginning with four batteries in secure trays, a robust 120V/40 Amp/12V battery charger/converter,

and two-way, solenoid-activated battery switches serving both the main distribution panel and bilge. A comprehensive cable TV system with inlet (including a phone inlet), TV and phone shore cords, coax outlets, gain control, and an omni-directional antenna keeps you connected dockside and at anchor. Corrosion defenses include two galvanic isolators. Power is organized through a remote DC circuit-breaker panel, a DC main breaker panel, and dedicated main distribution panels for both AC and DC. Shore power arrives via a 240V/50 Amp/60 Cycle/12 Kva transformer and dual 120V/30 Amp service with 50' cords, all supported by color-coded wiring with thorough chafe protection. For independent power, a Cummins/Onan diesel generator (120V/60 Cycle) stands ready behind a sound shield, with remote start, a muffler, closed cooling, and a proper seacock and seawater strainer—quiet, capable, and designed for extended stays off the grid.

Deck

The deck is sculpted in Arctic White gelcoat and framed by a 316 stainless-steel bow rail with welded stanchions, intermediate rails, and lifelines. You'll appreciate eight custom Sea Ray thru-bolted stainless-steel cleats, stainless deck fill plates and rails, and a brass-threaded garboard drain plug. Custom molded-in hull windows draw in natural light, while navigation lights, a PVC rub rail with stainless insert, and stainless thru-hull fittings speak to enduring build quality. There are graphics with clean striping and distinctive transom numerator graphics, plus 316 stainless-steel handrails throughout. A translucent, trapezoidal deck-vent hatch locks securely and carries Sky Screen covers, and a molded-fiberglass toe rail on deck provides confident footing. The tempered, tinted curved-glass windshield is bonded in with an electric front vent, served by a washer system and wipers with delay and speed control. Engine-room ventilation features stainless components, and the swim platform integrates a concealed stainless-steel four-step swim ladder with an

integral grab handle. A transom storage locker for fenders and gear opens easily with gas assist, while the stringer system of foam and fiberglass provides a stable, quiet ride. In the cockpit, six beverage holders punctuate generous seating, including an aft U-shaped lounge with storage below, a double-wide helm seat with a flip-up thigh-rise bolster, armrests, a heavy-duty pedestal with fore and aft slide and pneumatic vertical adjustment, and a port double-wide companion seat with a flip-up thigh-rise bolster, armrest, and fiberglass storage base. Climate is elevated by reverse-cycle air heating and air conditioning dedicated to the cockpit. A sliding, lockable cabin-entry door with skylight welcomes you inside, while a robust transom door with a stainless frame and Arctic insert keeps the cockpit secure. The fiberglass self-bailing floor liner stays clean, and the fiberglass hardtop with retractable sunroof, overhead lighting, and an electronic dimmer turns daylight into ambiance. Convenience abounds: an insulated, built-in ice bucket and a 120V icemaker, indirect lighting, protected 120V GFI and 12V accessory outlets, two rod holders, molded steps for deck access, side-panel storage to port and starboard, a cockpit sun pad with storage below, and a fiberglass cockpit table with dedicated storage. Entertainment is vivid with an amplifier, a 10" subwoofer, a digital cockpit remote control, and four speakers. To starboard, a full wet bar presents a sink, faucet, solid-surface countertop, stainless-steel handrail, trash receptacle, and a storage cabinet. At the bow, the windlass system is complete: a stainless-steel anchor chute, rope-and-chain locker with a gas-assisted hatch, a washdown spigot, a galvanized anchor, and a rope/chain windlass with foot switches make anchoring simple and dignified. Sunbrella canvas complements the profile with an aft curtain on bungee cords, rich black canvas colorway, and a dedicated canvas storage bag to keep everything orderly when the sky turns fair.

Engine and mechanical details

Beneath the deck, the yacht is engineered for confidence, starting with two automatic 12V bilge pumps, plus automatic high-water 12V bilge pumps—one in the bilge and one in the cabin—for belt and suspenders protection. Two 12V bilge blowers keep air moving, while an automatic fire-suppression system with manual pull adds a vital safety layer. The engine room is gel-coated for cleanability, lit by 12V lighting for clear access, and served by a removable stainless-steel ladder that makes inspection and service straightforward. Waste systems are cruise-proven, with a VacuFlush head system, holding-tank level indicators at both the MDP and the head, a holding tank with convenient dockside pump-out, and an automatic sump box with pump. Freshwater service is equally complete: washdown spigots at the transom and in the engine room, a manifold system with shutoff valves, a pressure water system, and a hot-and-cold cockpit shower. A 120V water heater with an 11 gallon capacity and a dockside water inlet ensure domestic comfort wherever you roam.

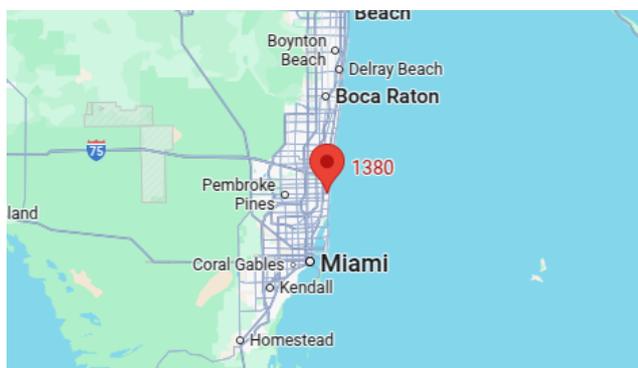
